We also want to call upon those who would take up the mantle of leadership to submit their Letters of Intent for the Spring Crown Tournament. The tournament will take place on Saturday, April 12, 2024, in the Barony of the Lonely Tower. As per kingdom law, Letters of Intent must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the tournament, which means the deadline is March 29, 2024.

The tournament will follow a best weapons style, and a shield no longer than your arm span.

In your Letter of Intent, please include the following details:

- Background in the SCA (such as how long you have been a member, any offices you have held, current activities).
- Proof of membership (a copy of your membership card and a photo of your driver's license).
- List of events you have attended over the last 6 months
- Contact information (email address and phone number).
- Mailing address.
- Why would you like to fight in the Crown Tournament?

Please send your Letter of Intent to both crown@calontir.org and seneschal@calontir.org.

We will notify all participants prior to the Crown Tournament whether their Letter of Intent has been accepted.

Until we meet on the field, around the fire, or beneath the banners of our great kingdom—know that you are ever in our hearts.

Greetings Calontir,

It is that time again, where we greet our new Crown and the search for new Heirs begins. I love this time. While I am always sad to see the outgoing Crown step down I am equally as excited to see the incoming Crown step up. What will their style be? What personality will they bring to the Kingdom? Every Crown gives something new to our culture, adds to our story.

TRMs (incoming) have requested Letters of Interest in their letter. Letters of interest are due to TRMs and the Kingdom Seneschal by March 29, 2025. Writing that first letter can be daunting. Below is a summary of what a letter of interest for Calontir Crown Tournament should include. Your letter can be formatted as you wish. I have seen fancy flowery prose, just the facts, and everything in between.

Requirements to vie for the honor of being Calontir Crown are found in Calontir Kingdom law and SCA Corpora and Policies. Some of the requirements allow the hosting Crown to grant exceptions.

Combatants and Consorts must be members of the SCA, be at least 19 years old, reside in Calontir over the prior 12 months (or live in close proximity to the borders - with permission from the Crown hosting the tournament) and have been an active participant in Calontir during that time. Both the combatant and consort are asked to confirm that they have read the governing documents (Corpora, SCA Policies, and Calontir Kingdom Law). These documents are where you will find the rights and responsibilities of the Crown. A simple statement in your letter that you have read these documents is acceptable. If your letter doesn't contain the required information I will reach out to you requesting additional information or clarification.

In addition to these requirements the Crown may have other requirements specific to Their Tournament. In my years in the SCA I have seen: A&S projects for display, items to be donated to largesse, specific tournament weapons/styles, a statement of offices held, a statement of why you want to win the tournament/ what you want to do/support if you win - all things that reflect on the parts of the SCA that the couple feels are important or that they wish to highlight.

Have any questions? Read Corpora and Kingdom law and now you have lots of questions? Let me know, I'm delighted to discuss these things. I think it's interesting. Don't worry about a silly question. I have friends I ask about things too (sometimes even silly

questions), because things change and what I thought it said might not be what it says now. I also re-read the documents when I get a question, because it's really too much to try to remember.

I look forward to hearing from you.

Greetings Calontir!

My goal is to spend the next few months demystifying the heraldic submissions process, starting with your initial consultation and taking you all the way through to final approval.

Have you ever been at an event, and seen a flock of heralds gathered at a table? Chances are, they're at Herald's Point—or a consultation table—waiting for you to walk up and ask about registering a name and arms of your very own.

Already have one? Fear not! You can register up to ten names and ten pieces of armory. With everything under a central filing name, you could register a name and device for each of your personas.

So pull up a chair, and get ready to be asked your opinion on time period, culture, colors, and items that you'd want to see in your new device.

Your consulting herald will use a number of resources (books, websites, databases, etc) to help document your new name within the SCA period.

The herald will also search the online database of all registered names and arms in the SCA (sometimes called the O&A) to make sure that your new name and/or arms (the symbols and designs that represent you) are unique to you and that you aren't accidentally copying someone else!

You may also choose to work with your local herald, and utilize their expertise in research to help design a device or pick that perfect name. Of course, you can always create your own submissions, whatever you are most comfortable with.

There is also a monthly online Heraldic Consultation hosted by Sofya la Rus on the third Sunday night of the month, where you can ask for assistance with your submissions.

Once you've got the forms filled out, you or the consulting herald will submit them to the Calontir College of Heraldry - either by mailing them or emailing them to the Eyas Herald.

Each registered item is \$8.00, and you can pay via cash, check or we can send you an online invoice to pay. Once the items have been paid for, they begin a 6-8 month approvals process that we'll detail next month.

Hello Calontir!

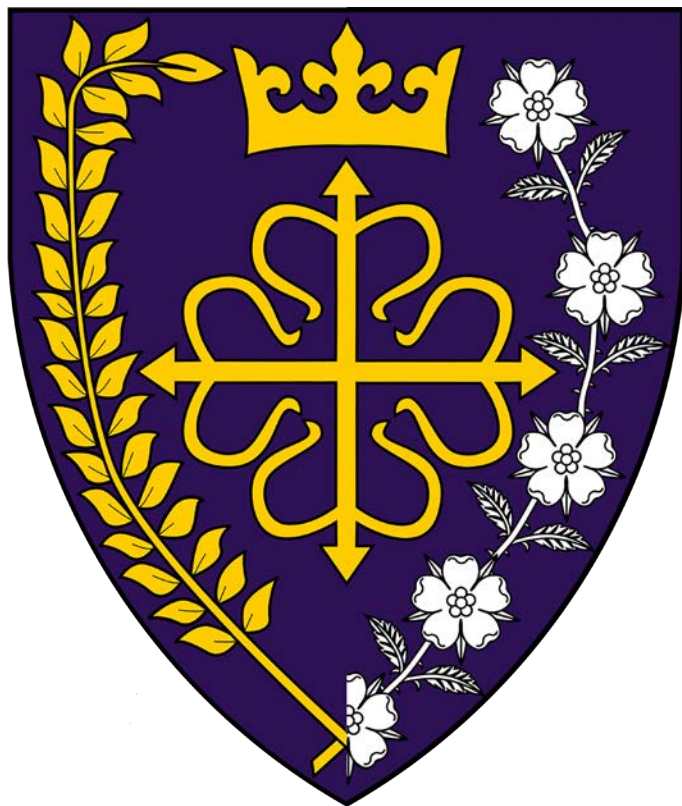

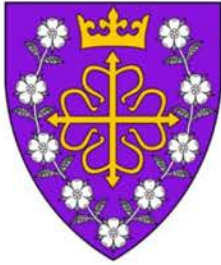

Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event.

Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/events/>

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
2. Day, month, and year of the event
3. Site open & close times for populace
4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25
Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20
Youth (6-17) \$5
Children 5 & Under: FREE
