Before him sat King Roak I, the far-rider, and Carlotta, who keeps her own counsel.

From the Kingdom Senschal

Hello sunshines!

It has been almost a year and a half since I have stepped into the role of Kingdom Seneschal, and as such I am beginning the process of seeking my successor. While I would not be stepping down until next summer, I would like to have time to work with my successor prior to the change over the office. The deadline for applications is Dec 31, 2024. Applications should include a letter of interest and your SCA and Mundane resume with relevant experience. Please send all applications to myself by email at ealdormere.kseneschal@gmail.com. Questions are welcome! If you wish to talk about the role and the responsibilities of the Kingdom Seneschal please feel free to contact me.

Full details of the Kingdom Seneschal Role are outlined in Corpora, Kingdom Law, The Seneschal's Handbook, and the Policies and Procedures of Ealdormere. In the interest of space, I won't list the duties out here.

At Coronation, the newest laws were read into court at feast. They've been repeated below as required by kingdom law.

I look forward to seeing everyone at events this autumn.

In Service, Lucia de Moranza

Law changes:

II-900 To ensure the smooth administration of the Kingdom, the Crown must maintain a means of direct communication (such as telephone, permanent mailing address, e-mail) with the populace throughout Their reign.

V-107 To ensure the smooth administration of the Kingdom, all members of the Privy Council must maintain a means of direct communication (such as telephone, permanent mailing address, e-mail) with the populace throughout their term in office.

VI-100 The Officers of State shall be the Kingdom Seneschal, the Trillium Principal Herald, the Earl Marshal, the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences, the Kingdom Exchequer, the Kingdom Chronicler, the Kingdom Clerk-Register, the Kingdom Chatelaine, and the Kingdom DEIB Officer.

VII-900 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall be responsible for promoting and fostering recruitment and retention of members of the Society within the Kingdom.

VII-901 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall be responsible for the conduct of any kingdom level demonstrations or recruiting events.

VII-902 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall appoint deputies as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the office.

VII-903 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall adhere to the laws governing financial accounting and contracts (Article XVI) and the Kingdom Operating Policies, Section One – Financial, when administering the financial aspects of the office. The Kingdom Chatelaine shall report to the Kingdom Exchequer regarding all financial matters pertaining to the office.

VII-904 The Kingdom Chatelaine and all subordinate officers will provide to the appropriate branch seneschal a copy of those reports necessary to maintain branch status by a date mutually acceptable to the officer and the branch seneschal.

VII-1000 The Kingdom DEIB Officer shall be responsible for promoting an equitable, open and welcoming environment in the Kingdom to cultivate a climate in which all members are treated fairly and able to thrive.

VII-1001 The Kingdom DEIB Officer shall appoint deputies as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the office.

VII-1002 The Kingdom DEIB Officer will refer any inquiries, concerns or incidents involving violations of the Society's inclusivity policies to the Kingdom Seneschal or Kingdom Lawspeaker as appropriate.

IX-101 Due to the nature of the work required of the Lawspeaker, the position of Lawspeaker will be a warranted deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal, for the purposes of Legal and Insurance coverage. It is hereby noted that while the Lawspeaker is a warranted deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal, the Lawspeaker shall not report any confidential mediation, arbitration or consultation issues to the Kingdom Seneschal, unless all involved parties request it. The Lawspeaker stands outside the formal reporting structure of the Kingdom, the better to act as a mediator, ombudsman and councilor to the Crown and people of Ealdormere.

IX-400 The term of office for the Lawspeaker shall be three years. The outgoing Lawspeaker may be considered an eligible candidate assuming they receive the required nominations and is confirmed by the Kingdom Seneschal, Sovereign, Consort, or either of the Crown Heirs.

IX-500 In the event the Lawspeaker is unable to fulfill their duties; they shall appoint an interim replacement subject to ratification by the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal. The Kingdom Seneschal and Crown may choose to allow the interim replacement to act for a stated period of time. At the end of this period, the Lawspeaker may resume their duties. The period of absence shall be included as part of the Lawspeaker's term in office. Or the Crown may choose to ask the Kingdom Seneschal to proceed with the selection process upon ratification of the interim replacement. The selection procedure as outlined in IX-300 shall be initiated immediately.

IX-804 The Lawspeaker shall not be responsible for any investigations requested by the Society Board of Directors or Society Officers, deferring to the Kingdom Seneschal in such matters. The Kingdom Seneschal may involve the Lawspeaker as a deputy or appointed representative at their discretion.


X-203 There is a slate of local officers consisting, at minimum, of a Seneschal and an Exchequer and either a Pursuivant, a Marshal, a Minister of Arts and Sciences, or a Chatelaine.

X-303 There is a full slate of local officers consisting at minimum of a Seneschal, Pursuivant, Exchequer, a Chronicler, and either a Marshal, Minister of Arts & Sciences, Clerk-Register, or a Chatelaine.

XIV-300 Any subject of Ealdormere may ask the Lawspeaker to mediate disputes within the Kingdom. If the Lawspeaker cannot mediate the situation, the Crown shall direct the Lawspeaker to appoint a Court of Inquiry. A subject of Ealdormere under banishment from the royal presence or banishment from the realm retains this right.








