Meet the Peer

Master Adam Goodwine

Order of Defense



What is your persona and what drew you to it? Adam Goodwine is an Elizabethan-era Crown agent working for Walsingham. He spent time on the seas with Sir Francis Drake and traveled far and wide in Her Majesty's service. Sometime in his colorful past, he met a wonderful lady from Navarra, and the two raised a beautiful family – having spent a period in Novgorod as an ambassador.

What drew me to it was the name. I was picking at the Heralds, who didn't want me to use a pun (Sexhua Lovechild) and settled on A-damn-good-wine (as in "what gets better with age?"). From there, I researched and found Goodwine's in England. My fascination with Christopher Marlowe led me to Walsingham ... and voila. Basically, it evolved from a joke and my penchant for looking things up.

How did you find the SCA? I knew about the SCA for many years before I joined, having attended several Coast Con and UNO demos. My wife and I were looking for a family-friendly educational activity and tried an Axemoor Populace meeting. We formally joined shortly after.

What was your first SCA event? Gulf Wars 1998, other than prior demos.

What SCA activities are you the most interested in? Currently practicing fencing with my sons. The long car rides between events allow us to spend time discussing things we are often too busy at home to discuss. I also really like analyzing fencing videos with them and for my Provosts.

If you could start on your path again with all the knowledge you have now, what if anything, would you do differently? There wasn't a fencing peerage when I started working in and supporting the fencing community, so it's a more difficult question for a 20+ year person to answer. If I had to advise my younger self, it would be to learn patience and practice empathy more. Don't be so hard on your failures. You only learn through trying things.

What is the best advice you received about being a peer? Remember that it is a job. People tend to forget that it's work and not simply a prize to win. Recognition is a great feeling, but the recognition is that you are ready and capable of doing the work, not just that you are good at something.

What is the worst advice you received about being a peer? Ironically, the same – that it's a job. Some people take the job aspect too far and forget that this is a volunteer organization. The recognition of peerage and the acceptance of the job/role are not the same as the job that pays your salary. Remember to prioritize your mundane job and family.

What is the one thing you wish someone had told you about being a peer? Nothing really comes to mind; I was pretty well informed, to be fair. Very few understand until they become a peer how much fun they had on the journey (which can be admittedly stressful) – and it isn't easy to recapture that energy once you take the job. Be ready to set new goals and redefine what you consider "wins" to keep you invigorated.

What's something people try to tell you is peerlike, or is not peerlike, that you disagree with? Many people seem to think that taking on work for the sake of the work is peerly and an expectation, and I tend to disagree. Sometimes, you need to step up to get things done, but the bulk should be work you enjoy doing. Frankly, if you aren't enjoying the work, you will probably not do a job as well as someone who will, and you will burn out fast on your hobby. Ideally, you should have gotten the peerage for doing work you enjoy and continuing that work shouldn't be a total hardship.

What is your favorite SCA moment? Too many good memories to point to any specific one as my favorite.

For Fun - What SCA skills have you learned that would help you survive a zombie apocalypse? I think the best is honing people skills in a volunteer organization, and learning how to bring out their best is a terrific skill that the SCA encourages. It would help bring together many frightened people in a zombie apocalypse.

For Fun - What is your favorite cuss word? Shyte – no idea why.

For Fun - Is a hotdog a sandwich? Why or Why Not? I'm gluten-free on a non-inflammatory diet. I view a hotdog (in the classical sense) as pain.

REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY – CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

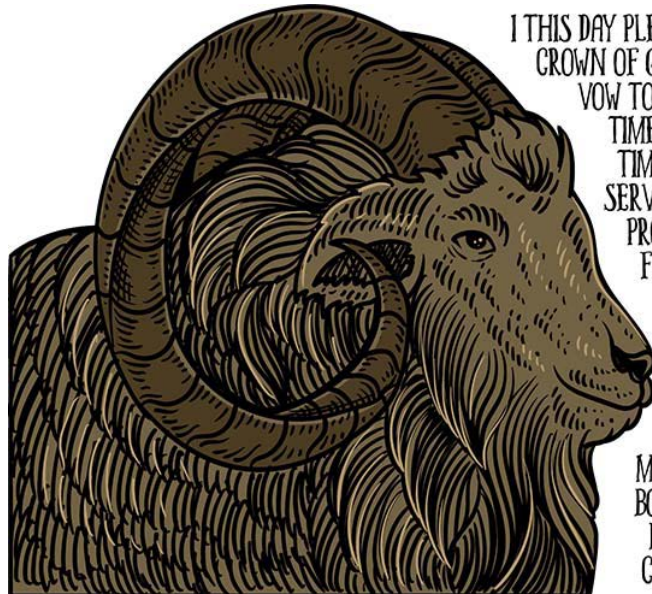
