Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event.
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

As you may already know, Medieval Week is a tourist event where SCA presence has varied over the years. Our barony of Styringheim always does an amazing work with all things SCA-related, and in recent years the camp is shared with other re-enactors, making it possible to form new friendships and bridge the gap that sometimes exist between us and other societies. If you have the chance, we strongly recommend everyone to travel to the island of Gotland in the future and experience Medieval Week! It has been the highlight of our year for 30 years now.

Cudgel wars was also an amazing experience. Having talked about going there for a long time, we finally got around to it and we couldn't be happier. All the rumours were true! The welcoming people of Aarnimetsä, the food, the lake, the sauna ... we are definitely coming back!

The Queen was also very well received in Frostheim for Broken Arrow. Lots of archery of course, a fire show on the beach under the midnight sun and a barbeque feast are only some of the fond memories she will take with her from this event.

A worrying thing did occur at Broken Arrow which we have to address, even though the matter has now been sorted. During the 3D shoot, to Her Majesty's shock and dismay, a cameleopard (giraffe) was one of the targets. A cameleopard is on her personal device, and Princess Elsa and Princess Padraig of Nordmark made them a protected species long ago. In her mercy, the Queen did not immediately execute those responsible, but gave them a chance to repent at a court during Cudgel Wars. The brave lord Eino appeared at this court, assuring Her Majesty and a representative of the cameleopard species that the wounded individual had received the best of care and will live out the rest of his days at the Monkey Island. Greetings from the Seneschal

Greetings and salutations, good gentles of Drachenwald!

Topic for the month: thoughts on "regions"... When I became Tova's deputy, her primary task for me was to clarify what "Central region" really meant, which led to the general question of what is a "region".

In general, the SCA does not recognize "regions" as an official administrative entity, the closest analogue would be a principality

or perhaps province. It is also completely normal for baronies and shires to report directly to kingdom officers, without an intermediary administrative level.

Nor is the concept of "regions" defined in Kingdom Law, the only 'official' reference to it (that I have found) is associated with the rotation scheme for Kingdom events. Beyond that, "regions" are simply a term of convenience to refer to subsets of the Kingdom.

It's also somewhat a misnomer to refer to someone as a "regional" officer, considering "regions" are not administrative entities and therefore would not have officers. Technically they are a deputy kingdom officer given responsibility by the kingdom officer for a specific geographical area.

Thus my conclusions:

- (1) "Regions" are not branches of the SCA nor an administrative entity in their own right.
- (2) There is no need for a "region" to have the roster of officers one would expect of a branch of the SCA.
- (3) The existence of an office with responsibility for a "region" is at the discretion of a kingdom officer who wants a deputy to help manage/coordinate things in a particular geographic area.

With respect to Central specifically: from what I've seen, there is insufficient interest or activity for Central to move in the direction of principality any time soon. Nor do I feel that I need a deputy to be an intermediary for the local branches in that area, so I am eliminating the "Deputy Kingdom Seneschal for Central Region" office.

To be clear: I'm not discouraging the use of such terms; I just wanted to clarify what they mean. If anyone has further thoughts on this, please feel free to reach out!
