Proposed Changes to Kingdom Law

1. Removed requirement for physical mailing of kingdom law amendment changes. This was not defined who would complete this task or who the populous was to make this request to. To better align kingdom resources, both monetary and volunteer time, this is being removed from law.

~~Any member of the Society of Creative Anachronism residing in the Kingdom of Trimaris may request a written copy of the proposed law changes referred to in the notice at the Kingdom's expense.~~

~~(i) Any notice published in the Kingdom newsletter pursuant to this section shall include the following language: "Those members of the Society for Creative Anachronism who wish to do so may contact the Kingdom Chronicler for a paper copy of the proposed law changes, to be mailed at the Kingdom's expense."~~

~~Removed courts of chivalry as per changes by SCA corpora:~~

~~COURTS OF CHIVALRY~~

~~A. General~~

~~1. Courts of Chivalry within the Kingdom of Trimaris will be for the purpose of investigation into matters within the medieval framework of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. As such, Courts of Chivalry are for the benefit of the Crown and shall not supplant or replace the investigative duties or powers of the Kingdom Seneschal.~~

~~2. Courts of Chivalry pertain only to conduct and matters within the structure and definitions of the Society.~~

~~3. The Kingdom Seneschal will have the responsibility for the convening of all Courts of Chivalry in the Kingdom.~~

~~a) If a Court of Chivalry is convened wherein the Kingdom Seneschal is the subject of the inquiry, the Crown will appoint a Peer of the Realm to assume the duties assigned to the Kingdom Seneschal by these laws.~~

~~B. Notification~~

~~1. Any person or group desiring that a Court of Chivalry be convened for any reason will petition the Kingdom Seneschal and the Crown in writing. The petition will include the following information:~~

~~a) The name of the petitioner~~

~~b) The name of the proposed subject of the Court~~

~~c) The nature of the charge(s)~~

~~d) The names of the witnesses against the subject~~

~~e) The nature of the evidence against the subject~~

~~f) An affirmative statement that the petitioner has attempted to resolve the issue via the grievance procedures and a recitation of the specific efforts that the petitioner has taken to resolve the issue via the grievance procedures, supported with copies of all correspondence relating to the grievance procedure, or a detailed statement as to why this is inapplicable or inappropriate under the circumstances.~~

~~2. The Kingdom Seneschal will examine the petition and present it to the Crown with advice as to whether the evidence warrants a formal Court of Chivalry. a) If it is determined that the evidence does not warrant a formal Court, the matter may be settled in a lesser manner; for example: by means of a reprimand; or by referring the matter to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal.~~

~~b) If it is determined that the evidence does warrant a formal Court of Chivalry, the Kingdom Seneschal will convene the Court as provided for by these Laws. 3. If a Court of Chivalry is to be convened, the Kingdom Seneschal will notify the subject by certified mail that the Court of Chivalry is to be convened, and will include the following information:~~

~~a) A copy of the petition~~

~~b) A list of the formal charges to be brought before the Court~~

~~c) A list of four proposed dates and places for the Court to be held, spanning not less than four weeks and not more than eight weeks:~~

~~(i) The dates will fall on a Saturday or Sunday during a Society event within Trimaris.~~

~~(ii) An event may be scheduled for the Court of Chivalry, if necessary.~~

~~d) A copy of this law (containing the procedures for the hearing of the case) and any other laws pertaining to the case~~

~~e) The nature of the evidence against the subject~~

~~f) A copy of all correspondence relating to the grievance procedure provided to the Kingdom Seneschal by the petitioner~~

~~4. The Kingdom Seneschal will also send a copy of the letter of notification to the subject's local seneschal to ensure notification:~~

~~a) If the subject's address is unknown and cannot be determined, then this notification will suffice; the local seneschal will then make reasonable attempts to notify the subject including general announcements at the local meetings.~~

~~5. The subject will have two weeks to reply either from the date that the notification was mailed, or, if the subject's address is unknown, from the date of the general announcement at the local meeting.~~



