From the Kingdom Seneschal

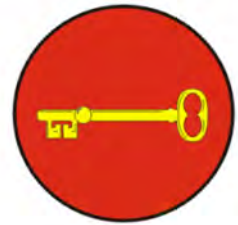
Greetings, Caid!

Create 12 items based on a theme that are suitable for largesse. EXAMPLES: - 12 needle books - 12 hats from different (or the same) period(s) - 12 items suitable for a specific time period - 12 children's toys --- 12 socks would not be suitable as that is only 6 pairs

Tag all of the items with the maker's name, ready to be gifted the day of the competition.

DIRTY DOZEN DONATION DERBY Cont'd:

The items need not be documentable; this is not an Arts and Sciences competition.

The items should not have heraldry on them as they are meant to be given to other areas.

Judging is done by the populace. Each entrant display will have a cup placed next to it and anyone may put a provided token into the accompanying cup to denote their choice. The entrant with the most tokens in their cup at the end of the day chooses one item from any one of the other entries as a prize. Each entrant then chooses from the remaining entries according to how many tokens they receive (largest to smallest number). Each entry may only be chosen once as a prize. The remaining 11 items from each entry will be given to Their Highnesses, at the end of the day for use as largess during Their Reign. The Rapier list will be single elimination, except that a second life may be gained by demonstration or display of a recent art or science project. Finals will be fought best of 11 with no weapons form repeated (Commonly referred to as an Uberelf), so please bring out all of your secondaries (Extras will be on hand as necessary). A prize will also be awarded to the Most Well-Rounded Fighter of the day.

The Cut & Thrust list will also be a single elimination, except that a second life may be gained by demonstration or display of a recent art or science project. Finals will also be fought best of 11 but it will be first blood, weapons forms will be negotiated between the MoDs on site.

If a fighter Really wants to, they may enter both lists, but the extra life from an art only applies to one list, and they must choose when entering the list.

No Masters of Defense may enter the lists but they are encouraged to marshal and watch.

A&S COMPETITION:

The arts and science competition is open to all who choose to enter. Entries will be on display during the day. (If you plan to take your entry into combat, please provide a photo and brief description of the piece for the display.) Fighters with an arts entry will be given a token to be redeemed at the list table for a second life. The Ladies of the Rose have kindly volunteered to judge the arts competition.
