King Jochen!*

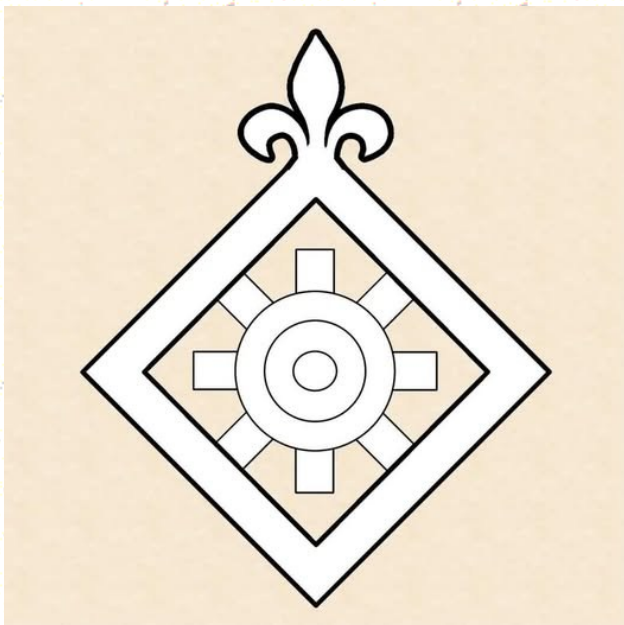

# From Kingdom Chirurgeon

Greetings Good Gentles,

I write to you all today with a brief reminder regarding situations wherein a member of the populace requires first aid, particularly at fighter practices. I have had several reports lately of enthusiastic attempts to help when people have been injured or have become unwell. It is lovely to see that people care so greatly for members of their community. Unfortunately, these attempts can sometimes lead to more work for the first responder as they have to do crowd management as well as trying to help the unwell party. I would therefore encourage you all, should you see someone who is unwell or injured and who is not already being attended to, to go help and get the process moving! If they already have someone helping, please go up and actively ask the first aid

provider if they need help. Then, if they say no, please help them by giving them some space to do their job. If you note that there are several people who are not actively helping but are standing around, it can be helpful to help the crowd disperse to give the patient their privacy and the chirurgeon space to think.

The people of Lochac care, and they want to help each other. Let's keep it up.

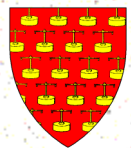

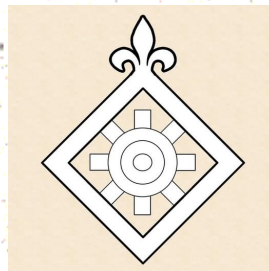

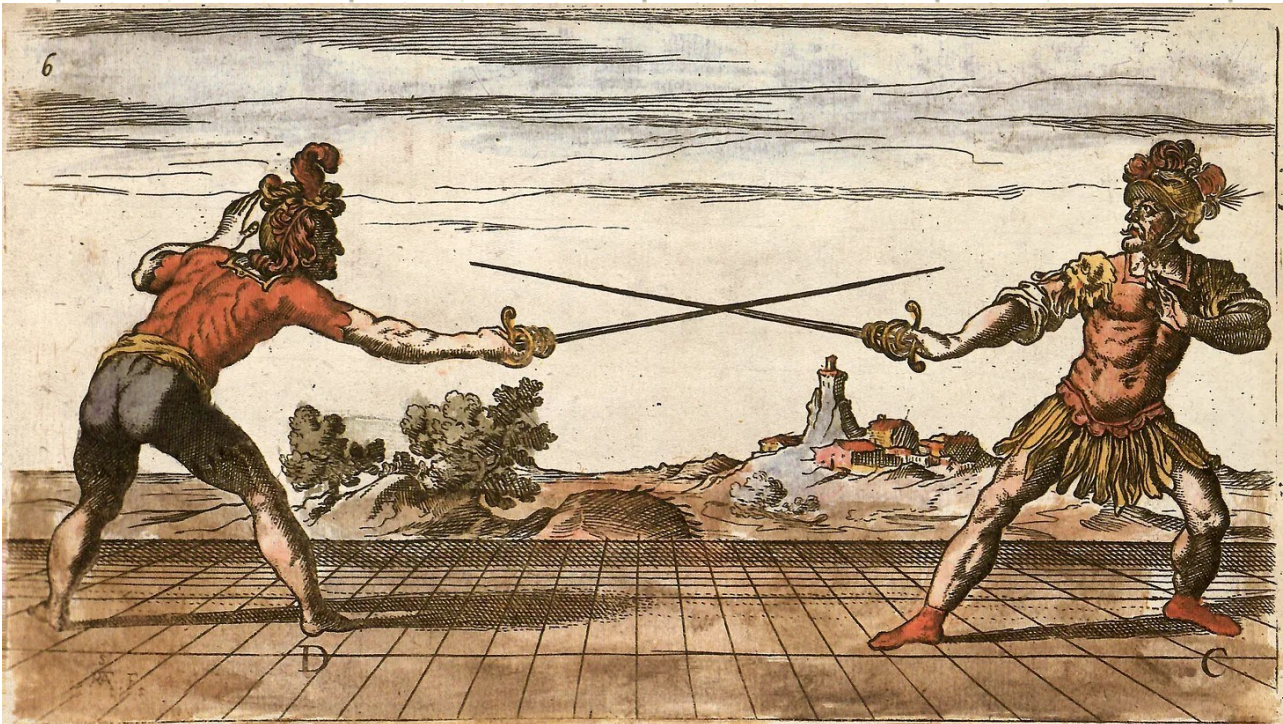
