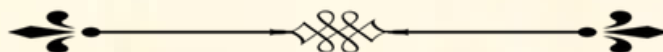

- Ealasaid Sionnach. Name and device. Per chevron gules and argent, a crescent pendant azure fimbriated argent and a fox's mask gules maintaining a trefoil knot vert. Nice cant on sionnach, meaning fox!

From the Kingdom A&S Officer



Greetings, Lochac!

The next Championship round will be held at Spring Crown, in Dismal Fogs on September 5. Themes for this round are 'Feastware', 'Footwork' and 'The Holy Roman Empire'.

Ways to enter:

- Bring your entry to the event or send it with a trusted friend.

Complete an entry form to go with it which can be located here
<https://artsandsciences.lochac.sca.org/how-to-enter-kingdom-competition/>.

On the day, make sure you locate the A&S table as early as possible, and put your entry and paperwork there for the judges to assess. Late entries may not be able to be judged.

Judging usually begins straight after invocation court. This is an intensive process and takes a lot of time - please give the volunteers space (drinks and snacks are welcome!). Entries can be collected at the end of the afternoon, when judging has been completed.

- Online entry

This is a trial for A.S LXI; information is here <https://artsandsciences.lochac.sca.org/lochacs-as-competitions/enter-kingdom-competition/online-submission-trial/>. Digital entries are easy to forward to the Cockatrice editor, should you wish.

- Local judging.

This option is for entries which cannot be presented at the event (or you may like to try the new online submission process).

Online submissions and entries for local judging are due by 15th August. This allows time to arrange early judging and send in the results, so that overall winners can be announced (and prizes given) at the event.

Incidentally, I am enjoying the recent fashion for holding 'judging parties' in local groups. This is where early/online entries are assessed

in an atmosphere of conviviality and comfort (and yummy snacks). It seems to be working well for everyone!

Coming soon: Research Rubric

I am trying to finalise a new form specifically for research entries. I hope to publish it in time for this round, but we shall see - every time I think it is ready, more alterations become necessary...fingers crossed.

Please speak to your local officer, or email artsandsciences@lochac.sca.org, if you need assistance with any of this. I look forward to seeing some beautiful and innovative entries for September!

It has been apparent for a long while that the existing A&S rubric is quite useful for most entries, where there is an actual item to be judged. It even works for performance entries - but falls down when the submission is a research paper. The wording of the rubric just doesn't fit with an entry of this kind, requiring a lot of extra consideration from the judges, and potentially leaving the entrant dissatisfied or confused about their result.

I have been working to remedy this for some time (ahem...about two years...), and have finally got something which I hope will fill the gap. There is now a dedicated form for Research-only submissions. The General Entry Form has also been slightly updated (and renamed).

Research Entry Form

The entire rubric has been re-written to suit the needs of entries which are information-only, without a physical object or performance to go with the text.

I hope this will make it much easier for our judges to fairly assess such work, and for entrants to understand where they can improve, or why a particular score was given.

There is a new area on the front page, for entrants to indicate how much modern



technological input is in their composition. The point is not to forbid or control the use of such supporting technologies, merely to encourage openness around their use.

Naturally, an entry which has been copied straight from Wikipedia, or generated by AI, will be less valuable than a paper researched and written by the actual entrant - as it always has been. We encourage people to learn new things and extend our understanding of history, rather than blindly accepting whatever appears in front of them.

How to use:

Research entrants should submit this new form with their research papers. It should also be available during every judging session, in case of research entries turning up without attached paperwork (just as there should always be copies of the General Entry Form on hand). Judges will refer to the appropriate rubric while assessing a research entry, and provide feedback based upon that rubric. This is exactly the same process everyone is used to, just with a research focus!

General Entry Form

The 'Entry Form and Judging Report' is now the 'General Entry Form'. The judging of general entries has not changed. Mostly, the update is to differentiate clearly between this and the new form, and to add the declaration box on the front page.

