THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

Court Reports

Arts & Sciences Faire and Queen's Prize Tourney 20 April, Anno Societatis LVIII

Documented from the Rolls and Files of the Coram Regibus of Murdoch I Rex and Ríoghnách I Regina, King and Queen of Æthelmearc: Being a True Record of the Business of Their Royal Court at the Arts & Sciences Faire and Queen's Prize Tourney, 20 April, Anno Societatis LVIII, in the Canton of Dunloch. As recorded by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Brehyres, Meistr-y-gân, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, with the assistance of Lady Umbriana Campana, deputy signet.

Their Majesties praised the day's activities and thanked all who attended, especially the artisans who displayed and were part of the Faire.

Their Majesties then invited the (single) youth member in attendance to come forward and select a toy from the toybox.

Next, Their Majesties greeted a newcomer and invited them to select a drinking vessel.

Their Majesties gave leave to Their Excellencies Delftwood, Thorbjorn and Oðindisa, to conduct Baronial Court.

Upon the conclusion of Baronial Court, Their Majesties released Mistress Gytha Oggsdottir from her service to the kingdom as our Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion deputy. In recognition of their skills in multiple martial activities, and in particular their service as a fencing marshall-intraining, Their Majesties were minded to name them a Companion of the Golden Alce. Scroll by Lady Umbriana Campana upon words by Master Cyrus Augur.

Their Majesties then requested the presence of Don Michael Gladwyne. They complimented his display and research, but explained that it was not for arts, but for his longstanding service, that he was to be recognized. Having heard as much from Their Noble Order of the Millrind, They called for that Order to join them, and inducted him as a Companion of that number. Scroll illumination by Lady Vedis Aradottir, calligraphy by adelante urraca beatriz botelho, and words by Baroness Sadira bint Wassouf.

Their Majesties next wished to be attended by The Honorable Lady Svana in Kyrra. His Majesty spoke with Her Ladyship of the artistic process, and in particular, as had been referenced several times that day, the "rabbit holes" into which artists may disappear as they delve deeper into their research, and the lengths to which they go to bring their work to the next level. Their Majesties further said that They had seen and heard of Her Ladyship's efforts in this regard, over many years, and the example Her Ladyship sets in embroidery as well as late-period clothing. They also revealed that others had spoken loudly and insistently of Her Ladyship's merit. Therefore, They invited forward the Most Noble Order of the Laurel, and directed Her Ladyship by means of Writ to choose a date on which to contemplate elevation into that assembly. Scroll by The Honorable Lady Gesa von Wellenstein upon words by "some guy in a hat" (Master Po Silvertop).

At this time, Her Majesty named The Honorable Lord Weasel as Queen's Inspiration for the day, for his tenacity in pursuit of his goals and the inclusivity with which he shared his learning.

Their Majesties thanked all the scribes and wordsmiths who contributed to the scrolls bestowed during the day's Court.

GREETINGS, GENTLEBEINGS! Are you ready to step to the line, check your aim, and fill the autumn air downrange with arrows and bolts, axes and knives? Please join us for the Barony of Delftwood's traditional fall archery and thrown weapons event, with a new name: Line of Fire!

Saturday September 14th, 2024, Delftwood Barony will be hosting our annual fall archery and thrown weapons event at the North Sportmans Club of West Monroe, NY, located at 1708 County Route 37 N, West Monroe, NY.

The site will open at 8:00am, and close for cleanup at 7:00pm. Lunch items will be for sale by the North Sportsmans Club.

The day will be filled with archery and thrown weapons activities including several novelty shoots/throws for youth and adults alike, a cross-martial activity endurance test open to all who wish to try, and the Baronial Archery Champion and Baronial Thrown Weapons Champion tourneys.

Directions:

From the West, South and East: Take your best route to I-86. Take Exit 10 (Westfield/Mayville) to get to Route 430 West. (From the West it is marked only as Route 430 West. Do not take exit 9 to Bemus Point). Follow the signs for Route 430 West towards Westfield and Mayville. From the exit, it will be several miles to the site (3 or 4 miles depending on where you start counting). You will pass Long Point Park and Midway Park before seeing the Lutheran Camp on your left at the top of a long hill next to a huge tree.

From the North: Take your best Route to I-90. Exit at the Westfield exit and take Route 394 to Mayville. Pick up Route 430 East and follow to the site. The site will be on your right.

Indoor space is available in the Main Hall for socializing, projects, games, and more as well as the A&S Display and Silent Auction. More information will appear on the Facebook page as we firm up details. Arts and Sciences Display – All attendees are encouraged to bring items, in progress or complete, to display in the Arts & Sciences Display. Documentation is encouraged but not required.
