Proceed for aprox. 1.5 miles and make a U-turn at State Rte. 1005 (going back west on 60). The fairgrounds will be less than a mile ahead on your Right. From North or South of Richmond - take 95 to exit 62 for Route 288N. Proceed approx. 20 miles to the exit for US60 West/ Midlothian Turnpike. Proceed west for approx. 15 miles (60 becomes Anderson Hwy. in Powhatan) and the Fairgrounds will be on the right.




