Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/ Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- · Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)



Review proposed Drachenwald law changes

Old Business:

1. Proposal for moving responsibility regarding baronies within a principality from Crown to Coronet Reasoning

The burdens of the Crown are many. This proposal moves the responsibilities for those baronies that are within a Principality, from the Crown to the Coronet, as the Coronet is already responsible for their regions.

2. Proposal for clarification of fealty presented by principalities

This proposal aligns the kingdom law with current practices and the wording is consistent with the proposed change under old business. This proposal affects section 6.01.4

3. Proposal for changes in categories of the kingdom officers Reasoning

This proposal is due to changes in Corpora where the Kingdom Chatelaine has been moved from the category of Lesser Officers to Great Officers. Additionally, the proposal removes the hierarchical wording that ranks the Great Officers in order of precedence. This proposal affects sections 5.01, 5.02, and 5.06.9.

4. Proposal for clarification of the responsibility to get awards registered in the Order of Precedence database Reasoning

The purpose of this proposal is to minimize frustration over missing awards in the online Order of Precedence, and to avoid wasting the time and resources of scribes and royals that unknowingly plan to give out awards that a recipient has already received. This propsal affects sections 2.02.6 and 5.06.2.3, and adds new sections 5.06.2.6, 6.01.5, and 6.05.6.1.
