

Greetings Calontir!

This month, I wanted to speak to you on a more serious topic - dead names. That is, a name that was once given or registered to a person that they no longer use. The term "dead name" is most commonly used in the context of deadnaming, or the act of using someone's dead name - especially when they have transitioned or changed their name to better reflect their gender identity - in a malicious manner.

Using a person's dead name is disrespectful to that person's identity.

In the SCA College of Arms we allow for individuals to register up to 10 names. You can specify that those names be gendered, gender neutral, or that you don't care what gender the name conforms to.

The first name you register is considered your "primary" name, but you can swap that out at any time. Having alternate names allows you to explore the time and place of a culture without being locked into a single identity or name.

You might change your name for a variety of reasons. Perhaps you are changing your persona, or you have simply found a name you like better. In that case, it might be practical to keep your previous name in the Order of Precedence (OP), so people can still find you by that name. If, however, your intention is to change your name and leave behind a persona, or a person, that's not the real you, then you might want to also remove that previous name from the OP. In that case, we got you, boo.

In the interest of fostering a welcoming and inclusive space for people regardless of gender, sexuality, or identity and in the spirit of mutual respect, the Calontir College of Heralds would like to correct the Order of Precedence (www.calontir. org/op) for any populace member who might be affected.

If you desire the removal of any name listed for you in the Order of Precedence, please contact me at goldfalcon@calontir.org so that we can take the appropriate steps to release and remove those names.

There are also several kingdom deputy and local group webminister positions available - so if you are interested in joining the team, even if not as the kingdom webminister, please send me an email. Sincerely,





Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: https://www.calontir.org/events/

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example*: If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews. If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- 1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- 2. Day, month, and year of the event
- 3. Site open & close times for populace
- 4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
- 6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 Youth (6-17) \$5 Children 5 & Under: FREE
