Greetings all!

It's fall, my favorite time of the year and this year we've got lots to get to.

First, we're **still looking for a new Eyas Herald**. Lady Dyrfinna Tonnudottir has done a fantastic job in that role, but it's about time for her to do great things with a new challenge. The **Eyas Herald takes all the submissions from Calontiri, checks their paperwork, confirms they don't conflict, and sends that up the chain for approval.**

Letters for the position are due by the end of October, with a decision made no later than Crown Tournament.

We also need a **new Vert Hawk Herald**. This is the person in **charge of Calontir's Online Armorial**. Giovanni Loredan has done this job for a while; done it so well that it'll be difficult to replace him. However, if you're interested in making sure we have everyone's devices online so we can show them off, this is the job for you.

Applications also by the end of October, please.

Now it's time to let the fur fly!

Furs in heraldry are a special kind of tincture. You may recall from previous articles I talked about the various colors and metals used in heraldry. Colors being red, blue, green, black, and purple while the metals are gold/yellow and silver/white. "Tincture" is, essentially, the overarching term for colors, metals, and furs.

The etymology of fur is interesting in that while it's derived from Old French, it came to Old French from Frankish and the Germanic languages, not Latin. In that lineage, it stretches back to Proto-Indo European where it comes from the root meaning both to feed and protect. Obviously, the sense of protection against cold is how that climbs up through the languages.

The most common fur in heraldry is *ermine*, which is a white background with a pattern of black shapes that represent the winter coat of a stoat. There are a bunch of ways you can make those black shapes, but a common one is a sort of triangle with three points at the base and three dots around the top point.

Before we go much farther, I'll link to a handy website where you see the particulars: <http://www.scaheraldry.info/index.php?title=Furs>. Calontir's very own Gotfrid von Schwaben contributed to this, so thanks very much to him for all the work.

Because of this website, I'll stop describing the visual aspects as I can either describe them badly or I can describe them really badly.

As I said, ermine is black spots on white, but of course there are variants. *Counter-ermine* is, not surprisingly, white spots on black. *Erminois* is black spots on yellow while *Peau* is yellow spots on black.

But wait, there's more. You can actually put ermine spots on any color, such as "azure, ermined or," which would give you gold spots on blue.

There's also another main fur type, and that's "vair." Vair is Old French for two-toned squirrel fur and comes from the same root that gives us "various." In heraldry, vair is a construction of interlocking bells.

By default, these interlocking bells are white and blue, but it should come as no shock that you can change that. For example, "vair, or and purpure" would give you purple and gold bells. And who doesn't like purple and gold?

One last fur that is used on occasion is "potent." This is much like vair in that it's an interlocking shape, which in

this case is a broad, short T. Again, it can be any color, and who doesn't like or and purpure?

But I digress (Shocking, I know).

There's a trick with furs, however. Furs are generally called "neutral," which means that while you can't put a metal on a metal or a color on a color, you *can* put something that's neutral on either. However, the SCA considers ermine-derived furs to be their background tincture. Ermine, with a white background, is a metal; counter-ermine with its black background is a color, and so on.

Vair and potent *are* neutral, but (and this is an important but when it comes to making a device), the SCA requires some contrast in all their devices. So, for example, you couldn't put a white dragon on a vair field, which is normally blue and white, but you *could* put a red one on it, as it would show up.

So there's how you can make your device furry, if not fuzzy. Have a great month, everyone!

The Role of the Advocates

There has been quite a bit of confusion regarding the role of the Kingdom Advocates' Office in recent months. Part of that confusion stems from the fact that the job description is ever evolving and is based on both popu-

lace needs and rulings from the Board of Directors, the Society President and Society Seneschal. This article is an attempt to clarify some of the misconceptions that people may have regarding the position and purpose of the Advocate's Office.

First, the job of an advocate is to advocate for victims. When someone comes to us with an issue, understand that it is not our job to investigate or punish the perpetrator. We are prohibited by the BoD from doing an active investigating of the incident ourselves. The reasoning for this is that we are involved in advocating for the victim, so there is potential for bias.

