THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.



There will be a youth combat tournament at the Passing of the Ice Dragon. April 5th. There will be loaner equipment available.

I will also be authorizing adults as youth sparing partners, at Ice Dragon. Time is TBD.

Youth Sparring Partners are experienced adult fighters who are authorized to fight full contact against youth fighters using youth weapons, calibrations, and rules.



Sparring Partners also do not need to be paid members of the SCA and are not required to get background checks, because they are only allowed to work with kids under the supervision of a Youth Combat Marshal and in the presence of someone who does have an SCA Background Check. The only exception is that, of course, parents are always permitted to spar with their own children.

Why would you want to be a Youth Sparring Partner?

- To make it possible for kids in small groups to fight even when there are no other kids their age participating in youth combat.
- To provide youth fighters with real training in SCA combat.
- To hone the skills of the best youth fighters.
- To help shape and improve the next generation of SCA fighters.
- To model appropriate behavior.

Ice Dragon Heavy Weapons Rules – Head Marshal Sir Callidus • The tournament will be a two hour bearpit. Limit of five consecutive fights. • Two points for the winner, one point for the loser. Double kills are considered losses. Loser reports to the MOL. • There will be two divisions. Division 1 is single handed weapons only (sword and shield, two weapons, etc). Division 2 is two handed weapons (polearms, greatswords, etc).

The points for each division will be recorded separately and fighters will sign in and report to MOL of that division. Fighters may fight exclusively in one division or fight in both divisions.