PICTURE: To the right is a beautiful example of 2/2 Interlaced sprang bag by the Barony of Politarchopolis' current A&S Champion Lady Igulfríðr Magnúsdóttir. Sprang is a weftless weaving/braiding technique that creates a stretchy fabric and dates back at least 3,500 years which was used to create complex patterns of lace and netting depending on technique and pattern used. In this example to the right, each cotton thread was woven over two threads then under two threads like twill weave turned on a 45 degree angle. While there is evidence of cotton being used in this period, such weaving was more often seen in linen and wool, and very occasionally silk. The bag's cord is a simple whipcord (4 thread round braid) in the same cotton. For those interested, Lady Igulfríðr gave a lecture about sprang weaving through the Tri-Kingdom University which is well worth the watch and can be viewed here https://youtu.be/X_ELVu3hjqQ?si=kG5lzx4y13l_bzG. From the Kingdom Chirurgeon



**Greetings all, it is I, your Friendly
Neighbourhood Kingdom Chirurgeon.**

When I was offered a spot to do a missive in Pegasus, we jumped at the opportunity to do so.

So what's new in the Chirurgeonate? Behind the scenes we're working on the following:

- Improved online incident reporting
- A new guidebook (not to be confused with the Chirurgeon Handbook) designed for new or unexperienced medics and Chirurgeons-at-Large in an SCA-context
- Reviewing policies and guidelines
- Updating the website.

I would also be remiss if I don't offer some basic tips to keep not only yourself, but others healthy (or preventing it from getting worse):

- Hail Hydrate - stay hydrated, even in our colder months and even when not exerting yourself.
- Don't be afraid to ask a chirurgeon for medical help, even if it's just a bandaid. This, however, does not include asking mundane Doctor chirurgeons for scripts or medications.
- Please alert a chirurgeon if you see someone in distress, medical or otherwise. Don't assume they'll be okay or someone

else will take care of it - we must look after each other.

- If you are a Group Chirurgeon, please report! Even if it's to say 'I have nothing to report'. We like to hear that the Kingdom is incident-free and that you haven't been taken away by a rampaging squirrel army... (don't ask).
- If you're a combatant, please go see a chirurgeon if you take any blow that's 'solid' or you feel will take a while to heal. We don't want to take away your fun, but we want to minimise any time and expense you'll need to recover.

I would also like to take this opportunity to reach out to any medical professional (Minimum of a First Aid Certificate with CPR) or those interested in becoming a Chirurgeon-at-Large (a Kingdom recognised medical person that's not necessarily linked to a specific group other than Lochac). The upside? Belonging to a like-minded group to talk shop, receive or offer support if/when you need it, and only have to do reports when you treat someone. If this sounds appealing, please drop us an email and say hi!

