These companion panels are from the front of a chest (cassone) and show two episodes from an unidentified story, or novella. In one, a youth is smitten by a maiden who appears at a window and seems to gesture for him to join her inside. In the other, they engage in an erotically charged game of chess where she is about to lose. Both were common themes in the amatory literature of the Renaissance. The figures' bleached blond, frizzy hair was the height of fashion in fifteenth-century Siena. Liberale was a brilliant illuminator and worked on choirbooks in Siena between 1467 and 1476. /www.metmuseum.org/

Unto all good gentles who read these words, I...Daveed Shmuel ben Rachon desires that this missive find you all in good spirits and healthy hearts as we prepare for the Outland's hosting the world at BATTLEMOOR.

At Battlemoor, I will be running all Page School activities. Attached to this missive is the current vision for the activities. I welcome comments and constructive suggestions. As this is a new format there will be kinks that have to be worked out. In going over the schedule if you have questions, constructive comments, or suggestions, please email me privately.

As all will see from the schedule plan there are rich opportunities for peers and the populace to help support this important and vital program within the Outlands. This can be done through spending a couple of hours visiting and talking

with our pages. If we want to create a sustainable program for youth that will help train our future officers, peers, and royals then we all need to take a few moments to model what it means to live the Dream.

Some housekeeping elements need to be addressed at this time.

The Outlands Page School is planning on providing full-day programming.

- The program is being tailored for youth ages 6 to 15.
- Families with early learners are welcome to come and participate with the Page School, but the Page School will not provide custodial supervision of children under 6.
- That said, if a parent or adult sibling would provide that supervision then they would all be welcome to have fun and fully participate.
- Parents or adult siblings will need to sign the pages in and out. As we are in a remote site, I will be asking all Pages to commit to walking with others and not by themselves or with strangers. Getting older pagers to look out for the younger ones is good from them. It helps give them some ownership of the event for which they are contributing.
- As adult supervision is going to be necessary for this program to work, a parent or adult sibling will need to volunteer one, 3-hour shift for one child. Not daily, just once. For two or more children, a parent or adult sibling will be asked to work two, 3-hour shifts.

In creating the format for this year, I knew that I could be biting off more than I could chew. That's possible, but I want to prove that notion wrong. To do that I need help. If anyone wants to volunteer, please let me know.

One thing that is MANDATORY, a background check. To get a background check, send an email to <u>Outlands Seneschal</u>. Include your mundane name, membership number, and expiration date,

I'm sure that more items will come up. The schedule is flexible. Depending upon any number of things, I plan to keep it flexible and adaptable throughout the event. I am hoping to have a session for all Kingdom groups to share their youth programs and ideas. They are welcome throughout Battlemoor. More details will follow soon.

If there are any questions, constructive comments, and/or suggestions please feel free to to email me and I will be happy to assist.

Please excuse my ego when I say that this program is a passion for me. I desire to leave the Kingdom much richer than when I first came to al-Barran. In other words, this is a multi-year process that will require the participation and ideas of many people. I hope that many will come and spend some time with the Page School.

Grab your bow, pack your camping gear and come join the Shire of Windkeep for a weekend of and about archery, in the beautiful mountains of the Northern Outlands. Never shot archery before? It's fun, easy and we will have teachers and equipment on hand to help you learn. Archery games are planned such as a Wand Shoot, Clout Shoot and many others courtesy of the mind of THL Forester. For the Combat Archers a Meanest Mother Woods Battle is planned. Archery Marshals, we need your help. If you would like to help, or if you have suggestions, please contact the Steward.

This is a primitive site and camping is first come first serve. A map of the camping area will be available at gate. There is limited level ground for RVs. Contact the Event Steward for information. We will have porta-potties (there are a few composting toilets as well). There will be no potable water on site so please remember to bring your own. Please plan to leave the site cleaner than we find it. The only fires allowed on site must have an off switch and fire extinguisher available. Smoking is only allowed in a designated area and the site is damp for use of alcohol. Cannabis is illegal in Wyoming in all forms. Well behaved service animals/pets are welcome. They must be leashed and under your immediate control at all times. (There are deer and other animals on site) Please make sure they have food, water, and shade. Please pick up after your animal and dispose of their fertilizer. If your animal is afraid of crowds or strangers it might be kinder to leave them at home.

DIRECTIONS: From the South: Find your best route to I25 north. Drive to Wyoming. Exit 8B onto I80 West toward Laramie. Drive approximately 24 miles. **Exit 335 North Buford Road (where the Buford gas station is). Take a right at the exit and then an immediate other right. Next, take a left to stay on North Buford Road (This is a winding unpaved road). Proceed on North Buford Road approximately 4.5 miles to site. Entrance is on the left.



This job is part Kingdom Administrator and Human Resources. This involves directing the activities of the Branch Seneschals and deputies. Where questions arise concerning the intent of Kingdom Law the Kingdom Seneschal is responsible for interpretations and clarifications. The Kingdom Seneschal is also responsible for reviewing all sanction related activities.

This is a part-time position requiring a minimum of 15 hours per week, often more.

Applicants must possess strong communication skills and be capable of interacting with unique SCA personalities without regard to rank or position in the organization. The ability to process and distill large amounts of information from multiple sources is required. Organizational and problem-solving skills are essential. Having held a Branch Seneschal position, while not required, is preferred. Applicants must be capable of maintaining a home office space, have access to the internet, PC/tablet, printer, and possess word processing skills.
