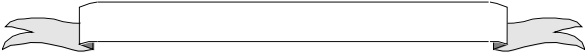

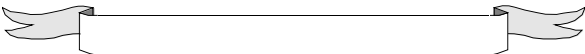

THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMENT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing - Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a senechal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

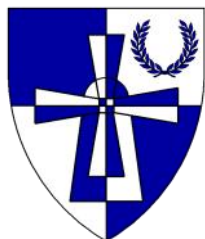

As we look forward to Coronation, we are excited to see what fall and winter bring in Æ. We could not be more proud of Æthelmearc

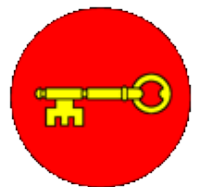

Greetings all,

An update in the rules for Rapier and Cut & Thrust was approved by the SCA Board of Directors in their June 2026 meeting and is scheduled to go into effect towards the end of September. Some of the changes include eliminating light class weapons for adults, reorganizing weapon authorizations, and a few reductions in the armor requirements. More information will be provided as the implementation time approaches.

By now, the cleaning and unpacking have begun for those of us who went to Pennsic 53. On that note, we wish to capture any rapier-related issues that came up for people at the event. Please send any reports, commentaries, etc. to my email and/or the Earl Marshal. Those emails are listed below.

For those interested, Pennsic 53 went by fast. One side won some battles, the other side won some battles, and then nature won some as well. I appreciate the work all rapier marshals (from Æthelmearc and beyond) put in. Helping with the safety and security of the 600+ rapier combatants at Pennsic is impossible without team effort.

All Rapier, Cut & Thrust, and Youth marshals are required to send in an annual report this quarter, so please have those in by August 15th.

My term as Kingdom Rapier Marshal is coming to an end, so I am putting out a call to anyone interested in the job to apply. Please submit a short letter of intent to myself, the kingdom Earl Marshal, the kingdom Seneschal, and Their Highnesses of Æthelmearc, Gareth and Juliana. All emails are listed below. Please include your background, ideas on the future of the office, and anything else that you may find relevant. Their Highnesses will ultimately choose the next person, who will start their term at Kingdom 12th Night in January 2027.

Court Report of Murdoch and Rioghnach at Bog 3 day July 12th, 2025

Documented from the Rolls and Files of the Coram Regibus of Murdoch II Rex and Ríoghnách II Regina, King and Queen of Æthelmearc: Being a True Record of the Business of Their Royal Court at the Bog 3-Day Event, 12 July, AS LX, in the Barony of St. Swithin's Bog. As recorded by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Meistr-y-gân, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, assisted by Mistress Gytha Oggdottir, Silver Sycamore Herald, Master Kieran MacRae, and Luminaria Salvatore de la Torres.

In the morning, Their Majesties wished to speak with Baron Jean Phillippe Dit Barbe Rousse. Noting the immense efforts His Excellency has been undertaking to run, replenish, and repair Iron Key not just for his own Barony, but for fighters throughout the Kingdom, They were pleased to name him a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll: Baroness Katherine Kiersey.

Their Majesties then sought Morgan. After reminding them that They brought their Youth Champion's regalia, They shared that their prowess and achievement in combat was worthy of inclusion in the Order of the Silver Alce. Scroll by The Honorable Lady Jinx (Christina Mary Lowe) with words by Lord Chaghagan Ghunan.

Their Majesties also received Eðvarð inn glaði. Noting that he had also competed himself well in the youth champions' tourney and he has been observed to be consistently chivalrous toward fellow combatants, They were also minded to make him a Companion of the Silver Alce. Scroll by The Honorable Lady Jinx (Christina Mary Lowe) with words by Lord Chaghagan Ghunan.

Next, Their Majesties requested the presence of Don Robert MacEwin of Thornhill. Hearing that it was indeed his wish to proceed to sit vigil that day, They gave leave to Sir Thorsol Solinauga to release Don Robert as his squire. Now free of any other obligations of fealty, he was joined by the Masters of the Most Noble Order of Defense to conduct him to his vigil and offer counsel.

Their Majesties then asked The Honorable Lady Rachel Dalicieux to present herself. Upon receiving her answer that at long last, she was willing to answer the summons set to her by Their Majesties' forebears, They called Mistress Arianna of Wynthrope forward to receive back her apprentice's belt and release her from all encumbrances save those of affection. Their Majesties then requested that the Most Noble Order of the Laurel take her to the place of her vigil for her to receive their counsel.

With a reminder to the populace to stay for a brief theatrical presentation on the day's historical context, Court was suspended.

In the late morning, upon the field, Their Majesties had business with the Noble Order of the Gage. Her Majesty addressed the Order, reminding them that soon, our armies would meet those of the Known World, and stating Her conviction that as a body, their prowess, their courtesy, their example, in short, would in turn remind all the forces on the field that we are, to quote the old saying, "Annual Enemies, but Eternal Friends." Yet despite that, Their Majesties felt there should be one more gentle added to their ranks before greeting our foemen. They thus demanded Lord Hartmann Foscari da Ferra to come before the Crown, whereupon They Granted him Arms and named him their Companion, and Duke Thomas Byron of Haverford presented him with his own medallion marking him as a Gage. Scroll forthcoming.