Greetings populace of Lochac,

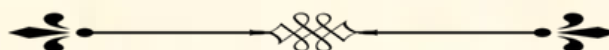

Dear Populace,

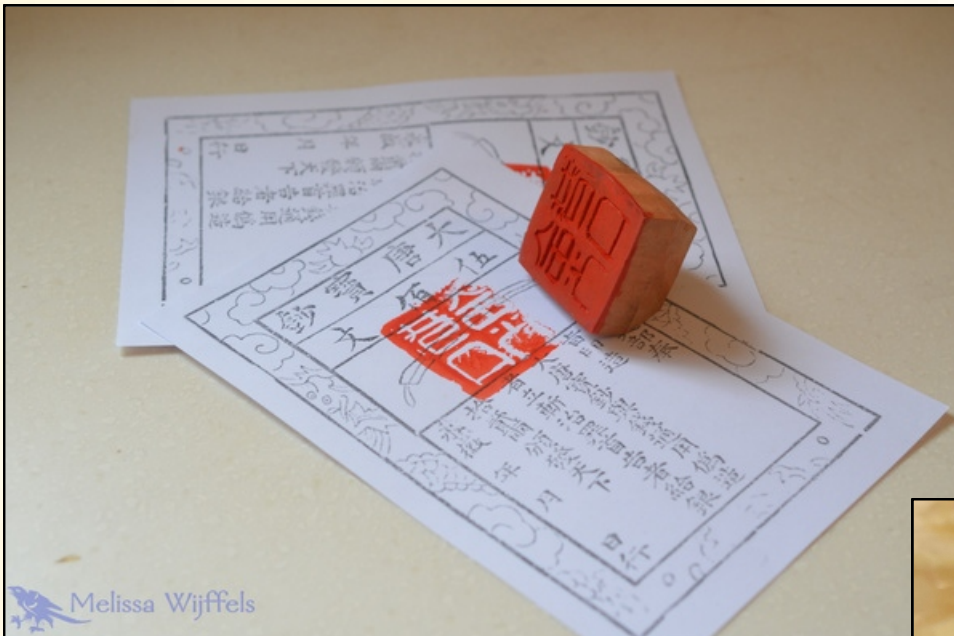

PICTURE: Above is a reproduction of a bank note from the Tang Dynasty (618-907AD), used to certify a deposit coins with the bank. The text on the note details the punishment for forgery and the amount of money that was deposited. The issuing bank (later the government) would stamp the notes to help prevent forgery. This reproduction was used at the opening of 金火港口 / Jin Huo Gangkou, Treasure Fire Harbour aka The Bank of Ildhafn for the event at this year's Dumpling Fest VI in the Canton of Cluain. It was stamped by Their Excellencies Baroness Isabella and Baroness Eleanor of Ildhafn during the opening of the Dumpling Feast using a stamp carved from wood by the Kingdom's A&S Champion TH Lady Melissa Wijffles. The bank notes were modified from the original by TH Lord Nathanael d'Avranches to have varying denominations and were used for gambling games at the event. *Photo courtesy of Melissa Wijffles. Dear Populace,

The Board of Directors for SCA Ltd (Australia) is calling for new general Board members. The Board currently has at least one member from all states and territories except the fine states of Victoria and Queensland which currently have no members on the Board. The Board highly encourages nominations from these states in particular.

A seat on the Board is not terribly onerous, there are meetings once a month over Zoom, and occasionally emails to discuss and pass motions out of session. The Board are the contact between our in-game SCA world and the Mundane world. The Board makes and amends policies that affect the way our Game is played and ensures we meet our mundane legal requirements as a corporation.

The Board liaises with SCA Inc. in the United States and our affiliates in SCANZ in New Zealand, and occasionally other international branches! Board terms are approximately 3 years in length but we have had members serve for between 12 months and 4 years previously, and are flexible as to when your time on the Board ends.

A good general knowledge of business practices, writing policies, looking up mundane laws or requirements, and strong communication skills are greatly appreciated but are not necessary to serve on the Board. General Board members are expected to have 2-3 hrs of time for Board business a week, with Executive Board members (e.g., Chair, Treasurer and Secretary) expected to do 5-8 hrs of Board business a week. The Board is **ONLY** looking for general Board members at this time.

PICTURE: The strand of glass beads in the picture to the left were created by the head of the Glass Workers Guild Lord Thorbjorn Bjarnylr from the Barony of Southron Gaard. This strand was commissioned by Jarl Porvaldr inn Suðreyski during his reign as King of Lochac and while the strand is mostly glass there are a few metal beads to string it together. The style is Anglo Saxon circa 600AD, and rather than a reproduction from that era, Lord Thorbjorn drew inspiration from many styles including those traded from Egypt and what is now modern day Iran. This strand is unique in that it is made up of many large polychrome beads and only a few monochrome ones (which would have been more common at the time to bulk out the strand). *Photo and words courtesy of Lord Thorbjorn Bjarnylr.*

Greetings Lochac,

The time has come (it's actually way overdue) for me to step down as the Guild Administrator for the Cook's Guild and call for expressions of interest in being the new Guild administrator.

The official duties of the Administrator, as set out in the Guild Charter, are as follows:

The Guild Administrator:

The administrative head shall be known as the Guild Administrator and may be of any rank. The Guild Administrator must maintain a current file of members and reply to their correspondence.

Each member's rank and progress must be recorded and filed. It is the duty of the Guild Administrator to notify members of their change in rank as it occurs. He or she should maintain and augment any Guild resources or index. The Guild Administrator reports to the Crown, the Lochac Minister of A&S and the Lochac Seneschal prior to Twelfth Night.

The Guild Administrator may appoint deputies and assistants as necessary (including, but not limited to, a newsletter editor and Web minister) and may appoint a substitute to run the Annual General Meeting if unable to attend).

The Administrative Head of the Guild should hold office for not more than two years (unless no other acceptable candidate is available. If this occurs, the administration position is renewed for a further six months until a replacement can be found).

The Administrator will select their successor based on merit and ability, and shall notify the Guild members in writing of change of administration details. If possible, the Administration position is to be passed to a Guild member from a different geographic area, ensuring Kingdom-wide rotation of position.

In the event of proven incompetence or mismanagement, an Administrator may be removed from the position by a majority vote of all active members.

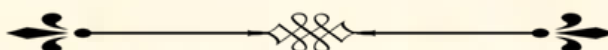

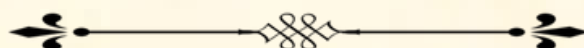

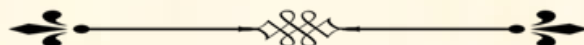
