THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing -Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

Again, we thank you for all of your support and look forward to a joyful reign!





The Site needs to be one large room with plenty of tablespace, handicap accessibility, and suitable changing rooms and royalty rooms.



From the Kingdom Webminister

Greetings unto the Kingdom of Æthelmearc,





ship when it comes to various procedures within their purview. Over two-years ago, we were requested to create a Data Retention Policy by the Society Webminister, at the direction of the Society IT Manager. The Kingdom Webministry, along with the Seneschallate, wrote and published a data retention policy which was published in January 2024. (Found at https://drive.google.com/file/d/1q-

Y4t1SRnauHTgfantUMIALqPNb 9nB /view?usp=drivesdk).

Part of these policies deals with the protection of Personally Identifiable Information otherwise known as PII. And please note, we have had growing pains around this as we find items that need to be brought into compliance. Part of this does extend further as we also need to prevent information lossage due to the inability to recover passwords from folks leaving the Society, rage quits, (unfortunate) deaths, and other occurrences. If you do a Google search for some of our groups, you will find orphaned webpages out there that are stagnant, and unable to be updated. The information on these abandoned sites cannot be changed or deleted.

We are trying to make the electronic experience with peoples' personal and group data safer in Æthelmearc. Since moving to Google for Æ in December 2020, we have required officers to use their official Æthelmearc accounts for communication. We also have a long-standing rule in Æthelmear. Webminister Policies that states that server space not on the Kingdom Server would need to be approved by the Kingdom Webminister in order for it to be used. This is to ensure compliance by both Kingdom and Society Policies as well as watching for any legal issues.

To assist with keeping Æthelmearc's data, along with its many groups and people from falling victim to any implicit,

explicit, or accidental maliciousness, we are asking all official web services, email accounts, and listservs to be hosted through the kingdom, servers and domain. This will include websites or email lists (aka listservs) for the Kingdom, including Officers, Local Groups, Guilds, Polling Orders, Events, and so forth.

With all this in mind, there are changes to Webminister policies, with a guiding timeline, that have been updated with the Crown's assistance. From now until April 1, which is just about 6 months from now, any websites, email lists, and emails not on the Kingdom server may remain intact where they reside. The non-PDF'd version of the Webminister Policy (found at https://docs.google.com/document/d/1h9CSYVe6B-

OWGpwYJk8ZC1dlulgB0hq7SyG_HwuznWQ/edit? usp=sharing) reflects this at current and states that these may be on the Kingdom infrastructure, but is currently not required. However, on April 1 (and no kidding, given the day), the Policy will change and will state that all websites, mailing lists, and official email addresses (as said above and in Webminister policy) will be required to be hosted on the Kingdom's Digital Infrastructure. If you wish to move your website before the deadline, let us know. We can accommodate a move anytime in the next 6 months.

Please note that we will not pay for vanity domains, however, we will work with you if your group wishes to keep their established vanity domain. Else, your domain will become https://<group/officer/order/event>.aethelmearc.org once it moves to the Kingdom server. Email addresses and listservs will not be able to have vanity domains.

If your Group, Officership, Polling Order, or Event needs assistance with moving their site to the Kingdom infrastructure, please let us know at helpdesk@aethelmearc.org. We can assist with FTP transfers, Wordpress site transfers, gmail account transfers, and more. Please let us know how we can be of assistance to make any digital —- easier for you and your Group, Officership, Order, or Event.

Additionally, if your Group, Officership, Order, or Event does not currently have a site, email list, or email address and would like one, please contact the Æ Webministry at helpdesk@aethelmearc.org and we will be happy to assist you.

Now, many may have concerns about your data. We would like to assure you that we do have checks and balances in place on the Webministry side as well. The Kingdom Seneschal is one of our Google Admins and has the ability (& will) run audit logs to ensure that data has not been inappro-

priately accessed by other admins on the server and that we are on the up-and-up and held accountable for our actions. Again, this is akin to what we see in the corporate world and will be holding ourselves to similar standards within the Kingdom.

Court Reports

Court Report Crown Tournament

Murdoch and Ríoghnách, May 11, AS 59 (2024)

Barony of Endless Hills

Documented from the Rolls and Files of the Coram Regibus of Murdoch I Rex and Ríoghnách I Regina, King and Queen of Æthelmearc: Being a True Record of the Business of Their Royal Court at Their Crown Tournament, 11 May, Anno Societatis LIX, in the Barony of Endless Hills. As recorded by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Brehyres, Meistr-y-gân, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, and Lærifaðir jorundr hinn rotinn, Silver Buccle Herald.

Upon the field, at the conclusion of the tournament: Their Majesties called before them Sir Bjarki Rikarðarson and Mistress Gabrielle de Winter, and Crowned them Prince and Princess. Court suspended.

In the evening, Their Majesties welcomed Prince Bjarki, Princess Gabrielle, and Her Excellency, Magge Illfoster, Baroness of the Endless Hills, to join Them in Their Court.