Secondly, we are there to guide and support the victims through the reporting process. We will listen to your report of what happened and discuss what your options are, answer any questions you have, and stay in contact with you to communicate what's going on as we are able.

There are three options when someone reports an issue to us. All these choices are made by the victim, and we cannot and will not try to influence them to either escalate or de-escalate their choice.

1. The victim may just want us to write a report to have on file in case the perpetrator offends again to show a pattern of behavior with the perpetrator. This is the basic, "Hey, you guys need to know about this" option.

When this option is chosen, the victim should realize that they may be asked about what happened to them again if the perpetrator hurts or goes after another person, and that victim has decided to pursue more serious consequences for that second issue.

2. The advocates can be asked to mediate issues. The victim can either be present or not for this. If there is a member of the populace that has been hateful to you, and you make a report to the Advocates, we can sit with the you the victim, and the perpetrator and mediate the issue to reach some sort of agreeable conclusion between the two parties. If you don't want to be present, we can go to the perpetrator and present them with what occurred, discuss why what they did was inappropriate, and outline the consequences of continued bad behavior.

After the fact, we will write a report that will go into the Advocates' file. Again, if the person who had the complaint made about them reoffends against another person, you may be asked about the incident you reported.

This is to enable a pattern of behavior to be recognized if needed.

3. The third option is the "heavy" option. The victim has decided to pursue a sanction, banishment, or R&D. The victim reports to the Advocates and states they wish to make a formal complaint. The Advocates will take a written report that goes to the Kingdom Seneschal. The Kingdom Seneschal appoints an outside, impartial investigator. That person will talk to all parties involved, including witnesses, and then make a report of their findings. That report will be read by the Kingdom Seneschal and will be discussed with the King and Queen. Together, the three of them will decide on what will be done. Some things, like sanctions or banishment (exile), can be decided by the Crown. However, to have someone's membership revoked and prohibited from playing in the SCA altogether, the matter must go before the Board of Directors, and they may do their own investigation to make that determination.

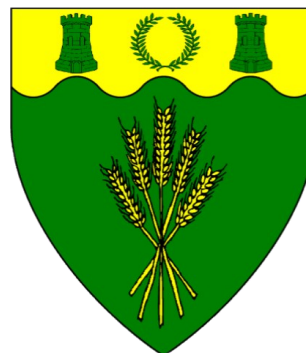
When the Advocate takes a report, we have the responsibility to be honest with the victim regarding what they can expect. The Advocates may explain that a victim's complaint may not meet the criteria for the corrective actions the victim may want, but that is only to prevent the victim from being disappointed. There are also things that the S.C.A. has no authority to oversee, and the Advocates will advise you what other options you have, if that is the case in your situation.

Some points to remember: The Advocates CANNOT solicit any reports. For instance, if I hear through the grapevine that you had an issue with someone, I cannot come up to you and say, "Hey, I heard you had an issue. Wanna make a report?" The Advocates must be approached by the victim, not the other way around. A witness to an incident can report that occurrence to the Advocates, and we can inquire with the victim about the incident to verify, but we cannot ask the victim to file a report. We can only document what the witness has told us.

Everything the Advocates have reported or told to them is confidential. Who has complaints against them, how many complaints, if they've had complaints against them before... The Advocates are prohibited from discussing those matters by the Kingdom and the BoD, with anyone other than the Kingdom Seneschal, the other Advocates, and a special investigator, if appointed.

If you are involved in a situation and aren't sure if you should reach out to the Kingdom Advocates and make a

report, we invite you to contact us and explain your issue. We can help you by clarifying what the Advocates can and cannot do in your situation, walk you through the reporting process, and give you support as you navigate the procedures necessary to bring your issue to a hopefully satisfactory conclusion. FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Flyers **MUST** contain these **SIX** ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
