Random Carp I have Learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Looking at many Renaissance portraits, you have the ubiquitous blurred edges, the vibrant colors, the depth and perspective not present in previous art. And you had the flawless pale, almost white skin and high forehead on women. These last two are very related, coming from the same source: Venetian ceruse. In high demand, the Venetian ceruse, more exclusive than normal ceruse, used water and vinegar mixed with basic lead carbonate. The basic (as in acid/base, not simple) mix produced an amazingly smooth white layer that fused well with the skin, took on outer layers of blush and eyeshadow, and left the wearer looking almost porcelain in appearance. It also caused lead poisoning, skin damage, tooth loss, and hair loss.

Evidence suggests Elizabeth I, after a childhood affliction of smallpox, was a frequent user of Venetian ceruse. Her various portraits starting with her Childhood, and her Coronation, Pelican, Armada, Gheeraets, and Sichem likenesses through her Reign showing a pale face, a receding hairline, and towards the end, evidence of tooth loss. Just 31 years after her death, ceruse was labeled a poison by the Royal Museums Greenwich.

Leaded gasoline was phased out starting in the 1970s, completely by 2021, though lead is still actively mined worldwide for use in lead-acid batteries, with more use in developed countries than less developed countries. So while complexion trends may have changed (tan skin with skin cancer vs white skin with lead poisoning), be aware of the high forehead, though some of us have a high forehead from completely OTHER means. And now you know more random carp.

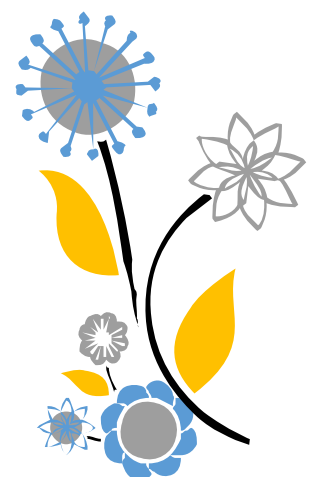