Their Majesties thanked all who attended and expressed the hope that all had had as fine a day as They. His Majesty also issued birthday greetings to Master Denys the Decadent, celebrating 70 years of age that day.

Their Majesties then invited all children into Their presence to inquire about their time that day. Though it was difficult to command their attention, They entreated them to chase Sir Lotharius qui et Segimundus in order to plunder the treasure chest.

Next, Their Majesties greeted the day's newcomers and invited them to select drinking vessels.

Their Majesties gave leave to The Honorable Lady Abby Rose, event steward, to address the populace. Her Ladyship thanked all her staff, including Baron Perote Gormal Campbell, head cook, and his kitchen staff; Dame Kateryna ty Ysaf, chief tollner, and all who assisted her; Sir Lotharius for the list barriers, Lady Revna Lunaris, hospitality coordinator; Baroness Elizabeta da Venezia, lead retainer for the day; and all others who assisted to make the event a success. She also announced a few lost and found items and asked any who may claim them to see her.

Next, Their Majesties asked the Ladies of the Rose and Garnet to present the Shield of Chivalry. Before announcing their decision, Duchess Kallista Morgunova acknowledged Magnifico Elena D'Artois with a token for Her Excellency's conduct in the list. Countess Caryl then spoke of good Crown Tourneys where the choice to bear the Shield is a difficult one because of so many acts of courtesy, as well as good Crown Tourneys where the choices are clear. Saying that this day was the latter sort of day, Her Excellency asked for Lord Sigfrid Corolys to be called forward. The Ladies of the Rose and Garnet then asked if he would stand as their champion. Upon his assent, Their Majesties released The Honorable Lord Halfdan Dansson from his responsibilities and joyfully passed the Shield of Chivalry to Lord Sigfrid, requesting that he join Their Court.

Before Magnifico Elena retired too far, Their Majesties requested that she return along with the other rapier army leadership, for the purpose of naming Their new Rapier General, Don Jehan LeBlanc, and investing him and his staff with new regalia capes to signify their station. These capes, embroidered by Baroness Anastasie de Lamoure, were presented to Don Jehan, Lady Ania Mhoireach, and Lord Marcos Baltanos, at which point Magnifico Elena and her fellow commanders, Don Diego Miguel Munoz de Castilla, and Master Po Silvertop, were released from their duties.

At this time, Their Majesties wished to be attended by Meisterin Helena Mützhazenin. They spoke with her of the entertainment offered by her heralding that day, as well as their gratitude for her service to the reign, but indicated that it was for another reason They called for her on this occasion, for many had brought words of praise to Their Majesties for Meisterin Helena's consistent

presentation in her dress and appearance. Finding Themselves in full agreement with this assessment, They were pleased to name her a Companion of the Golden Mirror. Scroll by The Honorable Lord Angellino the Bookmaker.

Their Majesties next sought Master Simon Savastian Caminante. Their Majesties pointed out the impressive range of Master Simon's artistic endeavors, from the very meticulous process of weaving and embroidering, to the very large scope of building a Pennsic house. For these reasons and other examples of his artistic skill, They deemed it right to name him a Companion of the Order of the Sycamore and presented him with the household medallion of Hus Farhaga. Scroll by Lady Christina Mary Lowe (Jinx) upon words by Lord Chaghagan Ghunan

Next, Their Majesties sought Syr Lorimer McAltin of Garioch. Many favorable reports had reached Their Majesties of Syr Lorimer's efforts to revive dance within the Kingdom, and in gratitude for this and to recognize his skill at teaching and leading dance, They were pleased to name him a companion of the Order of the Sycamore. In addition, His Majesty imparted that They had had a desire to cement Syr Lorimer further into the rolls of Æthelmearc, but also wished to present proof that Syr Lorimer was a part of the realm long before it became our realm. As a token of commemoration, His Majesty presented Syr Lorimer with a copy of an issue of "The Savage Sword of Conan," in which Syr Lorimer had been interviewed as a member of the then "Shire" of Thescorre. Scroll by Lady Umbriana Campana upon words by Master Cyrus Augur.

Their Majesties then wished for Lord Sigfried Corolys to join Them once more before the thrones. They remarked upon the tremendously impressive showing he had made in the tournament, and that They were particularly pleased for all the Kingdom to see his prowess on display. They also shared that others were already aware of his skills upon the field, and thus They asked that Their Noble Order of the Gage come forward as They named Lord Sigfrid their Companion, and Granted him Arms. In addition, His Lordship Sigfrid was presented with a pair of gloves inscribed with the ancestral Gage rolls of Hus Farhaga. Scroll by Lady Umbriana Campana upon words by "some guy in a hat" (Master Po Silverton)

At this time, Their Majesties desired to see The Honorable Lady Abby Rose once more. Her Majesty discussed the enormous amount of work and support Her Ladyship had provided Them throughout Their time as Prince and Princess, and no less as King and Queen. 
