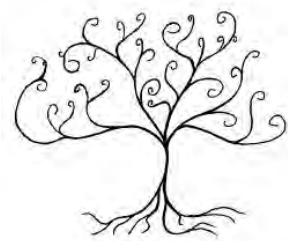
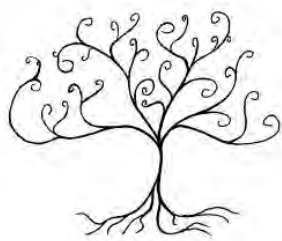
Greetings West Kingdom,

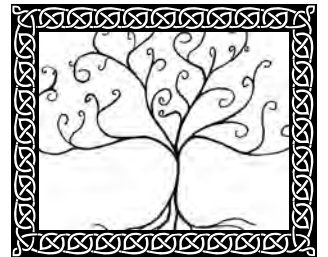
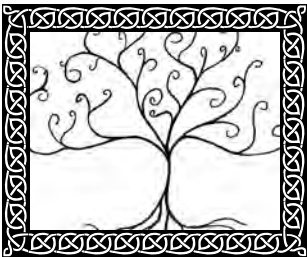

Western Artificer

The Western Artificer competition shall consist of twenty-one (21) possible competition topics over the course of the competition year. The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall hold three (3) competitions at each of the seven (7) Kingdom level events in the competition year. Each competition will be scored regardless of the number of entries.

Competitors must enter one (1) competition in each of the four (4) competition categories. The competitor who accumulates the highest overall score over the competition period, and has competed at least once per category, shall be named Western Artificer.

As the purpose and spirit of the Western Artificer competition is to encourage the exploration of historical arts and sciences at all levels within the West Kingdom, all entrants must submit a minimum half (1/2) page of documentation supporting their entry.

Competition Categories

Competitors for the Western Artificer must show breadth during the competition year. To achieve this, the Minister of Arts and Sciences shall set competitions for the year based on the schedule defined below. The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall announce the competition categories at Beltane Coronation for the next competition year.

Competition categories shall consist of the following four (4) areas rotated throughout the year so as to give the populace as many opportunities to participate as possible.

Ephemeral Arts: [Arts that are consumable or impermanent] bardic, theater, cooking, brewing, etc.

Permanent Arts: [Arts that are not consumable] wood, metal, leather, glass, illumination, calligraphy, needlework, costume, clay, etc.

Materials: [Arts that are used in the creation or preparation of another art] paint, weaving, ink, refining of glass/metal/clay for use, etc.

Research: research papers, oral presentation, documentation/class/teaching handouts, etc.