Court suspended.

In the evening, Their Majesties proclaimed it had been a wonderful, if warm, day, and hoped all had had a great time.

Their Majesties then allowed the youth of the kingdom to pursue The Honorable Lord Hartmann Foscari da Ferra to plunder the court toybox.

Their Majesties next invited all those attending their Royal Court to come forward and select one of Mistress Erzebet Fauconneau's mugs from Mistress Erzebet herself, as a gesture of welcome.

Their Majesties gave leave to Their Excellencies of St. Swithin's Bog to hold Baronial Court.

At the conclusion of Baronial Court, Their Majesties desired to speak with Lord Joshua of the Debatable Lands. Declaring Themselves impressed by his successes in Thrown Weapons and his promising prowess upon the range, They deemed it proper and worthy to name him a Companion of the Order of the Golden Alce, and Duke Byron begged a boon to present Lord Joshua with his own medallion to welcome him to the Order. Scroll: Baroness Katherine Kiersey.

Their Majesties next sought Lady Ædiva of Cratorne. Noting with pleasure the many, many ways in which she teaches, serves, creates, and supports her Shire and the Kingdom, They were minded to create her a Companion of the Order of the Keystone. Scroll by Armiger urraca beatriz botelho, upon words by Lord Gideon le Jars.

Next, Their Majesties wished to be attended by Aesha Meinfritter. They remarked upon her enthusiasm and willingness to serve, especially in the office of Baronial Chatelaine. To recognize of these efforts, They were pleased to name her a Companion of the Keystone and further Awarded her Arms. Scroll by Armiger urraca beatriz botelho, upon words by Lady Nea Kimball.

Court Reports

Their Majesties then requested the presence of Baroness Zaphira bint Benjamin ibn Ibrahim and were not surprised to find her retaining for Their Highnesses. But in addition to her retaining duties, They wished to speak with Her Excellency of her action to step into the office of Mistress of Lists at a time when the Shire of Sylvan Glen needed one. For this and all her other service, Their Majesties named her a Companion of the Order of the Keystone. Scroll by Lady Kolfinna Jodisdottir.

Following this, Their Majesties wished for the presence of Lord Ingvar Sviatoslavich. They praised his research into Khazar and early Rus clothing and in particular his entries in the Clothiers' Guild Through the Looking Glass and Accessories competitions. As token of his progress and growing skills in the fields of costuming and cultural studies, They named him a Companion of the Order of the Sycamore. Scroll by Baron Caleb Reynolds.

At this time, Their Majesties recalled Don Robert MacEwin of Thornhill and inquired whether he had reached his decision based on the counsel he had received. Upon his reply and desire to proceed, Their Majesties requested testimony to his worthiness as a Peer. From the Most Noble Order of Defense, Don Markus Skalpr Grimsson declared that Robert's path was harder than most, for being born into the Society, he had to grow not only in himself, but beyond the memories and impressions of those who had known him his entire life. However, this he had done admirably: serving twice as Queen's Rapier Champion, as Baronial Rapier Marshal, teacher of historic fencing and melee, leading with a warm heart, a fierce sense of justice, growing into a true courtier and a fine man. Representing the Most Noble Order of the Laurel, Baron Alaric MacConnal mentioned in passing the art of defense and of archery but dwelt on Robert's artistic creations in fiber arts and spinning, participation in the choir,

and entertaining the populace in performance. Boiarin Godzimir the Golden sent words from the Most Noble Order of the Mark, saying that Robert has become a cornerstone of the fencing community, leading by example by training his body and mind, particularly through his strength of character, wide smile, and cheerful demeanor, which bring him endless allies. Sir Thorsol Solinauga, who had taken Robert as a squire seven years previously, and who claimed that he knew early in their association that whatever discipline Robert chose, his path would lead to Peerage, said on behalf of the Most Noble Order of the Chivalry that Robert was the Peer he hoped to be. As a speaker from the Most Noble Order of the Pelican, Magister Ceindrech verch Eilidir recounted that she met Robert when she started in Society twenty years ago and he was already serving at the age of six. Over the years, he performed countless and varied chores, and while sometimes it took reminding, he never complained like the other children. She continued that it can never be certain whether a child raised in the Society will remain, but that not only has he done so, but he has also only grown in his capacity to serve. His Grace, Duke Thomas Byron of Haverford spoke as a Royal Peer, imparting that it can be difficult to see a young person as an adult, especially when one has known the person since birth, and when they are the same age as one's own child, but attesting that Robert dispelled any doubt about his maturity the first time he and Duke Byron crossed swords upon Robert's return to the Society. Further, His Grace postulated that someday, if Æthelmearc is allowed to follow in the footsteps of her parent in the Eastrealm, we all might well see if Robert's heart also pumps royal blood. After such strong support, Their Majesties were satisfied and invited the Most Noble Order of Defense to join the Crown. With their affirmation, Swordmaster Robert was then adorned with a cloak, and the collar of his fencing household. His Majesty also called

for the Hus Faerhaga Book of Grudges to be consulted. His Majesty requested the list of Masters of Defence elevated from within the household and found but one name on the rolls: that of Swordmaster Robert. Robert was then invested with the Ancestral collar and two personal collars, whereupon he gave his oath of service, and was given Arms by Letters Patent. Scroll: The Honorable Lady Lisabetta de Rossi with words by Lady Phillipa Faye of Rockford.

