THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

From the Board of Directors

REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY – CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB

Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments. Recruiting and Retention structural changes for member commentary and verbiage change to Corpora.



Court Reports

Court Report Debatable Lands Investiture 12/16 AS 58

Here begins the Report of the Court of Gareth and Juliana, King and Queen of Æthelmearc at Debatable Lands Investiture, December 16 AS 58, jorundr hinn rotinn reporting, with the assistance of Arias Beltran del Valle, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, and Angelino the Bookmaker.

In the Morning.

Baronessa Violeta and Praetoria Prima briefly addressed the populace wishing all had a fun day with the dancing, gaming, food, and other activities planned for the day.

Their Majesties called for Baron Brandubh Ó Donnghaile and Baroness Hilderun Hügelmann. They once again thanked them for their service as Landed Baronage of the Debatable Lands, and confirmed that they retained their rank as Court Baron and Court Baroness. Their Majesties invited all the newcomers to the Society to come forward. They gifted them with mugs by the hands of the artisans of the Kingdom in welcome.

Their Majesties called for Baron Arias Beltran del Valle to present himself. He was looking quite alive, so Their Majesties called for the youth of the Kingdom and sent them chasing after him with the Kingdom toy chest.

Their Majesties gave leave to Their Excellencies Violeta and Prima to hold Their First Baronial Court.

Their Majesties invited Mistress Graidhne ni Ruaidh to attend Them. Mistress Graidhne had found an individual that she wished to take as a protegé. Mistress Graidhne asked to be joined by Lord Alan Notty who agreed.

Their Majesties called for Cadence of the Debatable Lands.Cadence had been seen helping around the Debatable Lands and Kingdom. She has taken up a blade and authorized in fencing as well. For this Their Majesties Awarded her Arms. Scroll by Christina Mary Lowe with words by Chaghagan Ghunan.

Their Majesties summoned Etienne Renault. His impact around Pennsic in the Baronial camp is noticed by many, he further helps out around other events. For this Their Majesties Awarded him Arms. Scroll illuminated by Maria Cristina de Cordoba with calligraphy by Eleanore Godwin.

Their Majesties called Lady Elinor Walden. She has been working as part of the Barony's sewing guild, did much of the work on the Baronial cloaks, and has been working to assist on the archery ranges. For this Their Majesties inducted her into the Order of the Keystone. Scroll by Zosia Kowalewska. Their Majesties invited Rei Regenbogen before Them. Rei has been shooting archery, sewing, doing scribal arts, and enthusiastically learning other activities. For this They named them a Noble of Their Court and Awarded them Arms. Scroll by Máirghréad Stíobhard inghean uí Choinne.

Their Majesties demanded the presence off Baron Arias Beltran del Valle. They demanded to see his papers, which were presented by Master Kieran MacRae. Upon reviewing them Their Majesties found Them to be in order and signed them on the spot, or rather table. Their Majesties spoke of Arias' skill in heavy weapons, and his passion on the field and so named him a Companion of the Golden Alce. Their Majesties announced that Their Curia will be held on Friday January 12 at the same site for Æthelmearc Twelfth Night.




