I know you're saying to yourself, "Self, SeaWolf Herald sounds like a really fun thing, but I'm not sure what a SeaWolf Herald does? Do I have to already be a Herald? Do I have to be a wolf, whether a sea version or not? And as long as I'm asking questions, what's for dinner?" I can't help you with your dinner plans, but I can answer your other questions!

The SeaWolf Herald is the Principal Herald for the Principality of the Mists, and is responsible for coordinating heraldic activities at Principality events. Responsibilities include:

- Coordinate heralds for announcements, tournament fields, and Courts at Mists Coronets and Investitures.
- ♦ Serve as contact person for heraldic questions (names, devices, etc.), and refer to the correct herald (or other officer) best equipped to assist.
- ◊ Provide heraldic support to Their Highnesses of the Mists.
- ◊ Sign and Seal Principality scrolls as needed.
- ◊ Submit a report for the Mists Management Meeting, Sunday morning of Coronet weekend.
- Submit reports every other month for the West Kingdom College of Heralds meetings (currently held virtually, with the exception of 12th Night).
- ♦ And other fun things as assigned!

You do NOT have to be a Herald, although a basic knowledge of how Heralds function in the SCA might make things easier starting out, and you do NOT have to be a wolf, either swimming or four-legged. Training/words of encouragement/ checking over your shoulder provided — I will NOT kick you into the deep end and tell you to swim (especially if you're a four-legged wolf).



Rules of the List Update

Marshallate Content

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on the changes to the Rules of the List proposed by the Society Marshal.

These proposed changes aim to update the Rules of the List to include all SCA martial disciplines, while preserving their intent. Explanatory information is outlined for each rule with the functional change and the reason for the change provided where appropriate.

The Rules of the List are a critical core of SCA culture, values, and behavior. However, as written, they are mostly limited to Armored Combat and Rapier, and create contradictions for the approved martial activities of Equestrian, Combat Archery, Siege, Thrown Weapons, and Target Archery. The proposed changes also include a reordering of the list, to start with general underlying principles and then proceed to specific applications.

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on proposed changes to Governing Documents proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Governing Documents related to the Marshallate. The authorities, roles, responsibilities, and functions of the Marshallate occur in several sections of the Governing documents, and have been added to or updated over the years. However, they do not fully reflect the breadth of current SCA martial activities and the evolution of our administrative and safety practices. These changes will (a) include all SCA martial disciplines, (b) incorporate the current and modern practices that have evolved over the years in our rules and the application thereof, and (c) ensure consistency throughout the several sections, while preserving the kingdom flexibility that enables the uniqueness of our kingdom cultures.

Corpora Addition—Royalty Selection (Refusals)

The Board of Directors is seeking feedback on the proposed addition to Corpora: Section IV.A, Royalty-Selection. A previous version was put out for comment in 2023. The majority of commentary received was favorable to the concept but not necessarily to the specific language. This rewritten proposal attempts to address those concerns. Additionally, principalities have been added to be in line with other rights, privileges, and restrictions of Principality royalty.

It is clearly stated in the Rules of the List in Corpora that all combatants must be acceptable to the Crown. This is an authority that has great importance in Royal Lists. It is also important to note that the Crown should not, whether intentionally or otherwise, attempt to influence the outcome a Royal List by using that authority. On multiple occasions a Crown has barred or attempted to bar a swath of people from competing in the Royal Lists based on factors such as geographical location, household affiliation, membership in a particular order, or simply rejecting well over half the letters of intent, giving the distinct impression that this action would control the outcome of the tourney. In 2022, the Society Seneschal issued a Corpora interpretation barring this practice which was upheld by the Board. This proposed language would add and define this restriction to Corpora directly, and also to require the Crown to state a reason to an individual to whom they have refused entry if the individual requests it.
