Position Available: Lawspeaker

Spring Crown Tournament

Requirements and Formats for the Crown Tournament of Crispin Gildensteed and Laura Battista:

Requirements: In addition to the requirements outlined in Kingdom and Society law. All combatants and consorts have additional requirements they must meet:

- 1) All combatants and consorts are required to produce, by their own hand, an arts and science entry to be displayed in the combatants' and consorts' arts and science display. In-process projects are acceptable. A card featuring a description of the project is required; however, formal documentation, though encouraged, is not required. All A&S displays are expected to be presented during the procession.
 - 2) Both combatant and consort must be present on the day of the tournament.
 - 3) Both Combatant and Consort must have attended at least 6 events in Ealdormere in the past year. For this count, practices and meetings are not eligible. Provide a list of these events in your application. The cut-off date for this count is Saturday, April 17th, 2026.
 - 4) Applications must be submitted to both their Highnesses and the Kingdom Seneschal by Friday, April 17th, 2026, at 11:52 pm.
- If combatants or consorts are unable to meet these criteria, their applications are still welcomed and encouraged. Exceptions to the requirements will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Formats:

Format 1 – *If there are 12 or fewer combatants on the day of the tournament:*

The format will be a round-robin style tournament with each match being the best two out of three.

- ◇ Her Majesty will draw the order in which combatants appear on the grid. Names will be drawn immediately following the processional.

The Finals:

- The top two combatants from the round-robin will compete in a best three-out-of-five final, each round of which will be comprised of a best two-out-of-three match.
- In the event of a tied score to determine the finalists, those tied will complete a semi-final bout of 2/3 to determine who will advance to the finals.
- The weapon forms for the finals will be matched for the first four bouts and take place in the following order:
 - ◇ Lower rank combatant's choice,
 - ◇ Higher rank combatant's choice,
 - ◇ Lower rank combatant's choice,
 - ◇ Higher rank combatant's choice (if this fight is required),
 - ◇ Each combatant's personal choice (if this fight is necessary; it is not required to be matched weapons).

Format 2 – *If there are more than 12 combatants on the day of the tournament:*

The format will be a double-elimination tournament.

- The tournament will be fought on the 16-man double elimination list tree.

- If there are more than 16 combatants, combatants will fight for a position on the tree using the sudden victory tree. Conversely, if there are fewer than 16 combatants, by-fights will round out the list to 16. If you are unfamiliar with the sudden victory tree, read pages 26 and 27 of [Double Elimination Trees "The Gold Standard of Tournaments"](#).

- Combatants will be placed on the tree by random draw. Names will be drawn by Her Majesty, immediately following the processional.
- Each round of the tournament will be the best two-out-of-three fights.
- The semi-finals will be best two-out-of-three, the combatant from the undefeated side of the tree will need to win one round of three to advance. The combatant from the one-loss side of the tree will need to win two rounds of three to advance.

The Finals: Will be fought in matched-weapons forms to a best three of five weapons forms. Each weapon form will be a best-two-out-of-three round.

- The weapons forms for the finals will be matched for the first four bouts and take place in the following order:

- ◇ Lower rank combatant's choice,
- ◇ Higher rank combatant's choice,
- ◇ Lower rank combatant's choice,
- ◇ Higher rank combatant's choice (if this fight is required),
- ◇ Each combatant's personal choice (if this fight is necessary; it is not required to be matched weapons).

With looking forward to the events of the New Year I would like to let everyone know the due dates for putting in Kingdom events. Anyone can put in a Kingdom event but if no one does by the due date the group on rotation needs to bid.

2027 Spring Coronation *due by* end April 2026 (Ramshaven)

2027 Spring Crown *due by* end May 2026 Shires (assist from Septentria)

2027 Fall Coronation *due by* end September 2026 (Rising Waters)

2027 Fall Crown *due by* end October 2026 (Ben Dunfirth)

Thank you for your help in getting our Kingdom Events on the Calendar in a timely fashion.

Their Highnesses have put their requirements for their Crown Tourney in the Tidings.

Here are the legal requirements due no later than April 17th 2026 at 11:52pm

Requirements by Kingdom Law for participation:

- Must be 18

- Must be subjects of Ealdormere and have demonstrated a clear level of involvement in the Kingdom over the year prior to the Crown Tournament. Involvement includes event attendance and service.
- Must be armigerous (or provide dispensation request as per Kingdom Law)
- Must provide proof of membership (membership card or proof of membership from the Society Website)
- Must provide proof of renewal if expiring in month before or of Crown Tourney. (ie copy of renewal confirmation from the Society Website)
- Must provide a copy of authorization card for prospective combatant.
- Must meet any other requirement laid out by the Crown
- Must send copies to the Crown Prince and Princess (if published before Their Coronation, or The Crown if published after Their Coronation) and the Kingdom Seneschal.
- Must provide completed Declaration Form.

From The Kingdom Earl Marshal

Hello from my estates of Hundehugel.

By the time you read this, the new online Armoured Combat handbook will be live. A link to it will be in the Ealdormere library, or here:

This new handbook replaces the old Society handbook and incorporates all Ealdormere rules that differ from Society. Sections where Ealdormere does not follow Society look like the picture below.

Because all information will be in one spot Ealdormere no longer has a standalone AC handbook. It has been removed from the library.

There are only 2 new things in this handbook – Cold and Air Quality Guidelines.

This is a reminder to check your authorizations online (<https://ealdormere.ca/ealdormere-authorizations/>) to be sure that your authorizations are accurate. Take a moment to look at your authorization cards and ensure that you are not expired.

Also look at the online marshal list (<https://ealdormere.ca/ealdormere-marshals/>), to ensure you are listed if you are a warranted Marshal. If there are issues, please reach out to the MOL (ealdormere.mol@gmail.com) to have those issues corrected

8.4 Helpless opponents [edit | edit source]

1. You must not deliberately strike a helpless opponent.
2. Depending on the scenario or tournament rules, you may be allowed to declare a helpless opponent dead, ask them to yield, or allow them to regain the ability to continue safely.
3. If you get an unfair advantage by repeatedly becoming "helpless" (for example, by falling down or losing your weapon), the marshals will warn you, and if you do it again, they will force you to yield the fight. However, your opponent can ask the marshals to let the fight continue.
4. **Ealdormere additions for Helpless opponents**
 - a. In Ealdormere, "repeatedly" means three times.
 - b. A fighter using two weapons is not considered "helpless" when one weapon is dropped or lost, however a hold will be called, and the fighter warned. This is to ensure fairness in instances where a fighter may have an unprotected hand, verses those that may have a full gauntlet.
 - c. A fighter who repeatedly retreats to the edge of the field to obtain an unfair advantage shall, after being duly warned by the marshals on the field, be placed in the center of the list and considered legged. The onus of this is on the marshals, not on the opponent.

Ealdormere additions for Helpless opponents in War or Melee

1. If a fighter who is still considered alive falls to the ground during a war or melee, they may not be struck.
2. When safe, you must allow the fallen opponent to stand up, and assume a defensive stance at the spot where they fell, after which fighting may resume.
