May the gifts of Yule—peace, joy, and good fortune—find their place at every table.




As Máni steers his silver ship into the year ahead, may he light your path.

# Rowany Courtly Music Recital

Greetings to Lochac,

This is a planning post for the Courtly Music Recital at next year's Rowany Festival. (This message has also been shared in the Lochac Musicians and Performers Facebook group.)

The Courtly Music Recital is an indoor event for period music and spoken word performances, which has been held each Festival for almost a decade now (time flies, doesn't it?). It's open to anyone who wants to perform, at any skill level, as long as the performance is under five minutes and suitable for a mixed-age audience. If you're interested in performing at the recital, or attending as an audience member, please read on.

At the most recent recital, I asked the people who were present for feedback about how the event had evolved over time, and how they would like it to evolve in future. The three main points that came up were:

1. Now that Sunday is FAT/RAT day, the recital should move to a different time so that it's easier for people to attend.
2. We should advertise the recital more to encourage the general populace to come and watch.
3. We should try out inviting Royal and/or Baronial guests, so that the Recital has a higher profile and performers get more visibility.

All of these are things I'm very willing to try out, but I want to make sure I'm hearing from people who WEREN'T present this year as well. Would it work to move the recital to another time? Monday morning, maybe, since there's usually heavy war that day?

Do we want to encourage a larger audience? And finally, do we want the more formal kind of activity that comes with having thrones in the room?

If we did invite Royal/Baronial guests, I feel like a good way to handle it would be to book a two hour timeslot, with the first hour for the formal part of the recital, and the second hour available for anyone who wasn't comfortable performing before the Crown. That would also allow us to maybe have advance sign-ups, with early sign-ups getting first dibs on performance slots in the first hour, so that we could tell if we needed to seek out more performers in order to have a full program, while still having extra time available for people who decided to perform after getting to the event. But the question of HOW we manage having a potential Royal/Baronial presence is one that comes after WHETHER we should do that.

So please, if you have thoughts on the three points above, as a potential performer or audience member at the recital, let me know!

# SCANZ Meeting

Greetings to all members of SCANZ,

There will be a Special General Meeting for SCANZ members held at Canterbury Fair, on 18 January at 7:30pm at Canterbury Fair, in the Main Hall.

There will be just one item of business at the meeting as below.

All SCANZ members present at Canterbury Fair are invited to attend. Other CF attendees may join as observers.

(Astute readers may note that this is 3 days less than the 6 weeks notice period of a general meeting required by our current constitution. Our bad, but having the SGM on the evening before the main CF activity starts is the least inconvenient time, and much better than trying to fit it into some other time during CF. Please bear with us).

## **Agenda for the meeting:**

Proposed that two changes be made to the 2025 constitution. These changes are a single item of business, meaning that either both or neither of these changes will be made, according to the vote at the meeting.

Change 1. Remove clause d) from section 1.6.3 under "The purposes of the society" and renumber the remaining clauses of that section.

***1.6.3 But SCANZ will not operate for the financial gain of members simply if SCANZ - ...***  
***d. provides benefits to members or their families to alleviate hardship,"***

**Change 2. Add a clause in section 11.1 "Alterations to the constitution", and renumber the following parts of that section.**

***"11.1.2 No addition to, deletion from or alteration of the organisation's rules shall be made which would allow personal financial gain to any individuals. The provisions and effect of this clause shall not be removed from this document and shall be included and implied into any document replacing this document."***

## **The background to these changes:**

Inland Revenue Department has requested that we make these changes to our constitution to maintain our income tax deduction as a not-for-profit organisation. We have disputed the need for these changes since we consider that the current wording is allowed for in the Incorporated Societies Act 2022, either explicitly for the first text, or implicitly for the second text - all incorporated societies are required be not-for-profit by law anyway.

The Incorporated Societies Office are following up with IRD as to why we have been asked to removed a clause that has been provided by law. We suspect the IRD staff member who made the request for these changes was not aware of its origin.

Unfortunately, communicating with IRD appears to be a very slow process and we are running out of time, so this SGM will be to approve these changes so that we can avoid any tax issues while negotiation happens. Should further discussions with IRD result in our not requiring its removal before the meeting, we will not vote on it. If (more likely) the IRD discussion runs on past 18 January, we vote to remove it, noting that we may change it back in the future, if IRD can be talked around.

What happens if these changes are not accepted? SCANZ will face a considerably increased tax bill, since the \$1000 tax deduction for not-for-profit organisations will not be available. The committee recommends that these changes be passed by the meeting.
