

Earl Marshal Policy 002-2024

Kingdom Caid Gender Neutral Titles and manner of address.

Introduction:

I was approached by Rosie Black Rune, Caid Kingdom DEIB Officer about updating our process so that individuals could indicate their preferred pronouns on the tournament field. After consultation with THN Rosie, THN Hemneter Pennefer, Increscent Herald, Alesone Gray (Panda), KRM, and Baroness Tezar, Lists Officer, we have come up with the following policy.

Policy:

All individuals may be addressed as "Good Gentle" when their title is unknown. This allows the use and recognition of their Honorary Title when such is known. Example: "Thank you, Good Gentle", "may I assist you, Good Gentle", etc.

When an individual signs up for lists they may write one of the following as their title (Shorthand).

Please note it is also helpful if they would add this to their Fighter Authorization Card and perhaps their Membership Card.

This will be used for the List officer to write the Honorary Title on the combatants' fighter card.

AoA level:

Good Noble - GN Lady - La Lord - Lo

Grant level (GoA)

The Honorable Noble - THN The Honorable Lady - THLa The Honorable Lord - THLo

Peerage level:

Knight - Sir Master of Defense - MoD Or as they wish to be addressed (Count, Graf, Duke, Master, Excellency, etc).

If the individual does not specify then Good Gentle will be used.

Sample Tournament Script

Herald

"In this round, [title] Name on Card will face [title] Name on Card."

"Good Gentles (or fighters/combatants):

"Please salute the Crown of Caid." (pause)

"Please salute the one who's favor you bear." (pause)

The generic term of Good Gentle should be used for all combatants. The Marshal may also use the Honorary Title as the Herald announced it.

Please note that both are acceptable and no insult is intended if the Marshal simply uses Good Gentle.

Caid Heraldry

Greetings, heraldry lovers! The following are the newly accepted names and armoury for Caid, in Laurel's Letter of Acceptances and Returns for May 2024. As ever, we refrain from embarrassing anyone with the returns, we will work on them quietly and present them when they are Practically Perfect In Every Way [and accepted].

- Ansteys Darcy. Badge. Sable estencely, an orle Or.

 This badge does not presume upon the arms of Cornwall, Sable bezanty. As estencely is a period motif, and does not appear to have ever been used interchangeably with strewn roundels, we overturn the March 2017 precedent; there is at least a DC between estencely and semy of roundels. This, combined with the addition of the orle, is enough to remove presumption.

 "Estancely" is a field of "sparks," groupings of three small bezants, golden circles. No, we do not call it "sparky."
- ♦ Aracibo Salgado. Name change from Silenus of Mycenae. First name is Taino, last name is Spanish, which happened throughout the Caribbean well before 1600.
- Effie Fairyhall. Device. Gules, a moth and a chief doubly-enarched argent.
- Eleonora di Gerardo. Household name Company of the Golden Fox and badge. (Fieldless) A chevron inverted couped purpure and overall a fox's mask Or.
- ♦ Embla Drífudóttir. Name.
 - Laurel commentary of interest. TL:DR: expanding acceptance of names from Old Norse literary sources. 'In 2018, we stated that "Embla is a wholly legendary figure from Norse mythology; specifically, it is the name of the first woman created by the gods in one of the Norse creation myths. Unlike several other names from Norse legend, such as Dagný, which were used as the personal names of ordinary people later in period, there is no evidence that Embla as a name was used as anything but part of a creation myth. By long-standing precedent, names of purely legendary figures are not registerable." [Embla Hánefsdóttir, 02/2018 LoAR, R-Atlantia] Since then, we have expanded our recognition of naming patterns to register literary names in cultures that had a practice of given names based on literary figures, even if the specific name is not documented outside of literature. Old Norse is one of the languages in which this pattern of literary names exists. The legendary Embla was the first woman, according to myth, but did not herself have any supernatural abilities. We are therefore explicitly overturning this precedent, and allowing this given name to be registered.'
- ♦ Hemneter Pennefer. Release of Alternate name Godfrey Spelman of Hexham. Release of Alternate name Meredithe Spelman of Canterbury. Release of Badge. (Fieldless) A goat clymant contourny sable maintaining a chalice argent. Release of Badge. Argent, a patriarchal cross sable and in chief two mullets of eight points gules. Release of Badge. Per chevron gules and Or, two bees and a rose proper.
 - [May we just say, releasing names and armory that you are not using is a good idea, and a kindness to future clients who might want to use something like them.]
- Hoshina Yoshirou. Device. Quarterly vert and sable, on a martlet rising wings displayed argent within an annulet quarterly argent and Or a compass star gules. Badge. (Fieldless) A martlet displayed within and conjoined to an annulet sable.
- ♦ Isobel Kilburn. Name and device. Per fess rayonny gules and sable, in fess two palm trees couped argent.
- ♦ John Mahowney. Name.
- ♦ Livith filia Organae. Badge. (Fieldless) A cross of Caid argent surmounted by two rapiers in saltire sable.
- Mary Dedwydd verch Gwallter. Augmentation of arms. Quarterly gules and argent, an escallop counterchanged and for augmentation in canton a cross of Caid argent.
- Ovrynka Gaylis. Badge. Per chevron ployé sable goutty d'eau and gules, a comet and in base two asses combattant argent.
- Séamus mac Nathí. Name and device. Vert, a centaur passant reguardant maintaining to sinister a drawn bow with arrow nocked, on a chief argent an arrow reversed vert.
 [Nathí is the registered SCA name of the submitter's father and is used here in its genitive form via the Existing Registration Allowance.]
- ♦ Sloane Macnamara. Name.
- ♦ Vesna Saric. Name and device. Per bend purpure and sable, a thistle Or and a threaded needle bendwise argent. [Saric is the submitter's legal surname.]
