- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.

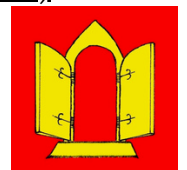

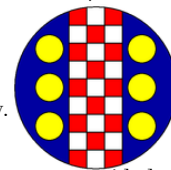

PayPal & Online Registration helps make event preregistration easy for both attendees and event staff. Working with Event Stewards and the Kingdom Exchequer, the Deputy creates online registration for Kingdom, Baronial, and Shire events (excluding War of the Phoenix), manages PayPal invoicing, and prepares the information needed to help events run smoothly.

While the position involves financial responsibility and requires a current Financial Warrant, most of the work centers on organization, communication, and creating registration tools that make life easier for everyone involved. Training and guidance are provided.



The Kingdom Deputy Exchequer of PayPal & Online Registration duties are as follows:

- Help Event Stewards Build Registration
 - Receive preregistration requests from Event Stewards.
 - Work with them to gather the details needed for online registration.
 - Set up registration options such as site fees, feasts, merchants, RV spaces, camping, cabins, parking, and other event-specific activities.

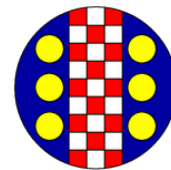
