Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Words of the Crown



Greetings Drachenwald!

Even though it feels like We have just stepped up and taken Our place on the Black Dragon Thrones, it is time to talk about the Crown Tournament!

We want to encourage those that have considered entering the Crown List to send in your letters

of intent sooner rather than later, more information can be found here: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/offices/seneschal/participate-in-crown-tourney/>

The format will be as follows: A round robin best out of three. The four with the most points will face each other in the semi-finals, which will also be fought as best out of three. The points will not carry over but will be restarted during the semi-finals. The two fighters with the most number of victories (not bouts but victories) from the semi-finals will face each other in the finals, to be fought as best out of five. If a fighter runs into the edge of the list field causing a hold three times, they will be considered to have fled the field and thus it will count as a loss. Pushing an opponent into the edge of the list cannot be used as a means to gain a victory in a bout. Double kills will be considered a loss for both parties and will only be re-fought if needed to determine a victor.

We would have it known that We intend to hold a Curia online in March and again at Spring Crown, to address changes in Corpora, some old business and some new. The two formats are to make sure that as many as possible are able to make their voices heard. Review proposed Drachenwald law changes

Old Business:

1. Proposal for moving responsibility regarding baronies within a principality from Crown to Coronet

Reasoning

The burdens of the Crown are many. This proposal moves the responsibilities for those baronies that are within a Principality, from the Crown to the Coronet, as the Coronet is already responsible for their regions.

2. Proposal for clarification of fealty presented by principalities

Reasoning

This proposal aligns the kingdom law with current practices and the wording is consistent with the proposed change under old business. This proposal affects section 6.01.4

3. Proposal for changes in categories of the kingdom officers

Reasoning

This proposal is due to changes in Corpora where the Kingdom Chatelaine has been moved from the category of Lesser Officers to Great Officers. Additionally, the proposal removes the hierarchical wording that ranks the Great Officers in order of precedence. This proposal affects sections 5.01, 5.02, and 5.06.9.

4. Proposal for clarification of the responsibility to get awards registered in the Order of Precedence database

Reasoning

The purpose of this proposal is to minimize frustration over missing awards in the online Order of Precedence, and to avoid wasting the time and resources of scribes and royals that unknowingly plan to give out awards that a recipient has already received. This proposal affects sections 2.02.6 and 5.06.2.3, and adds new sections 5.06.2.6, 6.01.5, and 6.05.6.1.

Questions submitted in writing in advance of the Curia will be answered first followed by general discussion.
