THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing -Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

Court Report Ice Dragon April 6th, AS 58 TRMs Gareth + Juliana

Their Majesties called for the Order of the Pelican and bade them to take these three gentles forth and give them their counsel.

Court Suspended.

In the Evening with the assistance of Magdalena Txoperena de Guerra, Eby Jousie, and Angelino the Bookmaker, featuring Amalie Reihardt and Ixac ben Simone as Ætherial Heralds.

Their Majesties invited Their Majesties of the Middle to join Them, and presented Them with gift baskets to welcome Them to Æthelmearc.

Their Majesties spotted a spry young thing in the audience and called him forth. Maestro Filippo de Sancto Martino was handed the Kingdom Toychest and sent on his way pursued by the

youth of the Kingdom.

Their Majesties invited all newcomers to join Them. They presented them all with mugs from the artisans of the Kingdom in welcome.

Their Majesties gave leave to Their Excellencies of the Rhydderich Hael to conduct Their Baronial Court.

After hearing these words, Their Majesties called for the Order of the Pelican and confirmed it was still the Order's wish to have Dubheasa counted as one of them. Their Maiesties invested Dubheasa with the Ancestral Pelican Medallion of Æthelmearc, a personal medallion, and a cloak. Their Majesties called for Mary of Blackthorn. Mary has been noted to be helpful around her Barony, she supports the fighters and always pitches in when needed. for this Their Majesties Awarded her Arms. Scroll illuminated by Robaird Michael Patrick Timothy James O'Suilleabhainn with calligraphy by Cassia Carataca.

Their Majesties summoned Aegis of Thescorre. He was a youth fighter, and has continued to pursue the combat arts and increase his skill now that he has joined the adults. For this Their Majesties Awarded him Arms. Scroll by Lisabetta de Rossi with words by Nuzha bint Saleem.

Their Majesties Awarded Arms in abstentia to Daniel of the Rhydderich Hael for his enthusiastic participation in so many parts of the Society, archery, thrown weapons, brewing, helping in kitchens, and helping out around events. Scroll by Caleb Reynolds.

Their Majesties called for Terry of the Rhydderich Hael. He has also jumped in to many parts of the Society archery, thrown weapons, brewing, helping in kitchens, and helping out around events. For this Their Majesties were pleased to Award him Arms. Scroll by Caleb Reynolds.

Their Majesties called for Lady Asteriya Royachevicha. She has long served as an officer in the Dominion of Myrkfaelinn, and has served as a combat scribe. For this Their Majesties named her a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll by Amalie Reinhardt.

Their Majesties called for Lord Eamonn na Laimhe. He has given great service in the kitchens and as event set up and tear down crew. For this Their Majesties named him a Companion of the Keystone. Scroll by Christina Mary Lowe with words by Chahagan Duras.

Their Majesties called for Baron Ixac ben Simone. He has completed many scroll blanks for the Kingdom and his Barony, and has taught classes on the bardic arts. For the Their Majesties named him a Companion of the Sycamore. Scroll by Kolfinna Jodisdottir with words by Po Silvertop.

Their Majesties summoned THLord Abdullah al- Rashid. They confirmed that he had received counsel and still wished to continue. They heard words in support of his elevation from Duke Cellach mac Cormaic as a Royal Peer, Sör Ustad Hasan al Hajjii as a member of the Chivalry, Maisterin Elisabeth Johanna von Flossenburg as a member of the Order of the Laurel, Duchess Líadain ní Dheirdre Chaomhánaigh as a Jewel of Æthelmearc, and Baron Magnus de Lyons as a member of the Order of the Laurel. Their Majesties called for the Order of the Pelican and confirmed that it was still their wish that Abdullah be counted among them. Abdullah was invested with a Sür Kaftan, the Ancestral Pelican Medallion of Æthelmearc, a household medallion, a personal medallion, and a Turban of Maintenance. Their Majesties heard his Oath and named him Ustät Abdullah, Companion of the Pelican. Scroll by Isibel inghean Uilliam mhic Leoid.

Their Majesties allowed jorundr hinn rotinn, Silver Buccle Herald, to perform some heraldic business. It is the purview of a Principal Herald to seek out and recognize those whose service and impact to the heraldic community is particularly important. There was one present who has worked diligently behind the scenes to allow three Silver Buckles to seamlessly perform their own duties, all while continuing to perform commentary on new submissions. Thus jorundr called for Dame Edith of Winterton and named her Herald Extraordinary, and bestowed upon her the right to register a personal heraldic title. Their Majesties called for Meisterin Amalie Reihardt. Amalie has given up many events to toil away performing last minute scroll surgery, or creating new scrolls at the last minute many times. Their Majesties wished to thank her for this by awarding her an Iron Quill. Scroll by Kolfinna Jodisdottir with words by Po Silvertop.

