The Dragon's Tale is set using Scribus 1.4.6 with Garamond, Arial, Arial Narrow. Lucida Handwriting and UBW Chancery typefaces in various sizes. The Dragon's Tale logo is in Tyrfing Demo typeface.

#### Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. Event announcements must include:

- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- · Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- · Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

# Medieval Ink Making

By Alfhild de Foxley

Oak gall ink was the primary ink between the 5th and 19th century. It's earliest mention was in Pliny the Elder's Natural History. Oak gall ink is made from gall nuts that grows on oak trees thanks to a wasp laying its eggs in the bark. It is usually made with rainwater since rainwater does not contain minerals, as ground water does, and which could interfere with the ink. In this recipe rainwater is replaced by distilled water, which has the same properties.

The gum arabic used in the recipe is a tree sap from the Acacia tree and its function is to make the ink a little thicker so that it flows better. The wine is for making the color warmer and the iron vitriol turns the brown color of the gall nuts black.

This recipe combines the two most common ways of extracting the color from the oak galls which is it both ferments them and boils them. This has proven to be the best way of getting the most saturated black color. This recipe is from the 14th century.

#### Ingredients

1 liter Distilled water 181 gram Gall nuts 22,6 gram Gum arabic 0,9 dl White wine 17 gram Iron Vitriol

#### How to:

- -Take the oak galls and crush them into small pieces.
- -Put the oak galls in the distilled water and let them ferment to the next morning.
- -Boil the liquid until it is reduced by half. You should have a brown mixture.
- -Filter out the oak galls through a fine cloth.
- -Take the gum arabic and crush it into a powder.
- -Add the gum arabic and boil it until the gum arabic is completely dissolved.
- -Filter the liquid again.
- -Take the wine and add the iron vitriol to it.
- -Add the wine mixture to the liquid. Now the ink should turn black.
- -Boil it for 5 min and then filter the ink again.

The ink is now ready.
