- **Group name**• Name of the group hosting the event. Must be an official group.
- **Location and directions**• Name and directions to the legal address of the site.
- **Event Steward**• Event Steward's Society name, a contact phone number with area code, and email address. **Mundane name and address are no longer required.**
- **Registration**• Member & non-Member for event, with deadlines (for pre-registration) as necessary. If there is a Registration for the event, the following statement must be included beneath the \$ amounts: "Make checks payable to SCA, Inc./(group name)." If the event is free, say so!
- **Activities**• Brief synopsis of event—fighting, arts & sciences, merchants, et cetera.
- **Site Restrictions**—wet or dry, no animals, no smoking, et cetera.
- **Accessibility**—handicap parking & entrance/exit ramps, uneven terrain, et cetera.
- **Duration**• Start and stop time of the event.

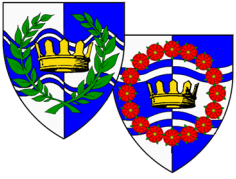

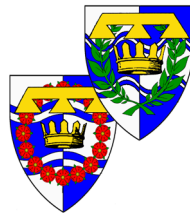

Please submit letters of intent for the office to me, seneschal@officer.atlantia.sca.org as well as to her at socialmedia@seneschal.atlantia.sca.org.

Letters of intent can be submitted beginning August 1st and that timeframe will run for thirty days, ending on August 31st. Her warrant ends in October, so the time between will be spent in training the new person, to ensure that they have an understanding of the office, and to facilitate a smooth transition in that office. The job description is below, for reference:

"The Kingdom Social Media Officer (KSMO) is a deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal's office. They are responsible for administration and moderation of the Kingdom's Official social Media Channels. These include Facebook, Bluesky, Instagram, Discord, TikTok, X, and any other social Media platforms approved by the Society Social Media office. The KSMO reports directly to the Society Social Media/Corporate Communications officer. The Kingdom Social Media officer's duties include: Creating and Maintaining the Kingdom's presence on various platforms; creating content for entertainment and recruitment purposes; moderating the various Social Media pages and upholding the rules of said pages; creating event pages for Kingdom Level Events in coordination with the autocrats of the event: being an emergency contact for Official pages for Kingdom Groups and offices (Baronial pages, Newcomers group, etc); maintaining a list of warranted Baronial and Group SMOs (University, Newcomer's Group etc); hosting an annual SMO Meeting at Unevent."

Greetings unto the Kingdom of Atlantia!

(Please respect his decision and give him privacy.) As you can imagine, this left us having to make a choice very quickly to maintain the smooth running of our kingdom. Though he will be missed, we must make sure that business continues. With that being said, I, in consultation with Their Majesties, have requested an individual to serve as an interim, until the position can be filled, according to Kingdom Law. I would like to point out that Kingdom Law allows, in the case of urgency, for an individual to be appointed by the Crown, in consultation with the Kingdom Seneschal, regardless of a position they might already hold. Their Majesties and I concluded that the most obvious choice would be the individual that preceded Konrad, Ollamh Cairtina inghean Fhearghuis. She has graciously agreed to act in this position until formalities can be accomplished. We welcome her with open arms to our team and look forward to once again working with her, and we are grateful for her answering this call to service.

The official announcement is being put forth to fill the position of Kingdom Chronicler. Please read the job description, below, and if you are interested, submit letters of interest to me at seneschal@officer.atlantia.sca.org, Their Majesties at trm@atlantia.sca.org, Their Highnesses at trh@atlantia.sca.org as well as the office of the Chronicler at chronicler@officer.atlantia.sca.org. The submission timeline is a bit skewed from normal, set out a bit further due to Pennsic, so letters will be accepted until September 19, 2026. (The decision will be made within 2 weeks following this date.) Please do not wait until the last minute, if you are interested, go ahead and submit your letter once you have it prepared. This is a three-year commitment, initially.

Officially:

The Kingdom Chronicler is responsible for all in-print publishing activities within the Kingdom of Atlantia and for disseminating information of importance to the populace of Atlantia.

The duties of the office include:

- Creating a monthly newsletter that includes: Kingdom Events, Letters from Kingdom Officers or Deputies, Updating Baronial Information, Champions, Officer Information, Information from Society, Warrant all local branch Chroniclers, Updated Kingdom Calendar.
- Receiving and reviewing branch newsletters, checking for compliance
- Maintain a roster of all warranted chroniclers and their deputies, and any Deputies under the Kingdom Chronicler
- Teach Chronicler 101 at all University sessions and Unevent
- Assign deputies as needed
- Prepare recommendations for the annual Black Fox Awards
- Make changes to policy as needed
- Attend Great Officers Meeting, bi weekly, with reports of the office.

Also:

The Kingdom Chronicler, along with the Kingdom Seneschal, is responsible for maintaining the Kingdom's calendar of events. You will work closely with the Kingdom Calendar Deputy on all events that are Spiked to make sure that required information is included, and support submission deadlines.

The Kingdom Chronicler is responsible for supervising the activities of his/her/their deputies, which include the Atlantan Historian, and any other deputies the Kingdom Chronicler has need of.

To be considered for the position of Kingdom Chronicler:

- You must be at least 18+, a paid member and member in good standing
- It is preferred that you have experience as a chronicler, but not essential
- Have knowledge of word processing software, good time management skills, a professional demeanor, and excellent communication skills.
