Unto the populace of the Outlands, let it be known that the following sections of Kingdom Law will be changed.

III. SELECTION OF ROYALTY

Entrants and consorts shall present themselves before the Crown the day of the Crown Lists in a manner showing their preparedness to serve as Crown. The Crown may allow the absence of the consort for exceptional circumstances.

Grab your bow, pack your camping gear and come join the Shire of Windkeep for a weekend of and about archery, in the beautiful mountains of the Northern Outlands. Never shot archery before? It's fun, easy and we will have teachers and equipment on hand to help you learn. Archery games are planned such as a Wand Shoot, Clout Shoot and many others courtesy of the mind of THL Forester. For the Combat Archers a Meanest Mother Woods Battle is planned. Archery Marshals, we need your help. If you would like to help, or if you have suggestions, please contact the Steward.

This is a primitive site and camping is first come first serve. A map of the camping area will be available at gate. There is limited level ground for RVs. Contact the Event Steward for information. We will have porta-potties (there are a few composting toilets as well). There will be no potable water on site so please remember to bring your own. Please plan to leave the site cleaner than we find it. The only fires allowed on site must have an off switch and fire extinguisher available. Smoking is only allowed in a designated area and the site is damp for use of alcohol. Cannabis is illegal in Wyoming in all forms. Well behaved service animals/pets are welcome. They must be leashed and under your immediate control at all times. (There are deer and other animals on site) Please make sure they have food, water, and shade. Please pick up after your animal and dispose of their fertilizer. If your animal is afraid of crowds or strangers it might be kinder to leave them at home.

DIRECTIONS: From the South: Find your best route to 125 north. Drive to Wyoming. Exit 8B onto I80 West toward Laramie. Drive approximately 24 miles. **Exit 335 North Buford Road (where the Buford gas station is). Take a right at the exit and then an immediate other right. Next, take a left to stay on North Buford Road (This is a winding unpaved road). Proceed on North Buford Road approximately 4.5 miles to site. Entrance is on the left.

Join the delight and flights of fancy as Dragonsspine and Caerthe jointly host a weekend camping event in the mountains featuring furiously fun archery shoots on six (6) different shooting ranges, including at least one night shoot, and one (1) thrown weapons range. Some of the shoots will offer prizes for the top scorers. One range will be dedicated to Royal Rounds and others will provide a chance to shoot at different types of targets, to include 3-D targets, moving targets, a woods shoot through the trees, and clout shooting.

Participants will also have a chance to participate in Barchery – a cross-bred game combining the concepts of Bocce Ball and archery – and experience a demonstration of Scottish Highland Games events, with a chance to learn how and try out these games. All are welcome to join in the fun and camaraderie of this event, whether archers or not. Site is WET. Leashed and controlled pets are welcome, but horses are not permitted. Trees flourish on site, however additional shade is advised.

Please note: the site is primitive, sits at 10,000 feet elevation, and has a rough dirt entrance road. Participants must bring their own water for the weekend – drinking, cooking, washing, etc. Some RV space may be available in the parking area, but there are no RV hookups.

Registration is limited to 135, so please sign-up in advance.



Applications for the next Outlands Seneschal/Regional Vice President for Operations are open from June 1st, 2024~ Nov 1st, 2024.

This vital role is key in the Kingdom of the Outland's operations and functions and will be supported through a significant handover process.

The Kingdom Seneschal is considered both a Kingdom and Corporate officer and is responsible for coordinating the administration of the Outland's historical re-creation. This job is part Kingdom Administrator and Human Resources. This involves directing the activities of the Branch Seneschals and deputies. Where questions arise concerning the intent of Kingdom Law the Kingdom Seneschal is responsible for interpretations and clarifications. The Kingdom Seneschal is also responsible for reviewing all sanction related activities.

This is a part-time position requiring a minimum of 15 hours per week, often more.

Applicants must possess strong communication skills and be capable of interacting with unique SCA personalities without regard to rank or position in the organization. The ability to process and distill large amounts of information from multiple sources is required. Organizational and problem-solving skills are essential. Having held a Branch Seneschal position, while not required, is preferred. Applicants must be capable of maintaining a home office space, have access to the internet, PC/tablet, printer, and possess word processing skills. Proficiency with Microsoft Office, Google Drive, and Adobe Pro is a plus. Ready access to postal service for the mailing of trackable documents is required.

Required skills or background:

- · Prior experience in positions of leadership within the SCA or in leading volunteer organizations
- · Excellent working knowledge of current SCA corporate documents and handbooks
- · Ability to research issues surrounding kingdom and Society rules and policies
- · Understanding of how the SCA's sanction and investigative procedures work; direct experience with these procedures is preferred
- · Ability to maintain confidentiality of investigations and other confidential material
- · Ability to manage multiple projects and oversee volunteers on both Society and Kingdom levels
- · Excellent communication skills, both written and oral
- The ability and willingness to communicate via email, phone, and videoconferencing on a regular basis
- · Ability to explain policies, delegate projects, and build consensus

The Outlands Kingdom Seneschal is responsible for the following duties:

- · Oversee directly and indirectly the planning and implementation of all "game side" activities.
- Deal with large amounts of correspondence with many individuals, including but not limited to all kingdom sene-schals, royalty, and corporate/Society level officers, especially the President, VP for Corporate Operations, and Executive Assistant to the Board of Directors.
- · Meet via videoconference and/or phone with branch seneschals, Crown, and other corporate and Society officers once a month.
- · Provide training and advice to branch seneschals on a regular basis.
- · Present sanction packets to the Society Seneschal and provide oversight of investigations related to possible sanctions.
- · Interpret Kingdom Law and other SCA policies as needed; revise policies and create new policies as needed to facilitate SCA activities.
- · Evaluate and create documentation as needed to facilitate a positive experience for SCA participants.
- · Monthly review of all Branch Seneschal reports, respond to reports, and refer Branch Seneschal requests or questions to the appropriate Society or Corporate officer for assistance as needed.
- · Submit detailed quarterly reports to the Society Seneschal, and supplemental reports as needed.
- · Lead monthly Branch Seneschal meetings and other meetings as required.
- · Other duties and projects may be assigned by the Society Seneschal or Crown.
