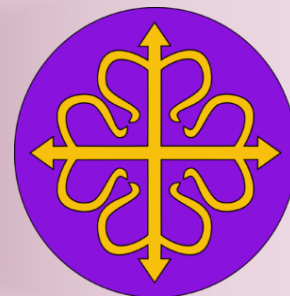

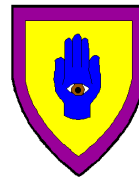

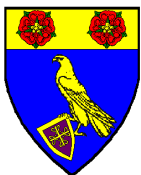

### Calontir!

It's time for May flowers, not, of course, to be confused with the *Mayflower*. In any case, we'll be talking about heraldic flowers in bit.

First, congratulations to Robert Magnus and Magge Magnus, our new Heirs. Exciting, and dare I say, outlandish times portend for our future.

A couple of job notes. First, we have a new Battleur: Brynjolfr Inn Eyverski. He has some major shoes to fill, so give him some time to settle into the role.

As for the other current job opening, Red Hawk Herald, I'm still accepting letters until the 31<sup>st</sup> of May. This is perfect for someone without much experience in book heraldry but wants to get good at it.

Now it's time to breathe in the aroma of some beautiful flowers. Let's start with roses. Yes, you can have roses. In fact, they're on something like a thousand registered devices in the SCA with roses. They can be any color, with different choices in the center (termed as "seeded") and for the barbs ("barbed"). So, for example, a blue rose

with yellow center and barbs would be blazoned "a rose Azure, barbed and seeded Or.

We like lilies in Calontir, of course, and you have a variety of choices with it. You can choose, simply, the "lily," which is just a flower. Notably, if you want, you can put another symbol on this version. Then you can opt for the "lily of the valley," which is a plant with a bunch of lilies on it. Next, there's the "arum lily," which is a trumpet-shaped version (think a lily on a stem). I can actually go on, given some other specific lily types that have already passed in the SCA, but you can already see it's really versatile, especially when you add your choice of color and arrangement.

Then we get to most famous of the heraldic lilies, the fleur-de-lys. You can do just about anything you want with these. Fleur-de-lys proper, fleur-de-lys in color, fleur-de-lys in chief, fleur-de-lys on the main part, fleur-de-lys everywhere (a semy, like what the French often did), fleur-de-lys gumbo, fleur-de-lys creole, fleur-de-lys kabobs—.

Errr, sorry, lost the flowers in the Forrest.

Anyway, you can put just about any other flower you want on your device. I see edelweiss, magnolia, flax, sunflower, columbine, lotus, nadeshiko, borage, dogwood, gillyflower, and jasmine flowers out of the first 25 listings of devices registered with a flower. There's nigh unto three hundred more listings of devices with flowers on them, so who knows how many options there are.

You can even have bouquets! People have already registered bouquets of lilacs, lavender, thistles, poppies, and lilies. Register a device with a bouquet for your loved one. It won't smell as sweet, but will last much longer. And you don't have to water it! (Paint might be involved, however).

Basically, it's flowers here, flowers there, flowers everywhere!

And speaking of which, I hope everyone has a great Lilies.

### **Commentary Request – Governing Documents – Marshallate Content**

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on proposed changes to Governing Documents proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Governing Documents related to the Marshallate. The authorities, roles, responsibilities, and functions of the Marshallate occur in several sections of the Governing documents, and have been added to or updated over the years. However, they do not fully reflect the breadth of current SCA martial activities and the evolution of our administrative and safety practices. These changes will (a) include all SCA martial disciplines, (b) incorporate the current and modern practices that have evolved over the years in our rules and the application thereof, and (c) ensure consistency throughout the several sections, while preserving the kingdom flexibility that enables the uniqueness of our kingdom cultures.



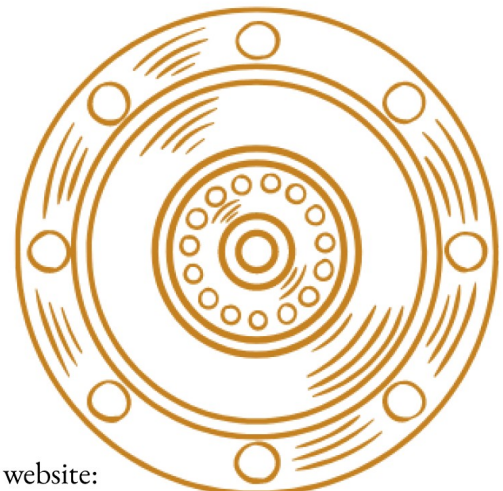

Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. ## Flyers **MUST** contain these **SIX** ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. ( Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member  
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /  
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

**Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.**

**Deadline:** The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1<sup>st</sup> of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** ( e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st. ) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