Proposed Changes to Kingdom Law



6. The subject will choose one of the four proposed dates and places for the convening of the Court of Chivalry.
 - a) If the subject of the Court fails to respond within the period specified by these laws, the Kingdom Seneschal will select one of the proposed dates and places. The Kingdom Seneschal will also notify the subject in writing as to when and where the Court of Chivalry will be held with or without the subject's attendance. If the subject's address is unknown, the local seneschal will then make reasonable attempts to notify the subject, including general announcements at the local meeting.
 - b) In the unusual circumstance that none of the proposed dates and places are acceptable, the subject will petition the Kingdom Seneschal and the Crown in writing within ten (10) business days of being notified of the Court of Chivalry, to request another date and place. A copy of the petition must be sent to the Kingdom Seneschal. The granting of said petition will be at the discretion of the Crown.
7. The populace will be notified of the convening of the Court of Chivalry.
 - a) The notification will include the name of the subject of the Court of Chivalry, the name of the petitioner(s), the charges, the date, and the place the Court of Chivalry will be convened.
 - b) Courts of Chivalry will be open to the populace.
- C. Procedure
 1. The Crown will preside over a Court of Chivalry
 - a) The Crown may appoint a Peer of the Realm to preside in Their name. b) In cases where the proceedings of a Court of Chivalry extend into the next Reign, the following Crown may re-appoint the former presiding Peer to continue in that office to preserve the continuity of the Court proceedings.
 - c) In the event the Crown is the petitioner or subject of a Court of Chivalry, the Court of Chivalry shall be continued until the following reign.
 2. The composition of a Court of Chivalry and the procedure followed in presenting evidence will be at the discretion of the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal subject to the restrictions of the Laws of the Kingdom.
 3. The Kingdom Seneschal will cause a complete record of the proceedings of the Court of Chivalry to be made by whatever means is determined to be most efficient and reliable.
 - a) A copy of this record will be made available to the subject of the Court of Chivalry within a reasonable time after the conclusion of the proceedings.
 4. On the day of the Court of Chivalry a jury will be chosen at random from those Peers of the Realm who are present. The jury will be comprised of at least six members, but not more than ten.
 5. The subject of the Court of Chivalry will be permitted to be represented and advised by counsel as he or she chooses.
 - a) The Crown will appoint a Peer of the Realm acceptable to the subject to aid in his or her defense if the subject so requests.
 6. The subject of the Court of Chivalry will have the right to present evidence and call witnesses in presenting his or her response.
 7. The Crown or Peer presiding over the Court of Chivalry is entitled to call and question any witness they deem relevant to the proceeding for the purpose of ensuring that a full and complete disclosure of the relevant facts are presented to the jury.
 - a) The subject of the Court of Chivalry shall have the right to question any witness so called.
 8. Upon the conclusion of the case, the jury will present to the Crown its recommendation for the disposition of the case.
 9. The final decision as to what, if any, action(s) will be taken in resolving the case before the Court of Chivalry rests with the Crown.
 10. The subject of a Court of Chivalry may appeal any resulting sanction to the Board of Directors of the Society in the manner specified by the Organizational Handbook.

Defining Chivalry regalia in verbiage to match corpora while keeping specific Trimaris tradition. I know this seems funky wording, but this is the best way to keep the Trimarian specific garter tradition available while breaking out the Unadorned chains of gold are reserved for use by the Chivalry, but only if they have sworn their fealty to the Crown. Spurs of gold, simple white belts and simple white garters are reserved for use of the Chivalry. Regalia reserved for members of the Chivalry are simple white garters and spurs of gold. Regalia reserved for Knights of the Chivalry is a white belt and an unadorned gold chain as a symbol of their fealty. Regalia reserved for Masters of Arms of the Chivalry is a white baldric (worn diagonally from shoulder to hip).

New verbiage for Herald Extraordinary

Herald Extraordinary (HE) given to a senior herald of the Kingdom to recognize their extreme service to the Kingdom and College of Arms. Recommendation of this award can come from the Triskele Herald. As this award is recognized in the Order of Precedence, the recommendation from the Triskele Herald should give a written summary of the contributions of the intended recipient to the Crown for consideration.

Searching for a Successor A/S Warranting Officer

The Successor A/S Warranting Officer serves under the direction of the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences and is responsible for the obtaining and completion of Warrants for new A/S officers, ensuring protocols are followed, and maintaining the spreadsheet that lists all such officers.

The Successor A/S Warranting Officer reports A/S Warranting 5 times a year (4 quarters and End of Year Domesday) to the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences.

The Successor A/S Warranting Officer is expected to join the Facebook Officer Group (or similar resource if and when this evolves) – or select a proxy to attend in their stead – and is expected to attend all online/Zoom meetings quarterly.

The Successor A/S Warranting Officer is expected to respond to all emailed correspondence to the Group's Official Arts and Sciences email box within three business days. Queries do not need to be resolved in that time but must be acknowledged. An auto-responder defining alternate contact is acceptable on extended travel/leave.

