Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.



Site Information:


Showers are available as well as stone privies! There are 3 shower stalls in each bathroom. There is potable water onsite and dumpsters for trash. The site is a Wet site, glass is allowed, but as always, clean up after yourself. Pets are welcome on a leash, and fires are in designated spots as well as any propane fires elevated from the ground. Quiet Hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM. Please be respectful of the other sites.

RV Campers – Reserve your spot online at https://azstateparks.com/catalina/camping-and-rvs/rv-and-tent-camping. There are limited RV sites available with electric, sewage, and water hookups. You will have to book your campsite separate from the event. Reservations can be cancelled 60 days prior to the event, though there is a \$3.20 non-refundable reservation fee. Sites are \$35 per night.

Equestrian – There is camping at the Equestrian Center for an additional \$25 per night, though you do not have to camp with your horse if you choose to stay at the registered group sites. There are 16 corrals for horses at the park available as a first come, first served basis. There will not be any formally organized equestrian activities at the event, however, the park boasts many horse friendly trails, and horses are welcome to attend the event, but cannot stay in the group campgrounds overnight. Please refer any additional questions about equestrian facilities and reservations to the park (520) 628-5798.

Parking: When you arrive at the gate, you do not have to pay for parking, simply explain that you are here for the SCA event, and you will be given a parking pass. If you have a state park pass, we ask that you use that instead to help with event costs. Parking for this event is limited. We ask everyone to please carpool whenever possible. Just across the street, there is an In and Out Burger with a huge parking lot. We strongly recommend that you park there and carpool on the way into the park.

For fighters that choose to sleep in nearby hotels: The Holiday Inn Express Oro Valley- Tucson North is the closest hotel, 3 miles from the park (average rates under \$100/night).

Requests for Letters of Intent-Baron and Baroness of Granite Mountion

The Baron and Baroness of Granite Mountain are preparing to conclude their tenure and enjoy a much deserved retirement. It is time to request Letters of Intent. On Saturday, January 25th 2024 at Northern War Practice there will be a polling for the next pair to lead the barony who will step up at Champion in the Pines May 16th-18th 2025.

Below are the Guidelines for Participation as a Baronial Candidate:

- 1. Baronial candidates must be current paid members and must receive their Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Granite Mountain.
- 2. Candidates must be at least 18 years old.
- 3. Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, and the Baron & Baroness no later than Friday November 1st. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial Newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling.
- 4. Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:
 - a. Full contact information, including SCA & amp; modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, & amp; membership numbers and expiration date
 - b. Their reasons for seeking the position
 - c. Their history of participation in the SCA and the Barony of Granite Mountain
 - d. Their plans for the future of the group
 - e. Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron & Baroness.
 - f. Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a two or three year warrant in the position, and understand their Letter of Intent will be published in the Baronial Newsletter if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

In addition, please review the following information regarding your participation in the Barony of Granite Mountain Polling:

A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Granite Mountain will be conducted on Saturday, January 25th 2024 to determine their support of candidates for Baron & Baroness. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling may be held immediately following the closing and tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining. Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, and must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Granite Mountain.

- Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Granite Mountain, and this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.
- NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Granite Mountain, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections and preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.
- You must be 18 years old or older & amp; present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

Kingdom Seneschal (Open until August 31, 2024)

The Kingdom Seneschal's office is seeking applications for the Kingdom Seneschal and Emergency Deputy Seneschal.

The Kingdom Seneschal is the primary officer and legal representative of the Kingdom of Atenveldt, and ultimately responsible for overseeing all events, and ensuring the Kingdom and Local Groups follow guidelines set forth by Corpora, Kingdom Financial Policy and Kingdom Law. This includes signing all Kingdom contracts for the SCA, Ensuring that the Kingdom and all SCA Local groups are maintaining group status, and adhering to SCA guidelines for operation and administration.

The Kingdom Seneschal's overall duties are:

Maintain Kingdom Law and administer changes to Kingdom Law.

- Advise the Crown on Kingdom Law and Corpora.
- Call such meetings, require such reports, and oversee such events as are necessary for the proper functioning of the Kingdom.
- Monitor official branches within the Kingdom to determine if they are maintaining the standards required for an official group and notify the Crown and the Board of Directors when groups failto uphold the standards.
