

NEWS From the Knowne World

It's rare that a book of SCAdian history is published.

That happened recently with the publication of "St. Hildegard Coppers," produced and edited by Arion the Wanderer (Dave Peters), Minister of the Moneyers Guild of An Tir and once the apprentice of the late Ian Cnulle (Gregory Paul Franck-Weiby) who produced the dies from which the coppers were struck.

Cnulle, together with Watt Kidman (Walt Patrick), produced the St. Hildegard Coppers, or folles, also well known as "baraks," as trade tokens accepted by merchants largely in An Tir but that remain popular with gaming enthusiasts and collectors throughout the Society.

You may already know that the St. Hildegard Coppers are the hot-struck 1-inch diameter, 1/8-inch thick coppers, each weighing in at about 14 grams, that gave a satisfying heft and jingle in the hand and pouch and enjoyed circulation throughout the kingdoms. Outside the SCA, the coppers feature in multiple volumes of Krause Publications' "Unusual World Coins" as "Coinage of the Realm" and their collector base is international.

However, there has been little available to explain where the coppers came from, who designed them and what part they played in SCAdian history.

Until now.

"St. Hildegard Coppers" provides that history and, for the first time anywhere, high quality images of the copper types and descriptions written by Cnulle himself.



Note: Please be aware for the tournament, we will be having MOLs. Please make sure to bring proof of authorization, and to check in with them for the tournament.

Non authorized fencers will be used as bye fighters. They will be marked with colored tape on arm to denote them as the bye fighters Overall, the tournament will consist of round robin pools feeding into a 16-person double elimination tree. There will likely be 8 pools, but this may shift depending on the number of entrants and the demands of space.

General rules:

To allow for maximum use of available space, gear bags, cases, and the like will not be permitted in the fighting space. There should be another room which will be available to keep the bulk of your gear.

Double kills will be refought until clean. Excessive numbers of double kills in a pairing will be frowned upon. Learn to parry. At the beginning of a bout, fencers will be positioned out of measure, or as far as possible as the list size allows.

If there is an issue with list boundaries, fencers will NOT be recentered by the marshals. After the pools, beginning with the larger lists for double elimination, ring-outs might be used. In summary, list ropes will be placed for safety. *Inside* the safety ropes, the list will be marked on the floor. If part of a fencer's body is placed on the ground outside the list, they will take a loss. Note that this will be dependent on the space and time constraints of the day.

Pools:

During the pools, entrants will be required to fight with a single one-handed sword only. Pairings will consist of a single pass. If ties

need to be broken to determine who makes it out of the pool, we will first use who beat who to break ties. (e.g., if Fencer A and Fencer B both have the same number of wins, but Fencer A beat Fencer B in their match in the pool, Fencer A will advance over Fencer B.)

Double Elimination Tree:

This will be a standard double-elimination bracket. Each pairing will be single pass. Those fencers who have not taken a loss will be restricted to fighting with a single one-handed sword. Fencers who have taken a loss may use whatever legal weapon style they choose. The final four will see the undefeated fencers paired against those with a loss. Those with a loss will need to win twice in order to advance into the finals. Undefeated fencers will need to win once to advance into the finals. Weapon restrictions for undefeated fencers remain in effect as long as they have not taken a loss. The finals will be the same format that Ryou and Indrakshi's Crown Tournament used. In summary, they will be best 4 of 7. The first pass will be fought with longsword. The loser of this (and subsequent passes) will select the weapon form of the next match.

In the event that the fencers tie 3-3 and go to a seventh match, they may bring their best form and are not required to match.

In addition to our grand tournament, we will also bring you a tantalizing dayboard and other activities for the populace to enjoy.

Tentative schedule is as follows:
9:00 AM - Site Opens to Public
10:00 AM - Morning Court (At Their Majesties' Discretion)
11:00 AM - Tournament Begins (Fencing in Upstairs Hall)
12:00 PM - Dayboard Begins
4:00 PM - All Lists Close (Including Pick-ups)
5:00 PM - Court (At Their Majesties' Discretion)
7:00 PM - Site Closes to the Public and Clean-up Begins
8:00 PM - Site Closes

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

The tournament will consist of round robin pools fought with single sword, then feeding into a 16 person double elimination tree. Number of pools will be determined by the number of entrants.

General rules:

PLEASE NOTE Fencers, please wear non-marking shoes

To allow for maximum use of available space, gear bags, cases, and the like must all be stored along the walls as neatly as possible, as there is limited floor space.

Double kills will be refought until clean. Excessive numbers of double kills in a pairing will be frowned upon.

At the beginning of a bout, fencers will be positioned out of measure, or as far as possible as the list size allows.

If there is an issue with list boundaries, fencers will not be recentered by the marshals.

Pools:

During the pools, entrants will be required to fight with a single one handed sword only. Pairings will consist of a single pass. If ties need to be broken to determine who makes it out of the pool, we will first use cumulative pool scoring to determine the winner. (e.g., if Fencer A and Fencer B both have the same number of wins, but Fencer A beat Fencer B in their match in the pool, Fencer A will advance over Fencer B.)

Double Elimination Tree:

This will be a standard double elimination bracket. Each pairing will be a single pass. Those fencers who have not taken a loss will be restricted to fighting with a single one handed sword. Fencers who have taken a loss may use whatever legal weapon style they choose.

The Final Four:

The undefeated fencers paired against those with a loss. Those with a loss will need to win twice in order to advance into the finals. Undefeated fencers will need to win once to advance into the finals. Weapon restrictions for undefeated fencers remain in effect as long as they have not taken a loss.

The Finals:

Same format that Ryou and Indrakshi's Crown Tournament used, best 4 of 7. The first pass will be fought with longsword. The loser of this (and subsequent) passes will select the weapon form of the next match. In the event that the fencers tie 3-3 and go to a seventh match, they may bring their best form and are not required to match.

Pickups may be fought in the grass or parking lot outside, weather permitting, NOT IN THE GRAVEYARD.

There will be two rounds, then the Finals. You will perform up to three times. If you are cut after rounds one or two, you may be called up to perform one of your other prepared pieces (as time allows) as between-rounds entertainment for the crowd.

One of your first two pieces must be a documented period piece. Your documentation need not be extensive - the name, time period, and author/composer are sufficient. The other piece may be any selection of your choosing. However, no modern filks in any round, please.

Your Finals piece should match the theme of the event (Silk Roads: Shared Bonds Of East and West). One week before the day of the championship, we will update this listing with a specific element you will need to include. The expectation is that you will make a minor adjustment to an existing plan to incorporate, not that you will create an entirely new plan at that time. Please do not wait until the last week to research/choose/compose a piece.

You should bring a "bard card." This is an index card that contains:
Your name with a short version of your "bardic resume".
