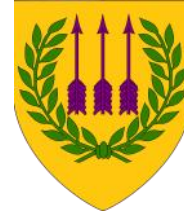

Random Carp I have Learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources **by K. Braden von Sobernheim**

Millinery, Mercery, and Haberdashery. Three industries, all with Worshipful Livery Companies of London (1604, 1394, and 1448), and maybe you can describe what they are for?

Milliners are hatmakers with the origin of the term milliner being someone from Milan, specifically the merchants who sold fancy hats, gloves, jewellery, etc. It evolved from foreign merchant to a dealer in small articles, to a woman who makes and sells hats and other accessories. Mad hatters did not come about until much later (18th-19th century) when felt production incorporated the use of mercury for better felt smoothing. Haberdashers have been mentioned since at least Chaucer's Canterbury Tales, driving from the Anglo-French *hapertas*, *a small trade good like a scrap of fabric, or beads and buttons*. The word evolved into *haberdasher*: *someone who would retail small wares, the goods of a peddler, while a mercer would specialize in larger pieces of fine fabric as well as bedding*. Mercer comes from *mercier* (French) *a person importing fabric from the Eastern world*. Mercers could sell needle and thread, but mostly leant to expensive silks and brocades. Mercery separated from general merchants in the 12th century, focusing on the high-end luxurious goods. Not surprisingly, the highest precedence Livery Company of London is the Mercers, with Haberdashers at 8 and Feltmakers/hatmakers all the way down to 63. So, Louis Vuitton might be considered a modern "mercier" while Claire's at the mall would be a "habadasher." And of course there are famous milliners around today: notably the John B. Stetson company. Enjoy your new Scrabble words, and now you know more random carp.

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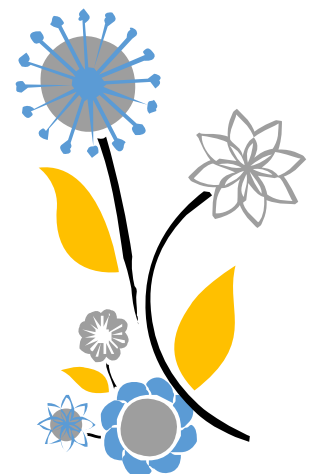
