Come prepared for rapier and heavy fighting demonstrations and recruitment.

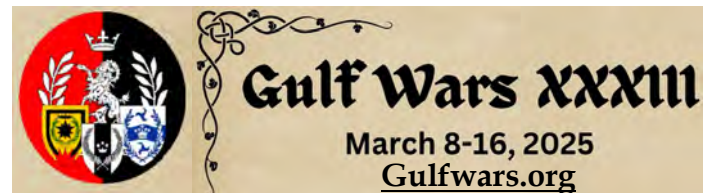
