# Robert and Magge King and Queen of Calontir

Announced at Summer 2024 Coronation: "On this, the 13 day of July in the year 2024, Anno Societatis LIX (59), We, Robert Magnus and Magge Magnus, Crown of Calontir, issue a Temporary Removal from Participation in the SCA for Tammy Miller, known in the Society as Berke Chinua."

### Greetings,

It's a lovely day at Cooper's Lake as I write this between rainy days at Pennsic. One of my favorite parts about Pennsic is the amazing bardic opportunities here, and this month, I'm going to touch on how often you see heraldry in the music we sing.

On the business side, we have a job coming up, our Eyas Herald. Lady Dyrfinna Tonnudottir has done a fantastic job in that role, but it's about time for her to do great things with a new challenge. The Eyas Herald takes all the submissions from Calontiri, checks their paperwork, confirms they don't conflict, and sends that up the chain for approval. Letters for the position are due by the end of September, with a decision made by the end of Chilies. This will give about a month for Dyrfinna to help the new Eyas get up to speed quickly.

I've talked about all the fun stuff you can do with heraldry in terms of using your device, such as putting it on your tunic, or your camp furniture, or on jewelry. You can also have fun with heraldry in story and song. You might already know the lyrics of Hotspur, which include "the Blue Lion of Percy will bloody the ground." The blue lion in question refers to the device of the House of Percy, which is: Or, a rampant lion azure."

Side note: If you played Kingmaker, the old Avalon Hill wargame about the Wars of the Roses, you recognize this device easily. If you haven't played it, you should, as you'll get a great lesson on the heraldry of sixteenth-century England. There are, of course, any number of awesome songs including a reference to the gold striking falcon on our populace badge. There's Fernando's *Gold Bird of Prey*, Conn's *For Crown and For Kingdom*, and of course Hyrim's great line from *Sing Calontir*: "Sing for the falcon flying o'er a hill of foemen's bones."

Conn also has a great verse in *Conn's Song* about the power of heraldry. It goes:

My sister's lover was trampled under, But I've marked well his murderer's shield, And on the morrow his love will sorrow, As does my sister in yon cold field.

Sometimes, as in this case, having recognizable heraldry isn't a good thing. A real world example of heraldry can be found in Bryce de Byram's *In Praise of the New Knight*-

hood.

No need for such raiment have true Knights of Christ, their habit sewn simple of black or of white. They carry the cross of our savior above, their bath is of valor, and sweat and of blood.

That song is drawn from Bernard of Clairvaux's treatise about the Templars, whose banner was black and white with a red cross. Now, if you want the viewpoint from an SCA herald, be sure to check out Dorcas Whitecap's Heraldicism, Blarney. Dorcas is, of course, one of Calontir's hardest-working heralds and this song shows her dedication. It's a rapid-paced tongue-twister of a song with a lot of jokes that SCA heralds really appreciate. A keen-eyed reader might notice that I haven't mentioned *The Raven Banner*, which seems like it should be heraldic. It's about a symbol on a banner after all. However, the specific definition of heraldry is the study of coats of arms, defined in the Oxford English Dictionary as "a design or a shield that is a special symbol of a family, city, or other organization," such as when a device is registered in the SCA College of Heralds. The raven banner was not tied to a family, city, or other organization, hence, not heraldry.

It's still cool, though, so much so that the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 1<sup>st</sup> Armored Infantry Company of the Danish Guard Hussar Regiment includes the raven banner in its badge. It's a rainy Pennsic, so that means I can say goodbye using the company's motto, "When the storm subsides we rage on!"



- Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)
- Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

**Deadline:** The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
