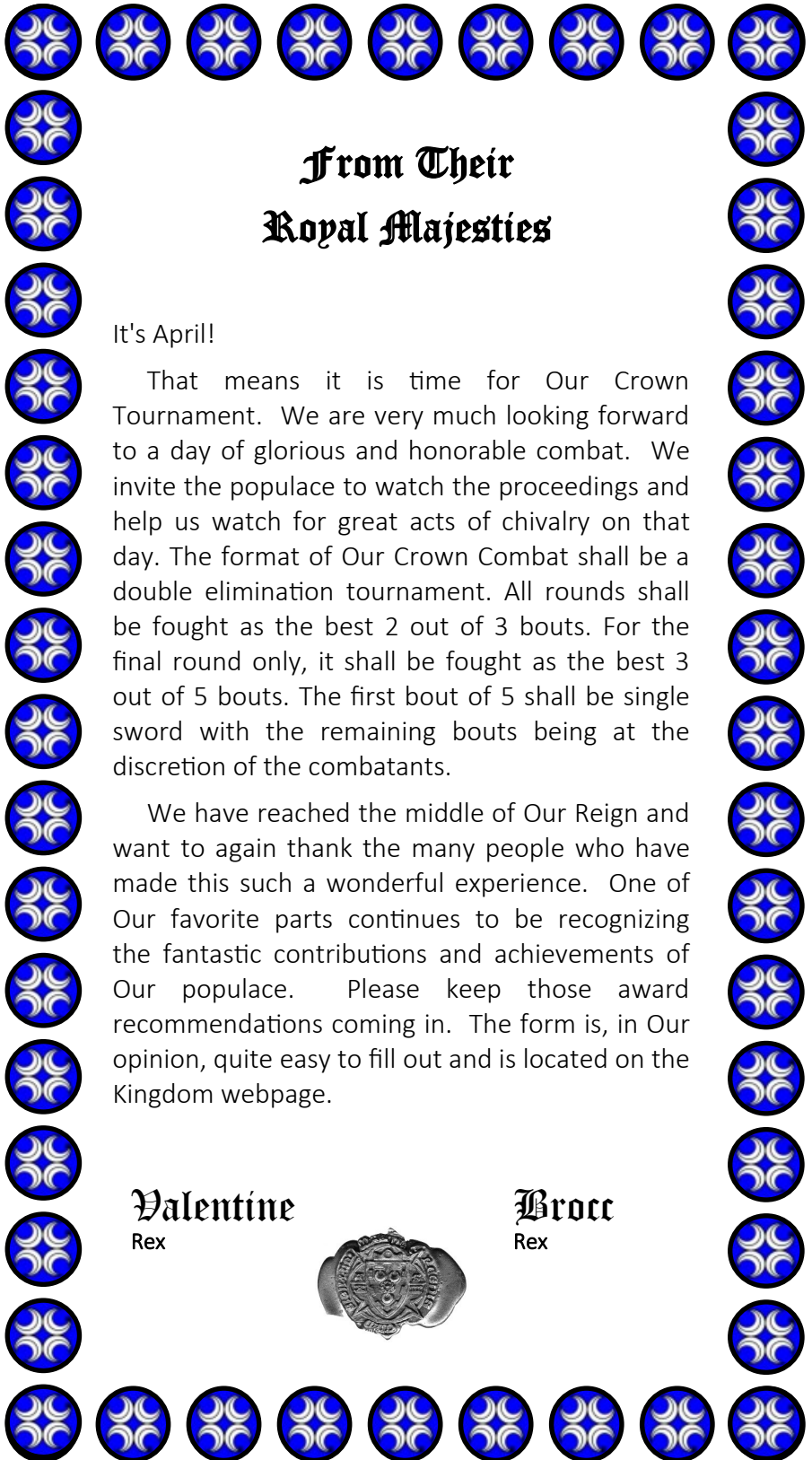

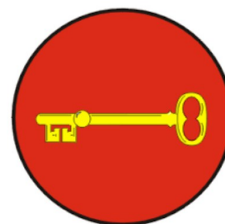
From the Kingdom Seneschal
