

When preparing your article, be sure to include all required information:

- Event date (day, month and legal year)
- Sponsoring group's name
- Site name, street address, city, state and zip code
- · Exact site opening and closing times
- Event Steward(s) name (SCA)
- Event Steward(s) e-mail
- Site Fee(s) including any applicable surcharges
- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.
- Event Articles should be provided as an attached MS Word, .txt, or Open Office file.







Letter from the Society President






Kingdom Sanction

Warmest greeting unto the populace of the Barony of Granite Mountain. Listed below are the requirements for submitting your Letters of Intent for the Territorial Nobility of Granite Mountain and the information concerning participation in both the virtual and the in person polling.

Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal and the Baron and Baroness of Granite Mountain no later than July 31, 2025. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling (with personal information redacted).

Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:

- Full contact information, for both of the persons seeking to serve as the Baronage, including SCA and modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, and membership numbers and expiration dates.
- Their reasons for seeking the position
- Their history of participation in the SCA and the Barony in which they reside
- Their plans for the future of the group
- Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Territorial Nobility
- Their statement that they are willing to be installed with their preference of either two or a three-year warrant in the position.

Virtual Polling

Virtual polling will be initiated on August 10, 2025 at 6 AM and will close on August 15, at 6 PM, 2025

In Person Polling:

In person polling will commence on August 16, 2025, directly following Investiture court, and will close promptly two hours after. As is required, please bring proof of membership and a picture ID for polling purposes.

Special Zip Code Exception Form: If you do not have a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Granite Mountain, but identify yourself as a member of the Barony of Granite Mountain, you may sign a special zip code exception pledge form. The pledge form simply states that you consider yourself a member of the Barony of Granite Mountain, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that you will not cast a ballot in any other baronial polling for the duration of the term of service of the prospective Baronage. This form shall remain on file for the duration of the Baronages' tenure.

Law Change/Update

C. Required Events: Although additional events may be approved by the Kingdom Financial Committee, each calendar year the Kingdom of Atenveldt shall hold the following Kingdom events. 

Update on Background Checks

Who needs an SCA background check and why? How long is it valid? How do you apply for one? All those questions are answered below!





All official or "published" SCA Youth Activities must have one background checked adult member who acts as the official "coordinator" for the SCA Youth Activity. For example, if there are 10 youth A&S classes each in their own separate classroom, each classroom needs to follow the "two-deep rule," but only one overall youth "coordinator" responsible for all activity in all classrooms is needed. There are many activities of the SCA where informal instruction (mentoring) occurs that are open to attendance by minors, but do not constitute dedicated and/or published SCA Youth Activities. They are known by many names (e.g., Practices, Meetings, and Guilds, and Workshops). A minor's attendance at an adult A&S class does not mean that class becomes an SCA Youth Activity simply because a youth is in attendance.

The "two-deep" rule specifies that for all SCA Youth Activities, a minimum of two adults (at or above the age of legal majority in the state, province or country in which the activity occurs) unrelated to one another by blood, marriage or personal relationship must be present. This policy does not relieve parents of their primary responsibility for the welfare and behavior of their children. One of these two adults may also be acting as the official coordinator for the Youth Activities going on.

The Kingdom of Atenveldt has chosen to follow this requirement without additional background check requirements for other positions outside of the Kingdom Seneschal and Youth Officers. The only exception to this practice is for groups who are very small or remote and have official youth activities that require an officer or member with a background check in order to have those activities.

Upon approval, background checks are valid for 2 years, or when the person's membership expires, whichever comes first. Keeping the background check valid requires the person's membership to be current. If the background check is needed longer than 2 years, the process will have to start again – the background check cannot be automatically "extended".

To request a background check, send an email with a copy of your current warrant that shows your legal name, membership number, and expiration date to the Kingdom of Atenveldt Deputy Seneschal for Background Checks at backgroundchecks@atenveldt.org. That will start the process for Atenveldt requesting a background check to the corporate office. Then the officer/requestor will receive an email from a third-party for additional information in order to run the background check. Results will be sent to the officer/member who requested the background check. This entire process could take several weeks.

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
