A Missive from The Incoming Royal Majesties

- Weapon restriction- No multi-weapon fighting style. (Florentine, Madu and sword, for example)
- Format- This will be a double elimination tournament. Each bout will be fought the best two out of three. The finals will be the best of 5.
- Seeding- The competitor with the lowest precedent will pick any other competitor that is higher in precedent. This will proceed until all competitors have an opponent. In the event of an odd numbered tournament, the person with the highest precedent will receive a bi-fight.
- •Letters will be accepted beginning May 1, 2025 and concluding on May 18th. They should include proof of membership and a copy of the fighter's authorization card. Letter should be emailed to the Crown, Kingdom Senschal, Earl Marshal, and Kingdom Exchequer.
