Coming from Boise and points north/west:

Take I-84E to Simco Rd / exit 74. Go south on Simco Rd for 20 miles to ID 167. Turn right onto ID 167, go one-half mile and turn left onto Strike Dam Cutoff Rd. Go approx. 7.5 miles to North park campground (just before you get to CJ Strike Dam.)

Coming from SLC and points east:

Take I-84W to Cold Springs Rd / exit 114 at Hammett, ID. Turn left onto Cold Springs Rd, cross I-84 and turn right onto Old US 30. Take Old US 30 for 2 miles, then turn left onto ID 78.

Continue for 16 miles, then turn left onto ID 51 / ID 78. Go 7 miles, then shift right to stay on ID 78. Go 9 more miles, then turn right onto River Rd. Go 0.75 miles and turn right onto Black Sands Rd. Go 0.5 miles and turn left onto Strike Dam Cutoff Rd.

After getting to CJ Strike area:

Do NOT turn at the North Park/Air Force Rec Area sign; turn at the second North Park exit. Also, do not turn into the Scout Camp area just south of the North Park signs.

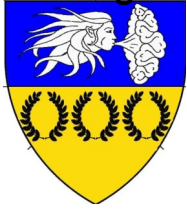

# Random Carp that I have Learned...



## A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

If it's Friday night it must be pizza night! A fine dish that spent much of history NOT being from Italy. Persian writings from the 6th century BCE talk of soldier rations including flatbread cooked on shields then topped with cheese and dates (which sounds kinda awesome, maybe with a drizzle of honey?) The Greeks frequently enjoyed focaccia and cheese, but topped with herbs and flavored oils. A Roman street food option was thin baked bread with cheese and plants atop it, until finally in 997 the word "pizza" appears in a Southern Italian document demanding payment for a list of foods provided for holiday feasts. 16th century Italian chef Bartolomeo Scappi put a recipe for sweet pizza in his cookbook, published in 1570.

Interestingly, pizza developed into cheap street food for poor people. When the Spanish brought tomatoes from the new world, they were treated with suspicion, making them cheap, allowing them to be added as a low cost topping to the street fare. A combination of Italian immigrants to New York (New York style) in the early 20th century, and World War II vets/cooks having served in Italy returning home to open the first ("uno" -> Uno's) deep dish restaurant (Chicago Style), brought on the Americanization of pizza.

Now you can have it delivered, pull from the freezer, or make it from scratch. You can top it with more pepperoni, more olives, more mushrooms... or more random carp.
