At the Curia of Their Royal Majesties Tindal and Emerson, held in the Barony of Concordia of the Snows on 6 April 2024, A.S. 58, at the Coronation of Tindal II and G. Emerson True, the following became East Kingdom Law:

4. Will have the following duties:
 c. Advise and assist the Crown in the organization of the tournaments or competitions to choose their successors, with the exception of the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms as appropriate. The Kingdom Youth Earl Marshal will assist the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms as appropriate, and will supervise, or arrange for the supervision of, the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms tournaments.

5. Will maintain their positions until the next tournament or competition to choose their successors, unless the Crown they are serving finds it necessary to replace them before the end of their term. Champions may not succeed themselves. The Youth Champions of Arms's terms end at the end of the event at which they are named the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms when the Monarchs that selected them step down. A youth may be named as champion multiple times within a reign.

VIII. Events

A. Kingdom Events

1. Coronations, Crown Tournaments, Twelfth Night, Baronial Investitures, and the various Crown's Champions Tournaments, with the exception of the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms, are Kingdom Events. All dates for Kingdom Events to be held are preferred dates; prospective sponsors or hosts are encouraged to submit bids for dates within the listed timeframes if at all possible.

3. Any branch, group, or individual wishing to sponsor or host a Coronation, Crown Tournament, Twelfth Night, or a Crown's Champions Tournament, except for the Crown's Youth Champions of Arms, must submit a bid package via email, to the Crown, the Heirs, the Kingdom Seneschal, the Event Clerk, and the Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer. Baronial Investitures are not required to submit a bid package unless combined with another Kingdom Event per Section VIII.A.4. The Crown's Youth Champions of Arms tournaments are not bid, per Section VIII.A.9.a.iii.

9. Champions Tournaments

a. iii. Tournaments and competitions to determine the The Crown's Youth Champions of Arms will be determined at any East Kingdom event that is a Royal Progress and has a martial tournament for youth, held at each Coronation or Crown Tournament if the Crown requests it. Bids to host the Youth Champions of Arms at a Coronation or Crown Tournament will follow the relevant submission deadlines in VIII.A.5. or VIII.A.6-

From the Board of Directors

There have recently been two sets of requests for commentary that went out from the Board:

First Item:

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on proposed changes to Governing Documents proposed by the Society Marshal. These proposed changes aim to update the Governing Documents related to the Marshallate. The authorities, roles,

responsibilities, and functions of the Marshallate occur in several sections of the Governing documents, and have been added to or updated over the years. However, they do not fully reflect the breadth of current SCA martial activities and the evolution of our administrative and safety practices. These changes will (a) include all SCA martial disciplines, (b) incorporate the current and modern practices that have evolved over the years in our rules and the application thereof, and (c) ensure consistency throughout the several sections, while preserving the kingdom flexibility that enables the uniqueness of our kingdom cultures.

Notes on Edits in the proposed changes:

Functional Change – Refers to how the new wording functionally changes the passage. This may be a simple clarification, or may affect policy or intent.

Reason for Change – Provides background and context which prompted the proposed change. There are also changes are minor grammatical corrections and wording change for consistency in the document. Examples:

Where “martial” should be used instead of “combat” or “marshal”, Update wording to be “Society Marshal” vs “Marshal of the Society”, and “Kingdom Earl Marshal” vs “Earl Marshal of the Kingdom” for consistency.

Second Item:

The Board of Directors is requesting commentary on the changes to the Rules of the List proposed by the Society Marshal.

These proposed changes aim to update the Rules of the List to include all SCA martial disciplines, while preserving their intent. Explanatory information is outlined for each rule with the functional change and the reason for the change provided where appropriate.

The Rules of the List are a critical core of SCA culture, values, and behavior. However, as written, they are mostly limited to Armored Combat and Rapier, and create contradictions for the approved martial activities of Equestrian, Combat Archery, Siege, Thrown Weapons, and Target Archery. The proposed changes also include a reordering of the list, to start with general underlying principles and then proceed to specific applications.

Welcome, friends, to the summer Opening Of the Inne at Coldwood! This season, we return to our prior format, but plan to include some of the new elements played out at last years Danelaw event. We return to our hearty and generous feast, fire, archery and thrown weapons, fencing and equestrian events, along with a Saturday filled with Heavy melee fun. (guaranteed to be NO boring, slow -paced or exclusionary war or champions practices!) There will be classes of various sorts , that will include fiber arts, metal working ,pottery and more. Details to follow. Merchants are welcome, with no merchant fees or sales item restrictions.

The site: The estate of Baron and Baroness Stephen and Ellen is an approximately 10 acre of wooded, rural ,primitive land with portable toilets, running cold water, a long-house/feast hall and several small private buildings. A smithy shop and a Arts/Fiber Arts building are in the planning stages and may be open by the event. There is a decidedly Viking/Early period feel to the site, but all periods and portrayals are welcome. Unlike the fall Danelaw event, there are no restrictions on clothing, fighting kits or camp presentations this time around. We ask that attendees place modern, non-canvas tents away from the perimeters of the main site and the area know as the Western Meadow, to help retain the ancient atmosphere. In an effort to display the talents and leadership abilities of our non-Peerage fighters , a Atlantean Speed tourney, open only to non-peerage fighters, will start off the day ,to select the top 3 to fill the roles of War Band leaders...two opposing teams and a third team of Mercenaries. Teams will be decided by lining up all remaining fighter and counting off 1,2,3 . 1's and 2's are the competing bands, 3's are the Mercs. The three war band leaders figure out the details! The scenarios will consist of a 30-45 min bridge battle with two resurrection points, 5 min rolling res's being called out by a person at each point. No tape marking on helms... war-cries encouraged! The other martial disciplines are encouraged to formulate a similar structure to allow us to total the points to determine a winning team.
