Northshield Open Position Descriptions

TANG Job description

The Transitional and New Groups Deputy (TANG) is a

lesser officer to the Kingdom Seneschal and is responsible for administering and facilitating the recognition, advancement, and dissolution processes for groups. They are also responsible for administering and facilitating the polling process for baronial changeovers. The TANG reports to the Kingdom Seneschal. This is primarily a hybrid hands-on and administrative role. The TANG is responsible for ensuring that the following duties are completed by themselves or such assistants as they deem necessary.

These duties include delivering and meeting deadlines for the following:

- Educating groups on the transition process.
- Meeting with group leadership either in-person or virtually as needed.
- Educating baronies on polling and result process.
- Implement Baronial polling and send results to both the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal.
- Supporting transitioning groups and maintaining contact with group leadership in order to
- ensure groups are operating within the transitional process.
- Maintain documentation and suggest process improvements.
- Be a good steward of kingdom and baronial resources where applicable.
- Identify, put forward, manage and train successors and assistants.
- Reporting quarterly in accordance with the Seneschal's office or more frequently as needed.

WORKLOAD:

Workload varies and is dependent on baronial and transitional group needs.

A typical baronial polling requires approximately 10 hours of work a week.

The position does not require travel but may be beneficial for remote groups.

- Dependable email access
- Dependable high-speed internet access
- Dependable social media access
- Demonstrable ability to interface and communicate both verbally and in writing with many
- personality types
- Demonstrable ability to maintain a schedule and communication lines
- Demonstrable ability to organize a survey and compile data in an easy to comprehend format

New Commentary Request: Proposed addition to Corpora, Confidentiality and Royals.

As part of a proposed change to address a gap in Corpora regarding confidentiality, we invite you to provide commentary on the language changes in Corpora that this update will require. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter. Deadline for commentary is September 20, 2026.

Please note these are proposed ADDITIONS to Corpora, nothing is being removed. All emphasis marks (bold/italic/etc) are provided to help clarify.

Proposed addition to Corpora, Confidentiality and Royals. Amendments to Corpora IV.C.1 and Corpora X.B. Approved 07-19-2026 by the Board of Directors for release for commentary:

Purpose: This change is requested to address a gap in Corpora regarding confidentiality expectations for officers. Royals are defined as officers within Corpora (see Glossary, "Officers"). However, unlike officers with a kingdom or Society superior officer, they are neither warranted for these offices, nor governed by a Board-approved handbook, that explicitly outlines confidentiality obligations.

Given the nature of this access, Royals, as officers, must be held to the same standards of confidentiality as other officers. As they are officers without warrant or handbook, this gap would be addressed

and codified in Corpora (which is a higher document in the precedence of law).

In their roles regarding sanctions, Royals are routinely granted access to highly sensitive information, such as the details of names, places, and allegations with regard to kingdom investigations and the judicious application of Royal sanctions, as outlined in the Sanctions Procedures and Policies Manual (2024).

The proposed addition to Corpora seeks to clearly establish the confidentiality obligations for these officers, as it is with other warranted officers, based on their role and access to sensitive information.

Fundamental addition: Specifically reiterating the role of Royals as officers, and as officers, their obligations for maintaining confidentiality during, and after, the investigation process and any sanctions that may follow.

IV.ROYALTY

C. Duties

1. Royalty, and the Royal Heirs, are officers of SCA, Inc., and/or its Affiliates, as defined in the Glossary found in Corpora. As such, Royalty must know and uphold the laws of their realm and Corpora.

X. GRIEVANCES

B. Sanctions

1. Sanctions

ADD: Confidentiality Within the Sanction Process (make this item 1 and 2, renumbering the remaining items accordingly).

1. Confidentiality Within the Sanction Process. Maximizing confidentiality in all aspects of the sanction process is necessary for people to feel free to speak openly and honestly about situations being investigated. To that end, all aspects of the investigation and resulting sanction, if any, are to be kept strictly confidential, except as necessary to investigate a matter or put into effect any sanction that may be issued. Officers and royalty involved in potential sanctions are prohibited from commenting on any sanction, or investigation into any matter that may lead to a sanction. Commenting includes, but is not limited to, revealing the identities of complainants or witnesses, and publicly stating facts or opinions regarding the matter beyond necessary announcements.

2. The duty to maintain confidentiality is a continuing obligation that survives the conclusion of the investigation, the completion, expiration, or removal of any sanction, and the

for disciplinary action or sanction, independent of the outcome of the underlying matter. Such action may include removal from office, revocation of warrant, additional sanctions, or other remedies as authorized under Corpora and governing policies.

New Commentary Request: Proposed update to AC-rattan weapon construction

The Society Earl Marshal and Deputy Marshal for Armored Combat is pleased to make available for commentary the proposed update to AC-rattan weapon construction: Commentary must be received no later than July 31, 2026.

Proposed update to AC-rattan weapon construction: Create 2 categories of weapons with heads: 1) Constructed heads – these are the current rules, #13.2.13 (Armored Combat: Equipment standards – Handheld weapons – Marshal Rules Wiki)

2) Integral heads – a proposed new option. While weapons of this type have been in use for years in some kingdoms (aka "carved or turned maces"), they don't meet current rules on weapon construction. This option would allow these to be used, within the new standards on their construction.