Their Majesties then required The Honorable Lady Rachel Dalicieux to return before the throne and give her answer to the question long before her. Upon declaring herself prepared to accept elevation, Their Majesties requested words from Their Peers. Duchess Sir Ariella of Thornbury, speaking on behalf of the Most Noble Order of the Chivalry, commended Her Ladyship's commitment and intensity, pointing out that in so many courts over the years, each time one heard, "scroll by The Honorable Lady Rachel Dalicieux," it represented all the time she had spent at home working. From the Most Noble Order of the Pelican, Dame Elsbeth Anne Roth attested to the ways in which Her Ladyship had expanded in labor, love, and talent, directing Pennsic choirs in the past and at the coming War, taking on Regional Signet responsibilities, and organizing and teaching scribal workshops, even in times when the community could not gather in person. Mistress Cynthia Love of the Tower, also speaking as a Pelican, recalled the former Canton of Westland Mor, where Her Ladyship served at various times as seneschal and autocrat, and of her forming the Iron Scribe competition which continues to this day, and claimed that her body of work can be seen as evidence of her dedication to service. Representing the Most Noble Order of Defense, Swordmaster Robert MacEwin of Thornhill drew on long experience to state that the rôle of a Peer is to guide and lead those who need it, and that when Rachel ran a Pennsic teen choir

ten years previously, it gave him and others of his age a place of belonging, proving that she lights the way for those who follow. Baron Alaric MacConnal spoke as a Jewel of Æthelmearc, describing the qualities of skill, courtesy, chivalry, and service, and attesting that Rachel's skill inspires and brings delight; she treats all with dignity and respect, speaks for those who cannot speak for themselves, gives of herself and helps others to excel, so that in these ways, she too, shines like a Jewel. For the Most Noble Order of the Laurel, Mistress Arianna of Wynthrope recounted meeting Rachel when she came over an hour just to sing with the Barony choir, then learning she was also a scribe, and said that it seemed natural she becomes her apprentice. Since then, she has watched as Rachel has grown and grown in her skills and in her leadership, making it clear she is a Peer. Finally, as a Royal Peer, Duke Thomas Byron of Haverford observed that as Royalty, one expects people to help, but one does not necessarily expect one to organize the scrolls, anticipate needs such as the right pen, nib, and ink, and provide insight and recommendations that the scribal community would want for their next assignments. In working with Rachel as signet, His Grace said that he gained renewed respect and a unique perspective on her talents and steady skill. With these testimonies, Their Majesties were well pleased and called the Most Noble Order of the Laurel forward. Upon the Order's assent, Rachel was presented with the hood, wreath, and medallion proclaiming her a Mistress of the Order of the Laurel, by Letters Patent, and she gave her Oath of Service. Scroll is a work in progress by Mistress Shirin al-Susayya with words by Baron Alaric MacConnal.

Next, Their Majesties had business requiring the attendance of Mistress Zoe Akropolitina. They reminded Mistress Zoe that she had presented them with a combat bolt and a list of action items a

year ago, and that in the interim, she had done everything in her promise and more. Thus, They had prepared a suitable recompense and called for the Companion of the Most Noble Order of the Mark there present. They then directed her to contemplate induction into Mark and commanded her by means of Writ of Summons to give her answer at a mutually agreed time. Scroll by His Royal Majesty, King Murdoch.

At this time, Her Majesty spoke, as customary, of Her day's inspiration. Her Majesty shared that Their Jewel Herald generally reminds Her when it is coming, because She is often composing what to say right up until the last possible moment, and in fact, She was similarly "winging it" on this day as well, but that She had chosen Their Jewel Herald, because not just at this event, but at every event, she literally has their back, and that even in moments when They may falter, she is a steady presence and hand keeping the Court's business on track. In addition, in recognition of having performed this office multiple times, her advocacy for the Siege community, and not least, her contributions to the Bardic Arts in the Kingdom, merited, in Their estimation, a place in Æthelmearc's history. So it was with great sneakiness that They named Gwendolyn the Graceful the 57th Jewel of Æthelmearc. Scroll illumination by His Royal Majesty, King Murdoch, and Baroness Abby Rose, and calligraphy by His Majesty, with words by Her Majesty, Queen Ríoghnách, inspired from lyrics by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Meistr-y-gân.

Their Majesties invited all scribes and wordsmiths who had contributed to the Court to accept charms against the demon Titivillus, along with book charms for each scroll that had been presented that day..

Finally, Their Majesties bid all who were remaining to enjoy the feast and night's festivities, and all the populace to make their final preparations for War. Their Highnesses, as well, encouraged all to

keep sending award recommendations to assist Them to hear of all that They might not know or see.

There being no further business, Court was closed.
