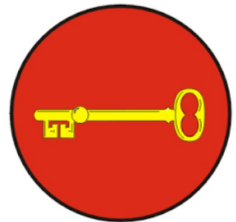
From the Kingdom Seneschal

Academia Draconis is a multi-day camping event designed to provide practical training on the battlefield and