The handbook would include the following changes (changes are in italics)

13.2.13 For weapons with a constructed head: (Remove: If a weapon has a head)

a) The head must not be constructed of only rigid materials. (*rattan is a rigid material*)

b) The head must be firmly and securely attached to the haft.

c) The head must allow at least 1/2 inch (12.7 mm) of progressive give between the striking surface and the weapon haft.

d) Semi-rigid ultra-lightweight shaped foam heads, or split rattan construction techniques do not require 1/2 inch (12.7 mm) of progressive give, as long as their construction provides striking characteristics similar to an unpadded weapon constructed of a single piece of rattan.

e) Pick heads must be made from a flexible material. Rattan cannot be used in the construction on the pick head.

13.2.14 For weapons with an integral head (e.g. *carved or turned rattan*):

a) *Must be constructed of a single piece of rattan for the whole weapon, not to exceed 30 inches (760 mm).*

b) *The head must be carved or turned to be significantly larger than the diameter of the haft to create a striking area clearly distinct from the haft, and be at least 3 inches (76 mm) in length.*

c) Maces constructed in this manner do not require the head to have 1/2 inch (12.7 mm) of progressive give.

d) Bar maces (maces with no haft section) and similar weapons are strictly prohibited.

13.2.15 Rattan used in weapons must be less than 2 1/4 inches in diameter.

Example: a "turned mace" with a head of 2.25 inches and a haft/handle of 1.25 inches. This results in a 1/2 inch difference between the head and the haft, creating a clear striking area.

After discussions with the KEMs and the kingdoms using weapons of this type, we determined that (1) they are safe, due to being similar or smaller in size as other allowed rattan weapons, and (2) its use as a mass weapon does not confer an undue

advantage (ie. it handles and moves like a mass weapon, and not as a very light sword with mass weapon advantage).

As this is a significant change to construction of weapons with heads, we are seeking feedback from the AC-rattan community. (i.e. instead of always requiring padding for weapons with heads, we would add an option that does not require padding).

Show Us Your Receipts!

Competition Concept The heart and soul of A&S is to educate the community at large on historical topics related to the science, crafts, and industry of historical people. However, the tools and materials used in A&S in the SCA can be expensive which may make it intimidating to approach. This is what our competition seeks to address. We want this to be a competition that shows that material costs aren't everything, and that projects can be done at a variety of price points, using thrift and creativity.

Competition Format Each entrant will provide a project, an object biography, and the associate receipts for the materials used in the construction of the project. Receipts must be provided for all of the materials that have been consumed in the creation process, but not for tools used. See table below for examples:

CONSUMED MATERIAL	NON-CONSUMED MATERIALS
Thread, Buttons, Fabric, Wood, Glue, Nails, Stone, Mortar, Wax, Wicks, etc.	Sewing needles, Sewing machines, Saws, Hammers, Drills, Looms, etc.

There will be three cost divisions: \$25, \$50, and \$100. Actual receipts must be presented to the judges during object registration, and a list of costs should be provided in the object biography so the populace can see the total cost of the project. Project receipts must come in below the category limit in order to be included in their desired category. No limit on projects per person or per category, subject to space limitations.

PLEASE NOTE: Consumable materials from your stash are only eligible if you have the original receipt or if they are presented to the competition sponsors and are assigned a fair market value estimate. If materials are only partially used and the remainder can be used in a future project (e.g., used 6 buttons off a card of 10), you can include both the cost of the purchase and an estimate of the cost of the materials consumed, but category inclusion will be based on the full purchase price. If you are buying materials second hand, please try to get a receipt. Please do not buy items at a significant discount from a friend for the purpose of circumventing the pricing rules of the competition. If you do so we will be sad and you could be disqualified. Anything curb-shopped should be photographed *in situ* before being acquired and submitted to the organizers for approval before inclusion in the project. Suggested sources of materials include thrift stores, clearance bins, and other low-cost retailers that have materials that might be repurposed in unconventional ways.

Object Biography Each item should be submitted with some information to provide context for its goal and construction. This biography must include:

- A short description of the item being recreated (e.g., "a 16th c man's shirt")
- A list of the materials used and their prices (to include partial use estimates, if applicable. Actual receipts to be turned in to the competition sponsors)
 - OPTIONAL: estimated cost if a more traditional source had been used (i.e., wood from a woodworker's specialty store would cost \$X, but this piece reclaimed from a broken picture frame cost \$X)
- A list of non-consumable tools used in the production
- Any sources consulted, whether it is a person, website, or book (no specific format required, just a list of basic info is fine)
- An estimate of how long it took to do the project (not scored, but just to give the viewers an idea of the time commitment of each entry)

Full documentation of the object is of course welcome, but **not** required!

Scoring Projects and receipts will be checked in at the competition table. Each entry should include the physical entry, at least the requested object biography, and all receipts associated with the project's consumable materials. There will be three categories of prizes - Populace voting, Thrift, and by Sponsor/Patron choice.

- **Populace Voting:** Each participating member of the populace will be given 3 tokens, one for each category. Most tokens in each category wins their category.
- **Thrift:** in each category, the entry that is the lowest cost, without being appropriately included in the next-lowest-cost category will win the category.
- **Patron Choice:** The patrons of this competition will, at their discretion, award prizes to their favorite entries. If you are interested in sponsoring a prize and being an additional patron, please reach out to the organizers.
