Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide. html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

IMAGES, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

EVENT PREVIEWS: A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

EVENT NOTICES (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: crown and coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of kingdom or principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event. The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Any issues contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at calendar@midrealm.org. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at **http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale**/. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, NAME (SCA & modern), email address and phone number of the event steward. Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image. Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.



Award Anniversaries - The Award of the Purple Fretty and the Award of the Grove

Happy 50th Anniversary to the Award of the Purple Fretty!

December 15, 2023 was the 50th anniversary of the Award of the Purple Fretty!

This award was first given on this day in 1973 by Their Majesties Merowald and Gwendolyn to the Barony of the Flame. If you are aware of the specific reason for this first award, please let me know by sending the info to history@midrealm.org. I'd love to document it.


The Purple Fretty is given to a group for excellent service to the Kingdom. In its fifty-year history this award has been given 241 times, most recently to the Cleftlands Needleworkers and Friends for creating Pennsic 50 garb for Their then-Highnesses Wigthegn and Neassa. That same group has been honored four times with the award since 1986, which is likely the most of any group in the Kingdom.



One of the more interesting notes I've come across is regarding House Shadowclans. This household was awarded the Purple Fretty on August 17, 2000, "along with a license to crenellate."

The device for the award is Or, fretty purpure. As with all of the group awards, it is encouraged for the group to display the award in some way, whether on a banner or some other manner where the group is indicated.

Congratulations and thank you to all of the groups who have achieved this award!



Happy 30th Anniversary to the Award of the Grove!

December 11, 2023 was the 30th anniversary of the Award of the Grove!

This award is given to a group for excellence in the arts and sciences for the benefit of the Kingdom. The first recipient of the Award of the Grove was the Jaravellir Music Guild on December 11, 1993, given by Their Majesties Jafar and Catherine, 48th king and queen of the MidRealm. The Jaravellir Music Guild had previously been awarded the Award of the Purple Fretty some years earlier in 1987.

In its history, the award has been given 64 times, most recently in 2022 to Flamma Chorum.

The device for the award was registered five months after it was first given, in April 1994: Per pale Or and argent, a hurst purpure. As a group award, it should be displayed by the group. Displays such as banners are perfect for showing a group's award history, but other displays indicating the group are also encouraged.

Happy 30th birthday to the Award of the Grove and congratulations to all of the groups recognized by this award over the last 30 years!

South Oaken Regional Chronicler (Deputy of the Chronicler)

As a regional chronicler, your job is to assist the Kingdom Chronicler with helping the many groups in your region.

- Maintain the list of current warranted chroniclers in your region
- Oversee local chroniclers' filing of a quarterly report and quarterly newsletter publication (when applicable, required for Baronies)
- File the regional chronicler report
- Help answer any questions that may arise from the local chroniclers in your region

Minister of Regalia (Deputy of the Exchequer)

The Minister of Regalia is responsible for the inventory, storage, and transportation of all Kingdom Regalia. They must have the ability to provide a climate-controlled, insured storage space as well as the means to transport various pieces of regalia to Coronations and Crown Tournaments.

The Regalia Minister will maintain the records of the items in the Regalia Inventory and administer the distribution and collection of the items to the Crown and its Heirs.

REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY – CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

Middle Kingdom Anniversaries

Happy 45th Anniversary to the Barony of Carraig Ban!

January 6, 2024 marked the 45th anniversary of Carraig Ban's elevation to a Barony of the Middle Kingdom in 1979. 2024 is also the 50th anniversary of the group becoming a shire in 1974. Located in northwestern Illinois, it is the oldest barony in the Midlands region.

It is the 6th barony of the Kingdom, being elevated to the status of barony just 7 months after Cleftlands and 10 months before Flaming Gryphon.

The first Baron and Baroness of Carraig Ban were Rory O'Tomrair and Winifred Yseulte of Hall's Isle whose tenure spanned 24 years. Baron Rory was the fifth Middle Kingdom seneschal and was elevated to the Order of the Pelican in 1980. Baroness Winifred was elevated to the Order of the Pelican in 1986. They stepped down in 2003 and were succeeded by Aleid van Groningen and Sean Morgan Aldheorte na Kitts Rill. When they stepped down in 2009 Faustino de Baez and Katherine Von Trier were entrusted with the coronets. The fourth Baron and Baroness were Mustafa Al-Hassan Abdualaziz and Epona Brodin. Baroness Epona is the owner of the Greatest Tavern in the Known World, the One Paw Tiger Inn. She was elevated to the Order of the Pelican in 2017. Honda Heihachiro and Samson Muskovich (the nomad of the Midlands) became the fifth holders of the baronial coronets in 2018. Currently, the barony is resolutely led by the barons Akiyama Kazuhiko (Japanese Heian era persona) and Akiyama Hiroaki (Japanese Muromachi era persona).


