This month, the Outlands is hosting Virtual Known World and Heraldic Symposium (vKWHSS)! It is the weekend of January 23–25, starting about noon on Friday and ending about 5 pm on Sunday. The event is fully online (classes are on Zoom, with Discord used for announcements, handouts, and the like) and free to attend. You can register at any time up to the start of the event at kwhss.sca.org. Please don't hesitate to reach out to me or the other event staff if you have any questions.

Also, it's January, so Domesday reports are coming due. If you are an at-large herald, please take the time to submit a summary of the work you have done in the past year at: portal.outlands.org/officers/reports. I am working on a review and update of the roster, including promotion, and the best way to tell me what you have been doing (especially if you do your work places I can't physically see it) is to report!

Finally, a reminder to all group heralds, in particular Baronial heralds, that it is your responsibility to ensure that court reports for non-Royal courts are submitted in a timely fashion (Blue Iris does this for Royal courts). The herald who conducts the court is expected to actually submit the report, but if you are the herald for the hosting group and you didn't conduct it, you should reach out to the herald in charge and ensure that a report was submitted in a timely fashion. This is the only way we can ensure that people's OPs (especially for Baronial awards) are correct and up-to-date. Remember the motto of the College of Arms: Non Scripta, Non Est (if it is not written, it does not exist).