Arts and Sciences Tournament: Documentation, Ephemeral, and Permanent

Event	Type	Competition	Detail
June Crown	Ephemeral	Food for the Road	A prepared period dish that was explicitly described as being for travelers and/or that is shelf-stable and easily transportable without specialized equipment.
June Crown	Permanent	Every Day Metal Object	A useful tool or accessory made of metal that would be worn or used on a regular basis in every day life. Items such as jewelry items, buckles, job-related tools, and/or keys are all appropriate.
June Crown	Materials	Fiber Preparation	Before using fiber to create something there is usually some preparation required. Provide a tool, prepared fiber sample, or demonstration of a period technique used for preparing fiber prior to using the fiber in a project.
Purgatorio	Research	Cultural Aesthetic (Verbal Presentation)	Describe the identifying characteristics of an art form from a specific culture, time frame, and place (e.g., religious iconography of 12th century France); presentation will be in the form of an oral discussion with the judges and should include a printed bibliography of your research sources
Purgatorio	Ephemeral	Disposable or Consumable	Objects that were expected to be used up/consumed/broken/discarded after one or a few uses. Examples could include disposable serving items (e.g., bread trenchers, pastry "coffins"), limited use ceramics (e.g., things expected to be broken as part of regular use), temporary tools (e.g., non-reusable molds), and/or personal hygiene/beauty products (e.g., soap, salves).
Purgatorio	Permanent	Every Day Stone/Non-Metal Mineral Object	A tool or accessory made of stone/non-metal mineral that would have been used/displayed on a regular basis in every day life. Items such as bowls, sculpture, and bead/gem jewelry are all appropriate.
Fall Crown	Materials	Ink/Paint	Create an ink or paint from scratch using period techniques
Fall Crown	Research	Performance Aesthetic (Verbal or Paper Presentation)	Describe the identifying characteristics of an aspect of performing art in a specific time and place (e.g., court dance in the X empire) during a cultural diaspora, such as Romans in Britain, the Muslim expulsion from Andalus, first European contact with the New World. Specific era and place chosen by the entrant.
Fall Crown	Ephemeral	Audience Participation	Deliver a performance that includes some aspect of audience participation, like a round, repeatable chorus, spoken interaction with audience members, etc. Must be something that would have been seen/done/heard in period
Twelfth Night	Permanent	Capturing History	An art piece of any medium used in a period style to capture the history of a particular event. In period examples include objects such as the Field of the Cloth of Gold and the Bayeux Tapestry. Note that in some contexts "history" may include supernatural/spiritual references - such content is permitted, provided it is appropriate to the style of the piece and is accompanied by a written review of the supernatural/spiritual elements and their in-period context.
Twelfth Night	Materials	Manufactured Writing Surface	Vellum, paper, papyrus, clay tablet
Twelfth Night	Research	Scribal Aesthetic (Verbal or Paper Presentation)	Describe the identifying characteristics of in-period manuscript design in a specific time and place
March Crown	Ephemeral	Bardic Composition: Poetry	Create a piece of poetry based on a style found in period (time and place selected by entrant must be specific); presentation will include a short overview of the form (# of lines, required rhyming scheme, topic expectations) followed by performance of the piece. Total presentation time should be no more than 10 minutes and entries should include a paper bibliography.
March Crown	Permanent	Outerwear	Period cloaks, hats, and/or other outer-layer clothing from a specific culture.
March Crown	Materials	Tools made of/for clay	A tool made for use with clay and/or made of clay. Items such as bowls, plates, cooking vessels, molds, or clay-shaping tools are all appropriate.
Beltane	Research	Building Aesthetic (Verbal or Paper Presentation)	Describe the identifying characteristics of an aspect of architecture/landscaping in a specific time and place (e.g., transition from gothic to renaissance style in Venice)
Beltane	Ephemeral	First Fruits	A dish with at least one primary ingredient that is harvested in the winter or spring
Beltane	Permanent	Everyday Jewelry	Create a functional, common every day piece of jewelry. This should be something that would be popular and sought by the every day wearer.
A&S Tourney	Materials	Fiber In Use	An object made from fiber that you prepared using period techniques. Entry can be samples of the completely prepared fiber that is ready to use in some other project (e.g., rope, thread, spun wool) and/or another material that is made from fiber used to make something else.
A&S Tourney	Research	Teaching & Learning	Describe the identifying characteristics of an aspect of learning/education/teaching in a specific time and/or place (e.g., origins of the socratic method)
A&S Tourney	Ephemeral	Teaching a Period Skill	Present an interactive class at West Kingdom A&S focused on learning an every-day skill from an in-period time and place. Class should cover how the task was performed in period and call out any specific modifications made in modern times to address health/safety concerns. Potential topics include: Teaching a period dance; Teaching a period-style preparation of a dish/meal; Teaching how to make a material used in period. This requires a verbal discussion about substitutions for hazardous ingredients, etc.



Western Artificer Judging Requirements

Each competition will be judged by three (3) judges, whose scores will be averaged for the final score on each entry. All judges must judge every entry on its own merit and shall not judge it based on the other entries. All judges will use the appropriate rubric sheet (Performance Based, Physical Item, Written Item). All entries submitted must be substantially on the topic designated for that competition. Any entry that is not substantially on the designated topic will be disqualified.

The Minister of Arts and Sciences may limit, at their discretion, the competition category by either 1) Century, 2) Item, or 3) Region. The Minister of Arts and Sciences may not add more than one (1) limiter per competition.

Examples of appropriate limiter-based competitions include:

14th Century Calligraphy (limited by Century)

Leatherworking Shoes (limited by Item)

German Musical Performance (limited by Region)



Wreath of Athena

The Wreath of Athena is an opportunity to display your Arts and Sciences for the entire Kingdom! You don't need documentation to display your entry, although documentation is welcome. Finished works or works in progress are both acceptable. There are no judging sheets, but participants are welcome to leave a comment card if they would like to receive feedback from the populace on their entry. Members of the populace are encouraged to come to view the displays and show their appreciation by dropping a bead in the tray corresponding to the display number.

The Wreath of Athena Displays happen at each Crown Tournament. The typical schedule is as follows:

Displays may be dropped off at the Arts & Sciences Pavilion after Morning Court (start of Invocation) and should be registered in before the first round of the Crown Tournament.

The populace is invited to view displays up until Crown Finals.

Displays may be picked up from the Arts & Sciences Pavilion after Finals are over.

The Wreath of Athena will be awarded in Evening Court

Go just past the building and turn into what appears to be the parking lot, look for the SCA signs starting here. Stay to the left and transition to the gravel road that continues beyond. You will be heading South at this point.

You will continue on this gravel road for approximately 1 mile. Follow the next SCA sign to the field the event is being held in. Continue another 1/2 mile to the event site.
