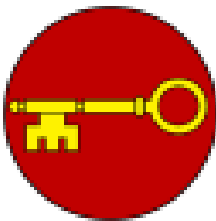

I often get questions

about what exactly I do as Kingdom Seneschal, so I thought I would write about it. The short answer: nothing glitzy.

Technically, the Kingdom Seneschal is the Regional Vice-President for the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. for our geographic area, and is entrusted with the power to sign contracts on behalf of the SCA for things under our purview (i.e., the legal representative for the kingdom). It falls to me and my deputies to take care of the business side of our game. I work with the local branch seneschals to make sure all of our 'i's are dotted and 't's are crossed. I make sure everyone has access to our insurance information and availability, and that we maintain a warrant roster for most of the kingdom's officers, which extends the Society's

indemnity over their actions to legally protect them. I aid the Crown in following Society policy in the form of Corpora and handbooks, as well as our own laws and policies.

Law changes are run by my office, as is the kingdom calendar, marshallate rolls, and minister of the lists, each of which is run by its own capable deputy. I also oversee several offices that have no Society counterpart, including the Social Media Office, the Waiver Secretary, the DEI office, and the Youth Minister. I shepherd new groups through the process of becoming official, and consider among my proudest accomplishments that we have two new groups in our kingdom.

Beyond that, I've picked several projects for the kingdom that I simply wanted to see done: a revamped and easily-modifiable kingdom website, online marshallate rolls, roster warrants, online reporting system, updated zip code maps, youth combat, online event registration and tracking, easier access to kingdom newsletter, and a kingdom-run camping event. I've stressed the use of online storage and tools far beyond simple email for kingdom officers to enhance our ability to work together. I just love doing stuff like that.

It may not be a very glamorous job, but the payoff is seeing all the fun, enriching activities we can have as a kingdom when all the mundane stuff is sorted out and running smoothly.

Random Carp that I have Learned...



A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

All over town, CBD oil is sold to help with a variety of ailments, such as anxiety, joint pain, etc. It was "discovered" in 1940, but the origins point a bit earlier than that. In Exodus 30:23, "...the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: Take for yourself choice spices: 500 shekels of pure myrrh, half as much of fragrant cinnamon, 250 shekels of kaneh-bosm, 500 shekels of cassia— and mix these with olive oil." All of these are easily identifiable... except for kaneh-bosm. This predecessor to the word *cannabis* was not mentioned much in the good book, but other references suggest anointing someone with oils was a way to treat disease. High Priests were anointed with oil, and the literal translation of the Hebrew word "messiah" is "anointed," referring to a ritual of consecrating someone or something by putting oil on it.

Use of cannabis can be documented back to references in Sanskrit, with residues found in Judaeen ruins from the 8th century BCE. Chinese use in the 3rd century involved incense burners and inhaling the smoke. REQUEST FOR COMMENTARY – CHATELAINE AND DEIB OFFICES

The Board of Directors is currently considering changes to Corpora. It invites commentary from the membership and participants.

These changes aim to enhance recruitment and member retention in the SCA. They also aim to further support these goals. They elevate the Society Chatelaine to a greater Society Officer. They align local and regional chatelaines to this same structure. It is a strategic move. It aims to support the implementation of comprehensive recruitment and retention strategies. It also aims to align the office to a clear vision.

The Board also approved proposed wording. It supports the creation of a Society Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (DEIB) Officer. They also approved aligning local and regional DEIB officers into one structure. Like the proposed Chatelaine changes, it aims to support an aligned Society vision. It also aims to support the implementation of strategy in this space.

Finally, the Board approved changing the name and scope of the Corporate Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging Office. It is now the Office of Inclusive Programs. This office will handle the implementation of large scale, heavy-lift projects. This work will move inclusivity in the SCA forward. It will also transition leadership and management of game-facing DEIB work to the newly created Society DEIB Officer. This office will support all corporate and society officers. It will also serve as a primary DEIB advisor to the Board.

Note: Changes to corporate offices don't require changes in Corpora or public commentary. Understanding the changes to the Corporate DEIB Office will add context for the proposed changes to Corpora. It will also provide clarity for the realignment of responsibilities among these offices.

This restructuring aligns with better practice for organizations that aim to improve recruiting and retention by creating welcoming and inclusive environments.

Proposed Law Changes—Spring 2024



Their Majesties Tearlach and Ursa of Artemisia advance the following changes to Kingdom Law.

Change 1: Succession of the Crown

Subsections H and I of Section XII, dealing with the succession of the Crown in the event that either the Sovereign or Consort is unable to continue (and allowing the remaining member to choose a new partner on the throne), is to be stricken and replaced with the following:

“In the event that either the Sovereign or Consort is unable to complete the reign, the Kingdom Seneschal shall request a variance from the Society Seneschal and the Board of Directors to allow the remaining Sovereign/ Consort to reign alone.”

Change 2: Gryphon of Artemisia to be Given by the Crown

Appendix A, Section B, Subsection a, to be changed to emphasize that the Gryphon of Artemisia award is given by the Crown of Artemisia, instead of solely by the Sovereign, to read:

“Gryphon of Artemisia – extraordinary service, given once per reign **by the Crown**”

Change 3: Kingdom Law to be worded in a gender-neutral manner

The Crown and Heirs direct the Kingdom Seneschal, with the aid of the Kingdom Law Clerk and Kingdom DEI Officer, to develop gender-neutral wording for all sections and appendices contained in Lex Artemisia.

Change 4: Sumptuary Customs for Mantles, Capelets, and Golden Spurs to be Stricken

Although Appendix B -The Sumptuary Customs of the Kingdom of Artemisia - are specifically excluded from statute law, it is announced here that Section D concerning mantles, Section E concerning capelets, and F concerning gold spurs, are to be removed from the list of Sumptuary Customs.

These changes will be posted in the Sage Advice, to be followed by a 30-day commentary period.