Their Majesties called for Baroness Katherine Kersey. Katherine gives other time at many events to ensure scrolls are ready for Court, so Their Majesties awarded her an Iron Quill. Scroll by Ixac ben Simone.

Their Majesties called for Dame Zofia Kowalewska. Zofia does all the things, and despite being made a Member of the Order of the Pelican continues doing all the things and leading in her Barony and Kingdom. Thus Their Majesties named her a Baroness of Their Court. Scroll in progress, promissory by Amalie

Reinhart with wors by jorundr hinn rotinn.

Their Majesties called for Baron Friderich Swartzwalder. They confirmed that after receiving counsel he still wished to continue. They heard words supporting his elevation from Master Wulfgar Von-Ostrand and Sir Beatrix Krieger as members of the Order of the Chivalry, Maisterin Elisabeth Johanna von Flossenburg as a member of the Order of the Laurel, Duke Thomas Byron of Haverford as a Royal Peer, Duke Timothy of Arindale as a Jewel of Æthelmearc, THLady Margery Kent of York as a member of the populace, and Dame Sara of the Evrie Sea and Mistress Zoe Akropolitina as members of the Order of the Pelican. They called for the Order of the Pelican and confirmed that it was still heir wish to have Friderich join their ranks. Friderich was presented with sprinkles, and was then invested with the Ancestral Pelican Medallion of Æthelmearc, a personal medallion, a belt, a shaub, and a telleberret to mark his new station. Their Majesties took his oath and named him Meister Friderich Scroll by Murdoch Bayne.

Their Majesties called for any who had completed the pilgrimage to come forth and receive their pilgrimage token.

Their Majesties feel that this leadership and good service should be recognized by making him a Baron of Their Court. St. Swithin's Bog Three Day Event: 1066 The Year of the Conquest

July 12th-14th, 2024 Hosted by the Barony of St. Swithin's Bog

It is January 6, 1066. Edward the Confessor, The King of England since 1042, has just died. AND HE HAS NO HEIR. Duke William of Normandy has sworn that Edward promised the crown to him, as Edward had spent most of his childhood in Normandy in exile from Cnut, the Viking king who defeated his father and married his mother. However, in Edward's last moments, he gave his blessing to the Witan (English councilmen to the king, literally "wise men") to select Harold Godwinson, Earl of Wessex, as the new King of England.

Meanwhile, Tostig Godwinson, deposed Earl of Northumbria and brother of Harold, has sworn revenge on his brother for being the one who deposed him for levying high taxes on his people. Tostig traveled to Norway and struck an alliance with King Harald Hardrada, whom he convinced to invade England to once again rule as a Viking king and restore Tostig as the Earl of Northumbria.

This would set in motion events that would change our world forever. England would have a new society unlike which it has never seen before. The Viking Era in England, which began in 793 C.E. at a raid of the Lindisfarne Abbey, would come to an abrupt and bloody end. Englishmen who were once considered freemen would find themselves subjugated to their new Norman overlords. The language you are currently reading would not look the way that it does if 1066 ended differently.

At this year's St. Swithin's Bog Three Day Event, we will celebrate this monumental year with Heavy Weapons, Rapier, Youth Fighting, Thrown Weapons and Archery, many of which will have a Saxon/Viking/ Norman flavor! The heavy weapon fighting will use the three major battles in that year (The Battle of Fulford, the Battle of Stamford Bridge, and the Battle of Hastings) as inspiration for the scenarios. The Battle of Stamford Bridge (famous for the lone Viking who defended a bridge against dozens of Saxons) will be our feature tournament, where the bravest of warriors will have their chance to see how long they can last on the bridge against the other fighters! Fighters are encouraged but not required to use Conquestera weapons and armor. The archery field will include special targets with a Norman and Saxon theme.

The feast will be made with mostly period materials, but will be sure not to disappoint our modern palettes! The hall will be adorned with images of The Bayeux Tapestry, a Norman work of art that depicts the invasion and defeat of Harold from William's perspective. Historical poster boards will be displayed in the hall as well, to provide basic information on what life was like in England in 1066. The theme for the Iron Scribe will follow the event theme, so better brush up on your early medieval history! Brewers will be encouraged to brew typical libations of the era, including mead and ale.
