Happy 2024 everyone! May this be the best year you've ever had.

Thanks to all the awesome folk in the College of Heraldry, there's not a lot of business this month, though we do have a couple of officer changes. Mistress Sofya la Rus is taking over the Purple Herald position. The Purple Herald is there to step in and take over should a bus "accidentally" run over the Gold Falcon. Previously, Her Ladyship Zaneta Baseggio held that position, having accepted my request to stay on there for a while since she'd served previously as Gold Falcon.

Sofya had been the Habicht herald, which is responsible for helping heralds learn how to do the job. She handled this position for many years and did great job. Lady Shoshanah bas Nachman fun Magenza is Sofya's replacement and she has some big shoes to fill.

If you were at Kris Kinder, you saw some of the college's best kicking a... er... doing great work. Krazy Uji's House of Heraldry was once again, a big hit but that was because of all the people doing the work. At the head of this crew was Lady Dyrfinna Tonnudottir, our Eyas Herald.

The Eyas Herald is one of the most important positions within the college, as they handle all the submissions before it goes to the great SCA College of Heraldry in the ether. It's their job to dot all the Is and cross all the Ts. She is one huge reason why my first year as Gold Falcon went so smoothly.

As I say, though, it's an important position and we want to make sure there are folks ready to step in when it's her time for new challenges. If you're at all vaguely interested in heraldry, are well organized, and want to help your fellow Calontiri, then reach out to Dyrfinna. She's looking for people to help out and learn what she does.

Now to the part where we talk new year, new heraldry!

Did you know you can replace your heraldry registered with the SCA? I know, because I've done it. My current heraldry is: Azure, a dragon passant and a bordure engrailed Or. I also have a badge: Azure, a dragon passant above two swords saltire Argent. This badge was my first device, which I changed to a badge (you can have several of these) and kept registered to me when I registered the new heraldry.

Why'd I make the change? I didn't like the way the dragons and the swords looked on top of each other. They kind of meshed into one strange, but very pointy, creature.

So why did I create it in the first place? Ah, now that's a story from a different time. For years before I got into the SCA, I went to gaming conventions. There, I played in Living City, a precursor to the modern Adventurer's League for D&D players at conventions. I created a series of paladins and clerics from the Silversword family.

The two argent swords in saltire came directly from those characters. Yes, D&D characters inspire my first device. I would be shocked if I'm the only one for whom that's true in the SCA.

As to my colors, those came from the Dallas Cowboys, whose heraldic colors are Azure and Argent. I've been a Cowboys fan for a loong time and those seem right and proper heraldic colors to me. I also bet I'm not the only person in the SCA who chose their heraldic colors from their favorite sports team.

Then there's the dragon. That's from the Welsh flag. Howell is a Welsh name, and that's been my persona since the beginning. The Old English research came later, but that was no hindrance, for Alfred the Great's biographer was Bishop Asser, who was Welsh but found service across the border.

As I said, though, the swords and the dragon didn't look as good on banners and shields as they had in my mind, so I decided to change it in 2004 or so. This time my inspiration came from another game, Kingmaker. This is the great Avalon Hill game about the Wars of the Roses. I wonder how many heralds in the SCA think of Kingmaker as one of their first experiences with heraldry. I'm definitely one.

So as I thought about rebuilding my device, I went back to the devices in that game. The Talbot family (Gules, a lion rampant Or) was always one of my favorites there, and I adapted it for my use.

The main tincture remained Blue. I went with Or for the rest, in part because I liked how blue and yellow meshed better than blue and white and in part because I was getting ready to leave Vatavia for grad school and I wanted to keep hold of home.

The dragon remained, as that was still good and Welsh, but then came the question of the swords, plus anything else I could think of to make it more me. In the end, I chose to leave it just the dragon. No chief, no other charges, just plain old Azure, a dragon passant and a bordure engrailed Or.

I personally like when devices are simple, so I kept to that principle.

And in truth, I didn't need anything else. All the aspects of the current device remind me of the things I honored in the first one because I think about all the choices I made along the way. So the Silverswords are still there, as are the Cowboys.

All of this is to say that if you want to improve your device, or change it completely, you can! The new one just has to pass through the College of Heraldry exactly like the old one. As for turning the old into a badge, that's really easy. You just say you want to do that. Since it's already passed, assuming you'd registered it before, you don't even need to worry about that.

Your heraldry should bring you joy, and if you want to update it to who you are now as opposed to the person you were when you first registered something, go for it.

That is why there must always be a head water bearer—to take the reins of those wagons and guide them to kurultai, skirmish, and War. And while it has been my honor to be the head water bearer, the sun is setting on my time.

When it rises again, there must be another to bear that banner and responsibility. REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY – CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

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FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
