The Kingdom is reflected in the glory of the Crown list and We would like to see a list worthy of this magnificent Kingdom. We have no additional requirements on entrants. The only requirements are those that are necessary to fight in any tournament and the Kingdom eligibility requirements. Your letter of intent should include the full SCA name of the combatant and the consort and the heraldry of each. Please also provide email addresses for both entrants.

Greetings Lochac,

My warrant has been extended and I will be stepping down in May.

Wanted: Someone to care for the various Arts and Sciences beloved by the artisans of our great Kingdom! Be amazed at and humbled by the skill and enthusiasm of our Kingdom, and play a role in supporting and developing a myriad of programs and events.

The Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences is one of the Greater Kingdom Officer roles ultimately responsible for the administration of all A&S in Lochac. You will be in fealty to the Crown, and typically have a two-year term.

Key requirements:

- You will need to be a current SCA member, 18 years or older.
- Reliable and responsive access to email
Ability to keep on top of a variety of A&S-related administrative tasks.

Key elements of the job:

- Taking care of the Kingdom's A&S website and Facebook group (directly or through deputies).
- Administration of the KMoAS email account and A&S Officer email list.
- Managing Kingdom-level competitions, and encouraging their uptake across the Kingdom.
- Oversight of the Guilds and Cockatrice.
- Reporting quarterly to the Kingdom Seneschal and Society Minister for A&S, as well as reading and replying to reports from the Kingdom's local groups.
- Caring for and administering local A&S officers.
- Being available to the populace to answer their questions on A&S, and listen to ideas on how we could be better.

Promoting the amazing artisans we have in this Kingdom, so more people can hear of their skills.

Some of these can be shared to deputies if they are not your interest or skill set - except reporting and officer administration. You will be supported by useful resources on competition guidance and procedures and notes on how to do the tasks listed above, as well as reports and A&S group Officers spread across the Kingdom.

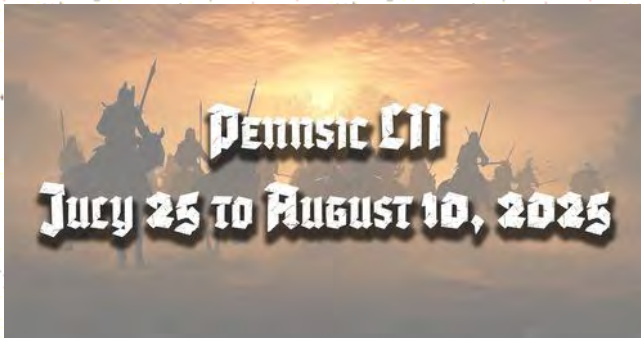

The SCA Ltd Board of Directors is in the process of getting the AGM agenda organised for the AGM which will be held the 4th of May 2025 at 2pm via Zoom (TBA).

A key part of the AGM is ensuring the continuation of the Board, with the appointment of new directors.

The current Board consists of:

Chair: Tam Hovenga, VIC (Lord Tomas van den Hove) – appointed February 2022

Secretary: Tegan Brinkman, SA (Genevieve Blackwolf) – appointed May 2022

Treasurer: David Potter, NSW (Norbert of Iken) – appointed May 2024

Board Members:

Amanda L'Estrelle, WA (Maestra Violetta Vasari) – appointed May 2024

Nicole Hellessey, TAS (Baroness Anna Felice Tavestoche) – appointed December 2024

Catherine Connor, CAN (Baroness Catherine James of Glastonbury) - appointed January 2025

The new directors will be replacing Tam Hovenga and Tegan Brinkman.

Directors typically serve for 3 years, and may take on membership of the executive during that time.

The Board of Directors is responsible for the overall governance of the SCA in Australia, including:

- Ensuring our policies and procedures comply with Australian legislation and regulations.
- Providing the required administrative infrastructure underpinning the SCA branches in Australia is in place and functioning.
- Providing support and systems to the SCA branches in Australia as required.

- Liasing with Kingdom Officers, primarily the Kingdom Seneschal, on matters that require board-level input, such as ratifying changes to officer handbooks and combat rules.

- Being the point of final appeal for sanctions.

- Liasing with SCA NZ Committee and SCA Inc (US) Board of Directors as needed on items of mutual interest.

The actual workload varies from month to month, however an average month would involve between 1-2 hours for the monthly board meeting, and 2-4 hours of other time working individually or jointly on committee tasks and projects.

You are required to have a directors ID prior to being accepted as a member of the board. I'm happy to advise on how to obtain this should this be a perceived barrier to entry.

Nominations will close by **Sunday, 6th April 2025**, to ensure they may be included in the AGM. Please send nominations to chair@sca.org.au or secretary@sca.org.au, including information about yourself and any information you would like to have published as part of the AGM agenda.

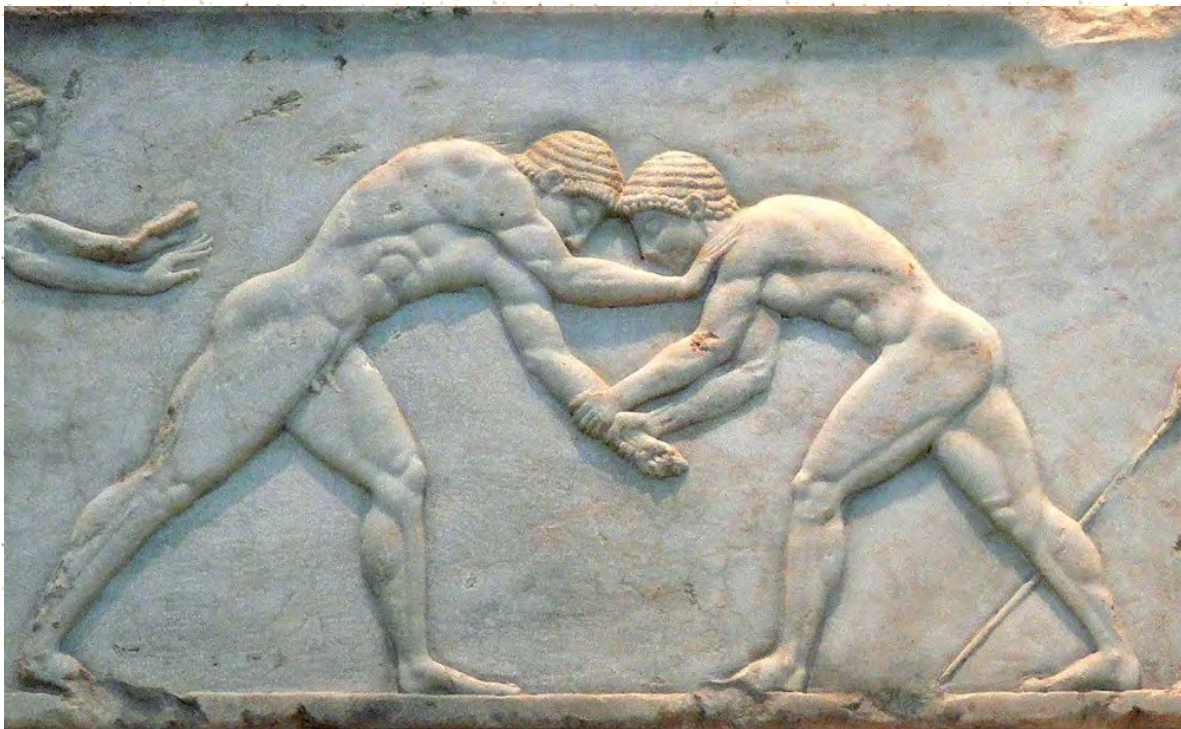