The Successor A/S Warranting Officer is responsible for reporting receipt and passing of the Chain of Office.

First Event?

Are you considering going to your first event? We're excited to have you join in on the fun!

Here are some quick things to know about going to your first event:

Fighter Practice:

If you are going to a fighter practice, this is where the guys with pointy sticks practice their craft. However Safety is priority! A designated Marshal will be onsite to make sure everyone is following SCA safety guidelines. Bring plenty of water, and dress for the weather: some groups practice rain or shine!

Kingdom Event:

These events are sometimes overnight or just single day, but they are lots of fun!

Bring a chair, drinks to stay hydrated, snacks, cooler, dress for the weather, and maybe have some cash on hand. There are often fund raiser lunches that cost a small donation. But you may also come across some of our Kingdom Merchants and you'll want to shop!

There are many activities going on, so don't be hesitant to stand by and observe or jump in and ask questions!

“Do I have to Dress Up?”

You certainly don't! But there aren't many other places year round where you can lounge around in comfy tunic and hang with cool people all day. But seriously wear what's comfortable and fun for you! It's doesn't have to be perfect, or 100% historic, we are just glad to have you join us. Having fun is our second priority.

A couple of tips for those that want to wear “Garb” (period style clothing):

Hot Weather: Sew with or Wear fabric that breathes (Cotton, Wool, Linens) Poly blends do not breathe well. In the hottest weather, some of us default to our South Asia, Roman, or Grecian Garb!

“What do all the different Crowns Mean?”

Great question! Many members of our populace wear a circlet or a coronet to signify their station in our Kingdom!

By default everyone (even you!) is considered “m'lord” or m'lady.

A simple circlet indicates that a person has been bestowed an Award of Arms or similar award and now has the title Lord or Lady or even more special as recognition, Honorable Lord or Honorable Lady.

Coronets are bit larger and ornamental! The folks wearing the more elaborate coronets have done great service to the kingdom in the form of running one of our Local Baronies as a Baron or Baroness, or even serving a reign as a previous King or Queen!

The only people wearing what we call crowns are the Trimaris Royalty! This includes:

His Majesty – the King, Her Majesty – the Queen,

His Highness – the Prince, and Her Highness – the Princess.

The Royals of Trimaris love to meet new members, so don't be shy to come up and say hi! (They are easy to spot!)

“Do I have to memorize titles? What do I call everyone?”

You can simply call a person by their name! But it can seem confusing with different titles and names.

If someone tells you their “Mundane” name – that is the name they go by outside of the SCA.

Many of us have SCA names we have picked to go with our “persona” or character we like to portray.

Those with certain accomplishments could have titles! You may hear:

Master/Mistress – These are members of the populace that have achieved a mastery of their craft and have been recognized as a peer.

Baron/Baroness or “Your Excellency” – These members of the kingdom have served as a Baron or Baroness of a Kingdom Barony.

Count/Countess or “Your Excellency” – These members of the kingdom have reigned as King or Queen once.

Duke/Duchess or “Your Grace” – These members of the kingdom have reigned as King or Queen 2 or more times.

EVENT FINANCIAL POLICIES

- All returned checks will be subject to a \$20 fee.
- Anyone who does not pay for their site registration by the time registration closes at an event will be considered to have spent the entire weekend with feast and shall be charged accordingly.
- Anyone who does not pay their event fees, or uses NSF checks to do so, will not be permitted to attend events until all fees are paid in full.

- Name event and the sponsoring group.
- Date of the event.
- Event site location including name and address.
- Time the event site opens and closes to the public.
- Registration open and closing times.
- Name (mundane and SCA) mailing address, e-mail address, and telephone number of the Reservation Steward.
- Name (mundane and SCA), e-mail address, and phone number for the Event Steward
- Names (mundane and SCA), e-mail address, and phone number for the Marshal in Charge and Ranger in Charge
- SCA Corporate Anti-Bullying policy
- Site registration pricing and payment information.
- OPTIONAL: Description of the event activities.

In order to comply with Kingdom Laws and Policies, unless otherwise stated, the following standard event policies will automatically apply to all events submitted and held within the Kingdom of Trimaris.

- No family shall pay more than the equivalent of three (3) adult site fees. Family is defined as adults and their minor children. This applies to site fees only and does not include feast or cabin space.
- Unless otherwise noted, The site fees for children 12 and under are free.
- The SCA member discount for site registration shall not exceed \$10 per person.
