From the Society Seneschal

New Peerage Approved Pending Name and Heraldry



On June 5, 2024, the Board of Directors of Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) Inc. held an extraordinary conference call to discuss the progress of a path to a prowess related peerage for target archery, combat archery, siege weapons, thrown weapons, and equestrian martial activities. This item was moved from the scheduled conference call of May 30, 2024, to allow for appropriate robust discussion on the matter.

During the call, a range of opinions and options were discussed. The Board was highly appreciative of the feedback they had received from around the Knowne World and wished to acknowledge the passionate opinions expressed which shows a membership who cares deeply about the direction of the SCA.

The Board remained committed to finding that next step, noting again that compromises would be necessary, and no solution will satisfy universally. There was robust discussion of the existing paths that were seen for equestrian activities reflecting that there was potential for inclusion with the Chivalry and the Order of Defense given weapon form choices as well as mounted archery falling within a ranged martial pursuits definition.

Following discussion of more than hour, an initial motion was raised by Director Krochmal for the Board to approve in principle the addition to Corpora of 'pre-17th century ranged and mounted martial pursuits' peerage. Directors Sheppard, Bainter and O'Shea voted in favor, Directors Faulcon, Fisher, Krochmal and Capps voted in the negative. The motion did not pass.

Director Krochmal then raised a second motion for the Board to approve in principle the addition to Corpora of 'pre-17th century ranged martial pursuits' peerage. Directors Faulcon, Krochmal, Bainter, O'Shea and Capps voted in favor. Directors Sheppard and Fisher voted in the negative. A two thirds majority having been reached – the motion passed.

With the substance of the language to approve the new peerage in Corpora approved, the Board will now direct the Laurel Sovereign of Arms to develop and submit an appropriate name and heraldry for the new Order to the heraldic comment process to allow for the language to be added to Corpora and a date established for the opening of the new Order.

The Board would like to thank the vast number of people around the Knowne World who have worked tirelessly for many years to ensure that this decision could be made on a compelling evidence base – they appreciate the time, emotional, mental, and physical labor involved. You have the gratitude of the Society.

Further information will be made available as to the process and timeline for the proposal of the potential naming and heraldry of the incipient Order.

 - Membership numbers and expiration dates, that can be confirmed by the SCA Registry Membership.
 - Statement of Residency and active participation within the Kingdom of Atenveldt for twelve months immediately prior to the Crown Tournament.
 - The status of the name and device of the fighter and consort, either in submission or passed by the College of Heraldry.
 - Contact Information, including Society and Modern names.
 - A copy of the current Atenveldt Fighter Authorization card or other documentation that can be confirmed on the marshallate rolls.

Calling for Letters of Intent

The Baron and Baroness of Atenveldt are preparing to conclude their tenure and enjoy a much deserved retirement. It is time to request Letters of Intent. On Saturday, September 21st, 2024 at the Baronial Masquerade Ball there will be a polling for the next pair to lead the barony who will step up at Baronial Anniversary, December 7th.

Below are the Guidelines for Participation as a Baronial Candidate:

- Baronial candidates must be current paid members and must receive their *Southwind* or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years old.
- Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, & the Baron & Baroness no later than Wednesday, July 31st, 2024. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial Newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling.
- Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:
 - Full contact information, including SCA & modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, & membership numbers with expiration date.
 - Their reasons for seeking the position.
 - Their history of participation in the SCA & the Barony of Atenveldt.
 - Their plans for the future of the group.
 - Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron & Baroness.
 - Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a two or three year warrant in the position, & understand their Letter of Intent will be published in the Baronial Newsletter if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

In addition, please review the following information regarding your participation in the Barony of Atenveldt Polling. A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Atenveldt will be conducted on Saturday, September 21st 2024 to determine their support of candidates for Baron & Baroness. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling may be held immediately following the closing & tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, & must receive a *Southwind* or have an SCA membership in a zip code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

- Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt, & this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.
- NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Atenveldt, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown & Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections & preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.
- You must be 18 years old or older & present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

**** SPECIAL ZIP CODE EXCEPTION ****

If you DO NOT HAVE a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Atenveldt, but your membership is current and in a zip code in metropolitan Phoenix, you will be asked to sign a Pledge Form before you can receive a ballot. The Pledge Form shows your agreement with this statement:

"I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Atenveldt, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any Pollings held in the Barony of Sun Dragon or the Barony of Twin Moons for 3 years following the date of this polling."

A list of the members who sign this Pledge Form will be kept by the Kingdom Seneschal's office, and by the Seneschals of the three Baronies in the Phoenix metropolitan area. After signing the Pledge Form, you will be given a different color ballot to indicate your preference for Baron and Baroness.

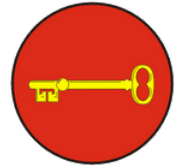

Kingdom Seneschal (Open until August 31, 2024)

The Kingdom Seneschal's office is seeking applications for the Kingdom Seneschal and Emergency Deputy Seneschal.

The Kingdom Seneschal is the primary officer and legal representative of the Kingdom of Atenveldt, and ultimately responsible for overseeing all events, and ensuring the Kingdom and Local Groups follow guidelines set forth by Corpora, Kingdom Financial Policy and Kingdom Law. This includes signing all Kingdom contracts for the SCA, Ensuring that the Kingdom and all SCA Local groups are maintaining group status, and adhering to SCA guidelines for operation and administration.



The Kingdom Seneschal's overall duties are:

Maintain Kingdom Law and administer changes to Kingdom Law.

- Advise the Crown on Kingdom Law and Corpora.
- Call such meetings, require such reports, and oversee such events as are necessary for the proper functioning of the Kingdom.
- Monitor official branches within the Kingdom to determine if they are maintaining the standards required for an official group and notify the Crown and the Board of Directors when groups fail to uphold the standards.
- Be ultimately responsible for all official Kingdom and inter-kingdom events held within Atenveldt.
- Distribute a copy of Kingdom Law to Royal Heirs at the time of Crown Tourney.
- Be responsible for the dissemination of information via *Southwind* any changes to law made by, or considered for change by, the Board of Directors.
- Be responsible for ensuring that Territorial Nobility review law changes proclaimed on any day other than the day of Coronation.
- Participate as a member of the Kingdom Financial Committee including authority as a second signer for a variety of Kingdom Checking Accounts.

This is a two-year warranted position reporting directly to the Crown and the Society Seneschal. The position requires an ability to tactfully work with Royalty, Officers and members of the populace.
