CROWN TOURNEY ENTRANT INSTRUCTIONS

Ave, Nobiles Pugnatores Artemisiae,

In this season of destiny and valor, we summon those whose hearts are as resolute as the steel they bear. As the appointed hour approaches—when we shall seek the heirs to our storied tradition—we now call for the submission of your letters of intent for the forthcoming Crown Tournament.

Let it be known that the tournament list will be divided into two or more pools, where the top fighters from each will advance into a single-elimination bracket. In this trial, both physical strength and the fortitude of spirit shall be tested. For this contest is not merely a measure of might, but a proving ground for the courage and resolve of true leaders—those destined to lead and serve the Kingdom of Artemisia.

To take up the sword in this tournament is to embrace the timeless virtues of duty, courage, and honor. It is to stand before our people as a living testament to our highest ideals, accepting with stoic grace both fortune's favor and its challenges. Your participation is not only a personal quest for glory but a solemn pledge to lead and serve our realm with wisdom and valor.

We call upon you to submit your letters of intent—whether by email or in person—at your earliest convenience. Even if they are hand-delivered, both your letter and Crown Entrant Forms (for both persons) must be emailed to <mailto:crown.list.entry@artemisia.sca.org> - this will forward to Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, and List minister. All submissions must be received no later than two weeks before the commencement of Crown Tourney, that is, on or before April 5th. Late submissions will not be accepted and may forfeit your right to participate.

Let your letters be a testament to your commitment to the future of Artemisia. May your passion, your skill, and your unwavering spirit shine forth as you answer this call. In the heat of contest, let there be no dishonor—only the noble clashing of arms and the forging of bonds that shall guide our Kingdom to ever greater heights.

Eligibility Requirements:

Entrants must have resided within the Kingdom of Artemisia for twelve (12) months and to have been active in the SCA for the twelve (12) months preceding the tournament. Entrants' SCA membership information must reflect their residence in Artemisia and combatants must have a current combat authorization in Artemisia. They must be at least eighteen (18) years of age, have a regular means of quick communication, dependable transportation, and sufficient income to support the Crown should they win. They must be acceptable unto the Crown of Artemisia. Each unbelted combatant must have a member of the Order of Chivalry who is willing to speak for them at the time of Crown Tournament.

Additionally, each entrant must agree to remain resident of the Kingdom of Artemisia throughout their tenure and reign, to familiarize themselves with Corpora and Kingdom Law, Kingdom Financial Policy and be willing to swear on their honor that, should they win, they believe themselves competent to hold the Crown of Artemisia. Proof of membership and copies of combat authorization cards are no longer required in the entrant packet, as they are now checked from the database.
